Eisen, ISBN # 0-7641-3547-3. **Prerequisites**: Familiarity with the PC or Fundamentals of PC Use course.

Objectives: Every student will be able to:

- 1. Define accounting terminology
- 2. Analyze and record business transactions in a manual and computerized environment
- 3. Complete the accounting cycle
- 4. Prepare financial statements
- 5. Apply accounting concepts related to cash and payroll
