## ACC Children's Lab School

### Evening Care Program

**The Children's Lab currently has space available for the Summer, and get on the wait list for the Fall.**

The Evening Care Program, located at the Child Development Center on the Eastview Campus, operates Monday through Thursday from 5:30PM to 9:30PM, and serves children aged two through ten in a mixed age group. They can accommodate up to 20 children an evening, and have up to four staff members per night.

They provide activities and material for children to explore in a relaxed family style atmosphere. Our trained, warm & friendly staff provides guidance to the children, and encourages self help skills. A healthy snack is also offered nightly to each enrolled child.

Tuition fro the program is based on a sliding scale according to income level and can range from \$1-45 a family per night of care. Only current ACC students, taking evening college credit classes may enroll their children for Evening Care. Evening Care children must attend on a regular basis for the semester enrolled. Unfortunately, we can not provide Evening Care before 5:30PM or after 9:30PM

We are in building 5000 (the Child Development Center), which is the one story building with an attached playground, at the back of the parking lot.

### Kudo's to Norma Mercado

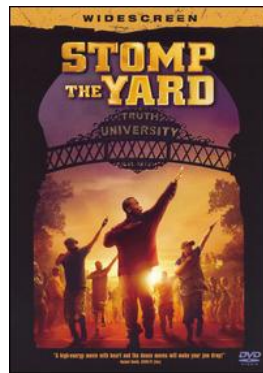
