

## How to Apply for the Drawing in Italy Program

### Step 1

Review the [program information packet](#), also available online or from a [program coordinator](#). Be sure to read the information carefully and to review the FAQ section.

This program has the pre-requisite of Drawing I or Life Drawing I. You may apply without having met the pre-requisite; however, you must complete the pre-requisite by the end of the Spring 2010 semester.

### Step 2

Download the [program application](#). Review the checklist.

### Step 3

Obtain all required materials as indicated on the checklist. *(If you have a time constraint in obtaining one of the required items and wish to submit the application without it, please indicate with a note on the checklist that you will obtain the item within two weeks of submission).*

### Step 4

Fill out the application and submit materials to the International Programs Office. You must acknowledge on the application (pg 1) that you have read and understood the program information packet.
