



**GENERAL ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
Austin Community College and Concordia University at Austin**

This agreement is entered into, by and between Austin Community College, hereinafter referred to as ACC, and Concordia University at Austin, hereinafter referred to as CUA, for the purposes, terms, and conditions as further described below.

I. Purpose and Rationale

Through this general agreement, both parties seek to clearly identify those courses as ACC that are equivalent to courses offered by CUA to ensure accurate advising and accurately inform students who transfer from ACC to CUA. Implementation of this agreement should ensure a smoother and expeditious process for ACC students intending to enroll at CUA.

II. Course Equivalencies

Course equivalencies are attached as an addendum to this articulation agreement and will be updated on an annual basis.
