Hanna, or his authorized agent: And further agree to crib the Corn, pick, gin and pack the Cotton, upon the following terms-viz: The Corn to be divided by the wagon load, for said Hanna, Leve Loads Cen Gever, ah yong & ah Bao. The Cotton to be sold on joint Calvertaccount, or divided, at one Lourth for said Hanna, Three fourths ah buw el al . James S. Hanna, on his part, agrees to furnish all necessary team and tools to cultivate the land, and corn to feed the team until the corn crop of 1874 can be used; and further agrees to make such advances as he may deem necessary, throughout the year. Each party furnishes his own Bagging and Ties. Said Oh Geory, ah your Hah Bas also agree to DO AND KEEP in good repair, the fences and ditches around and about Therecrop, and to take proper care of all work animals and implements used by Them in making the crop, and not remove them from the place without permission; and to return them at the end of the year, in good order and condition. and not to ATTEMPT TO MOVE any portion of the crop until said Hanna HAS BEEN PAID for all advances made to said ah Geory, ah gong Vah Bas. Said ah beow agrees to furnish one horse or mule to Cultivate I in coll the land throughout the Season until The Crop is made, Said Hanna agrees to pay ah Suow el-al Eight- Dolls per acre for Cotton to be paid at the time of of the sorty acres For the faithful performance of the stipulations of this contract by each party, each party gives the other a lien on his share of the crop.
