

Florence, Rome, and Venice

Italy

Program Site: This program takes place in Florence, Rome, and Venice. Classes are on-location.

Duration: 4 weeks during the first summer session: 2 weeks in Florence, 1 week in Rome, 1 week in Venice.

Description: Be inspired by the architecture of Florence, the rich history of Rome and the sparkling canals of Venice as you sketch and draw before some of the world's most famous sites.

Course and Credit: Drawing II (ARTS 1317) or Life Drawing II (ARTS 2324)
3 ACC credits.

Accommodations: Students will live in fully furnished, fully equipped apartments with other program participants. Rooms will be shared; private rooms may be available for an additional fee.

Activities and Other Program Features: Classes will be held on-location rather than in a classroom, in order to give students the opportunity to experience art first-hand and be inspired by their immediate surroundings. The program includes numerous visits to archaeological sites including the Colosseum, museum trips including the Uffizi in Florence and Capitolini in Rome, visits to the San Marco, Guggenheim, Grassi, Accademia and Arte Moderna in Venice, and a tour of the Vatican and St. Peter's Basilica. Participants will benefit from the programs small instructor to student ratio.

Eligibility: Preferred applicants are Art majors. Students must complete Drawing I or Life Drawing I (or earn equivalent credit) by the end of the Spring 2010 semester.

Program Fee: \$2800. Includes accommodations, transportation between cities, excursions, site entrance and tour fees, general fee (covers some instructor expenses)

Not included: Tuition, airfare, meals, art supplies, personal expenses

Scholarships: Funding is available through the Campus Activity Board and through the Board of Trustees Study Abroad Scholarship Program
