ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

DeVry University and Austin Community College

This Articulation Agreement includes a Course-to-Course transfer agreement between Austin Community College (ACC) and DeVry University, which is intended to allow holders of ACC credits to transfer approved credit hours into a DeVry University program of study. DeVry University will award semester transfer credit for approved ACC courses into one of the bachelor degree programs listed below:

- Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (BSBA) including all listed majors
- Bachelor of Science in Computer Information Systems (BSCIS) including all listed tracks
- Bachelor of Science in Electronics Engineering Technology (BSEET)
- Bachelor of Science in Technical Management (BSTM)

Also included in this Articulation Agreement between DeVry University and Austin Community College (ACC) are specific degree-to-degree agreements, allowing ACC associate degree graduates to be awarded specific credit hours into a DeVry University program of study. In addition to these specific program-to-program agreements listed above, DeVry will grant at least 60 credit hours towards the Bachelor of Science in Technical Management degree to any student that graduates from ACC earning all required credits exclusively from an ACC school. The exact awarding of these credits against graduation requirements will be accomplished through academic advising at the time of transfer. Up to three credit hours from cooperative education courses, not normally transferable, will be awarded as elective credits as needed to award the full 60 credit hours.
