### Admission to the College

- Gain admission to Austin Community College; follow the instructions/process at <http://www.austincc.edu>  
Visit a campus advisor or counselor to determine need for ACC assessment testing.
- Radiology requires that the TSI status be complete or exempt.

**NOTE:** Admission to Austin Community College **does not** guarantee admission to the Radiology Program.

### Applying to the Program:

  - Retain the Verification Form to submit with application.
- Complete program required immunizations. See <http://www.austincc.edu/health/immunizations.php> for information and form.
- Complete the prerequisites with a “C” or better:
  - BIOL 2404 Introduction to Anatomy and Physiology must be within five (5) years prior to application deadline
  - MATH 1314 College Algebra (may be substituted with a higher level math)
- Submit Radiology application by **February 1<sup>st</sup>** with:
  - Information Session Verification Form
  - Immunization documentation
  - Unofficial copies of transcripts, other than ACC

### For Selection:

Ranking is determined by multiplying the number of prerequisites and co-requisites courses completed (by application deadline) by the GPA in those courses. In order to be competitive, it is very important that the applicant complete most if not all of the co-requisite courses by the application deadline.

- Additional points are given for completion of Information Session and re-applicants.

This program only starts in the fall semester.

Applications are good for three years. If the applicant has not been admitted into the program within three years, the application will be removed from the applicant pool and the student will need to reapply. The student will lose all reapplication points.

Please note that to be compliant with clinical requirements a **criminal background check** will be required prior to admission to the Radiology Program. As specific timelines must be met, **do not do this until instructed by the program.**
