Austin Community College District and Western Illinois University AAS to BOT/BA Degree

Education Plan/Transfer Guide

Western Illinois University and ACC agree that that students may take one or more courses, and at the same time work toward completing their Associate in Arts and WIU's Board of Trustees Bachelor of Arts (BOT/BA) degree without campus attendance at Western Illinois University.

The following is an education plan for students who intend to earn the AAS in Fire Science at ACC and then transfer to WIU's BOT/BA degree program. The plan includes the AAS degree requirements and courses to complete the Illinois Transferable General Education Core Curriculum (IAI GECC).

Changes to the IAI course articulations may require an adjustment to the student education plan as outlined in the above degree plan.

A maximum of 80 semester credit hours may be transferred from Austin Community College and applied toward the 120 semester hours required for a BOT/BA degree.

A student who completes a Certificate of Achievement or a Certificate of Completion will have his/her transcript evaluated on a course by course basis. The most current course by course articulation information is available to transfer students through the WIU Admissions Office.

If an applicant plans to take courses "on-site" at a WIU campus, State of Illinois law requires the student to furnish proof of proper immunization against certain communicable diseases. Information may be obtained from the Beu Health Center on the WIU Macomb campus by calling 309/298-1888. A health form will be sent from WIU and must be on file before the student may begin classes "on-site" at Western Illinois University.
