It is expected that each student will be well prepared for Mastery Ck-off-

****Review [Nursing Skills Competencies](#)** (videos etc) and associated performance criteria (as previously taught) including **all safety criteria** for entry/exit of patient room. *Satisfactory performance on Skill Mastery is **required for continuation in the nursing course-** refer to [Student Handbook](#), p. 23, 24

For Mastery/Practice -bring lab pack/supplies including IV drug book to determine rate, solution and/or medication compatibility. During and following all practice and preparation time the student is expected to leave the lab in "order".

Comprehensive Mastery Skills includes previously learned skills presented in various patient care scenarios including:

- Catheterization- indwelling catheter
- *IV's (IV push, administering a piggy-back solutions as antibiotics or other solutions through a central line and/or peripheral line or saline lock; maintaining IV, setting ml's per hour per pump, compatibility med/solutions); flushing central line
- Tracheostomy care and tracheostomy suctioning;
- Central Line dressing change,
- Inserting nasogastric tube and/or enteral feeding tube
- *Documentation (verbal or written)

At time of Mastery the student will:

Select "at random" a patient situation that includes several skills; must be rated as "satisfactory" and be completed within 20 minutes. (*All skills scenarios to include IV and IV med administration)

Demonstrate skills required in the patient care scenario in an organized, correctly prioritized manner with adherence to patient safety.

*Review printed criteria for skills to be performed. (available on Nursing Skills Competencies link)

Present to assigned clinical faculty -completed **Written Skills Quiz & RNCEUs** at time of Mastery or when designed by faculty.
