Duration: 10 days January 3-12, 2010.

Description: Visit factories that manufacture products for export to the United States. Follow the process from order management, fulfillment and manufacturing to the dock. See how products make it to port of embarkation and discuss the merits of different processes.

Activities and Other Program Features: Visit the Kong Kong Museum of History, Tour the Port of Hong Kong, Tour Chep Lap Kok Airport, Supply Chain lecture at the University of HongKong, Visit Yantian Port, Tour the Futian distribution facility.

Acceptance Policy: Must meet with Professor Shawn Levens. Application and scholarship deadline for this program is November 20, 2009. LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Program Fee: The estimated total of \$2850 includes air transport, double-occupancy lodging, local transportation, tours, visa and some meals. A valid passport, tuition fees for one credit hour, incidentals and some meals are the responsibility of the participant. Not included in program fee: ACC Tuition, some meals, passport.

Scholarships: Funding is available through the Campus Activity Board and the Board of Trustees Study Abroad Scholarship program.
