Please ensure that your program is in compliance with the indicated stipulations prior to placement of students.

Standard Health Sciences Responsibilities Required by all – as applicable

- Criminal Background Check (CBC)- *** see note below**
- Immunizations
- CPR: American Heart Association Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers
- TB test annually or Negative Chest X-Ray-***chest x-ray within three years if TB test positive**
- HIPPA
- Environment of Care for Seton
- St. David's Orientation Manual
- Workplace Violence- Seton
- Statement of Responsibility and Confidentiality and Security Agreement–St. David's

Additional Requirements

- Drug Screens prior to placement: see timeframes in agreement or contact your facility liaison – **10 Panel Drug Screen within two weeks of beginning placement; get verification from Compliance Coordinator to provide to facility (results may take 3-5 days to be complete); includes an alcohol breathalyzer that is an additional cost to student**
- Orientation- faculty to verify with facility
- Additional Criminal Background Check (CBC)- **No one with a drug related, substance abuse, or alcohol related convictions can be sent to Cedar Park**
- Health Insurance- **Students must sign Waiver: Responsibility for Medical Care (separate documents)**
- Student list within specified timeframe: see agreement-faculty to check with facility
- Other forms: faculty to verify with facility for additional requirements
- CPR: American Heart Association Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers if not required by your program routinely

*** Students with convictions of drug related, substance abuse, or alcohol crimes cannot be assigned to Cedar Park. Please verify through the Compliance Coordinator that all students are in compliance with this stipulation.**

Note: All students registered in the clinical courses are covered by accident insurance and professional liability insurance. They are not covered by health insurance. Specific information can be provided to site by the Risk Management Office.
