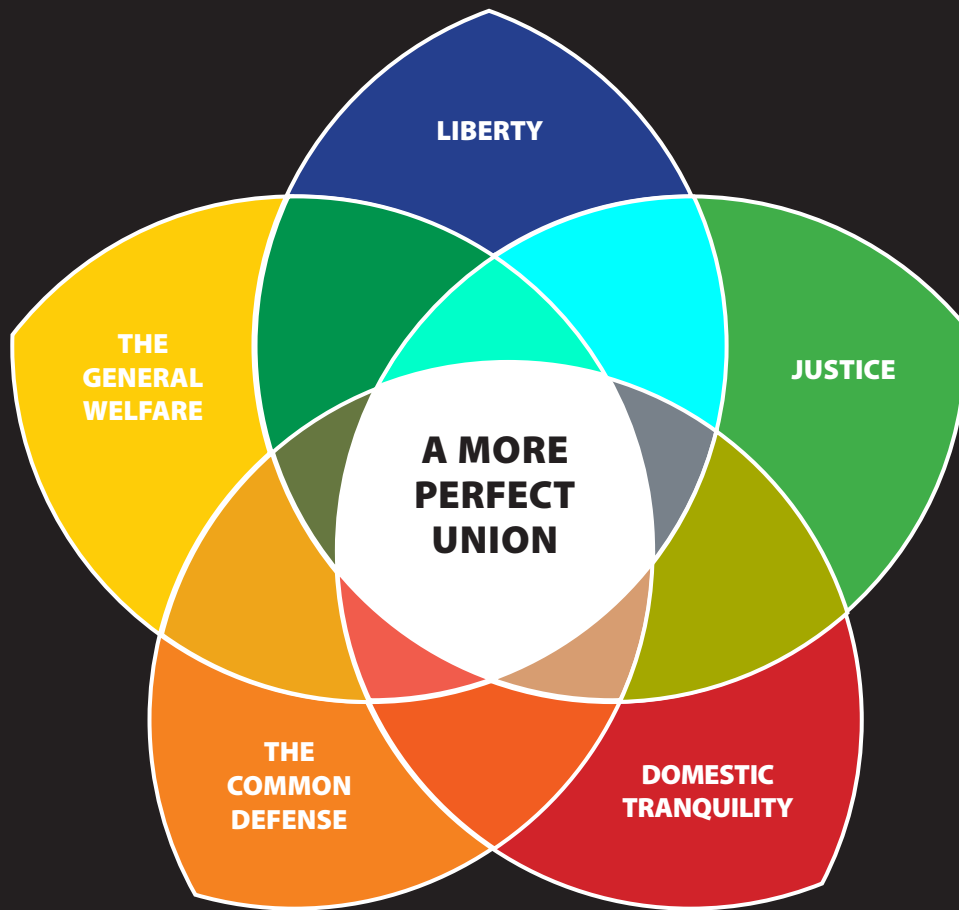


# ACC CONSTITUTION DEBATE DAY CELEBRATION

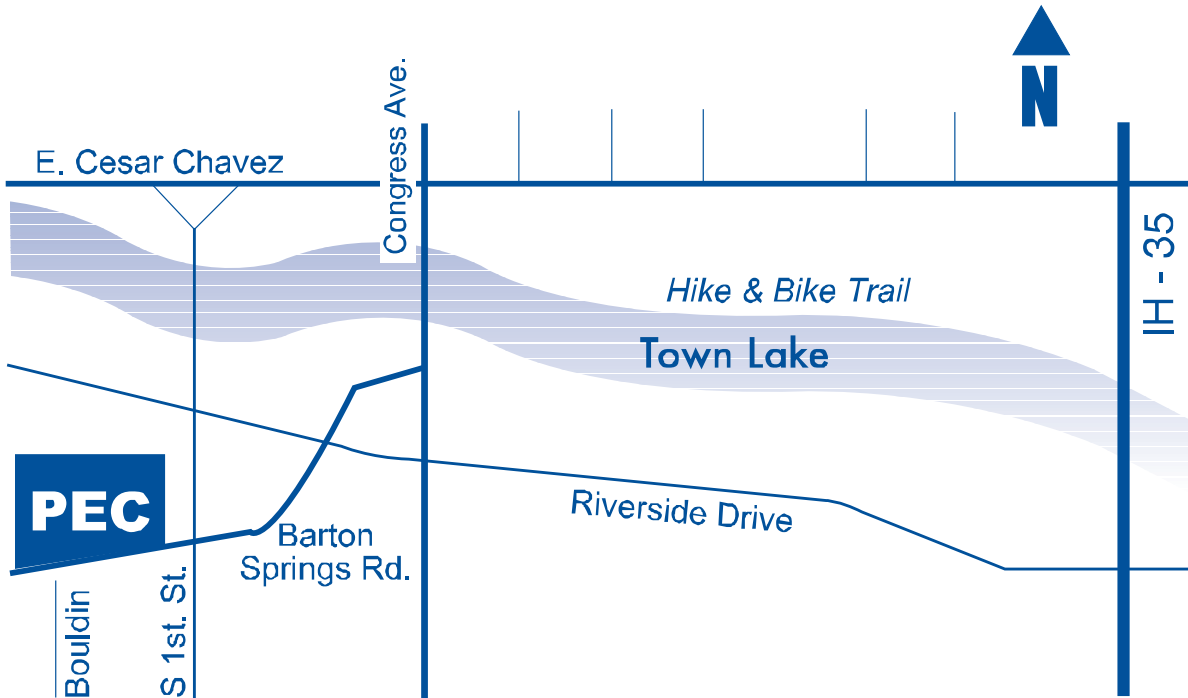
