SYLLABUS

Course Description

Topics address recently identified current event, skills, knowledge and/or attitudes and behaviors pertinent to the technology or occupation and relevant to the professional development of the student. May be repeated for credit.

Course Objective:

To allow the advanced student to work independently on a personal project with limited guidance from the instructor.

Students set their own learning objectives through the following sequence:

- Personally design or obtain a design for a woodworking project
- **SUBMIT THE DESIGN TO THE INSTRUCTOR FOR APPROVAL!**
- Draw or obtain a working drawing complete with dimensions and specifications
- Establish a material list and cut sheet
- Determine a work sequence

Student Responsibilities

- Furnish all materials and hardware
- Furnish and WEAR protective eyewear
- Furnish tape measure and personal hand tools
- Practice proper safety procedures **AT ALL TIMES**
- Adhere to the specified class day and time
- Clean up at the close of each class
- Remove project and all material at the end of the semester

Instructor Responsibilities:

- Meet with each student to review project
- Help student with design and work sequence *if needed*
- Promote and maintain a safe working atmosphere
- Offer guidance and direction when asked

Note: the instructor is present to promote independent study, not to design, estimate or build the project for the student
