

## PROJECT FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION GRANT of P.E.O.

### About the grant:

1. A grant for education expenses, maximum of \$3,000, for women whose education has been interrupted for at least 24 months and who find it necessary to complete their education to support themselves and/or their families.
2. The ACC ADN Scholarship Committee will recommend an eligible student to a local P.E.O. chapter for sponsorship.
3. The PCE committee of the local P.E.O. chapter will interview the prospective candidate to determine eligibility.
4. Once eligibility is established, the committee chairman will assist the student in the application process.
5. The application will be forwarded to the P.E.O. executive office for consideration.
6. Applications are evaluated on the basis of financial need and available funds.
7. If the grant is approved, the check is mailed to the sponsoring chapter to be presented personally to the recipient.

### Who is eligible?

1. Must be a female citizen of the U.S. or Canada.
2. Must have had at least 24 consecutive months as a non-student sometime in her adult life.
3. Must be within 24 months of completing her educational goal.
4. Must need financial assistance.

### How to get started:

1. Complete the ACC General Scholarship Application with an attachment indicating the time frames when schooling was discontinued.
2. Write a short statement (not more than 1 page) about what the student will contribute to the field of nursing.
3. Turn in the application to Pat Shirejian, (EVC 8351) by Tuesday, January 31, 2012.
4. The Scholarship Committee will meet to review the applications and make a recommendation to the local P.E.O. chapter.
