Many Honors students have been asking about the status of the transfer policy to the University of Texas. UT – Austin has started to rework their admissions policy based on a point system. Instead of automatic admission, ACC Honors students will now have a certain (undetermined at this time) number of points added to their application totals based on the number of Honors courses they have taken. The more Honors classes the more points added. We expect UT to have their admissions policy in place for the Spring '05 semester.
