

Cancelled Classes

Business Studies departments make every effort to schedule classes at times and locations that satisfy student demand. However, classes are occasionally cancelled for low enrollment.

A low enrollment class is defined as a class that has less than 14 students, or less than 70% of maximum enrollment, whichever is less. Low enrollment classes are reviewed the day after registration ends in order to determine if there are special circumstances that justify allowing them to run. Classes that are cancelled are identified in the online schedule by an X where the student enrollment figure normally appears.

When a class is cancelled, students receive automated notification by phone, and have the ability to register for another class before the add/drop period begins.
