 - Email with details will be forthcoming

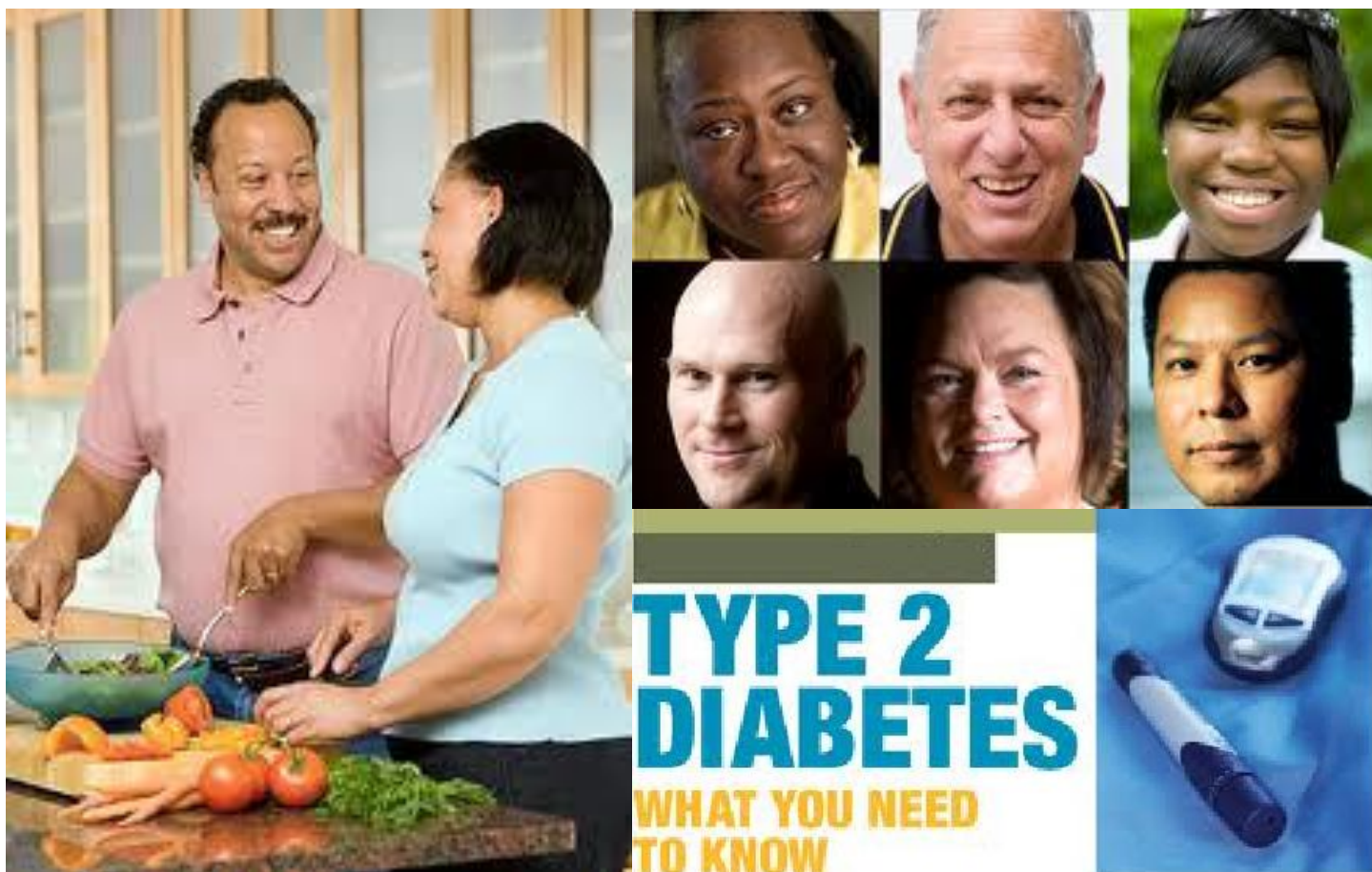
3. Campus Advisory Committee
