7. Home Page Redesign: Ed Osborn reviewed the navigational structure of the proposed home page redesign. The committee provided a number of suggestions for moving links around, adding links, changing category titles, and other changes. The home page design was also reviewed and comments made. The opt-in e-mail option was discussed. Suggestions on adding a mapping (how to find ACC) link were given.

8. Instructional Page Guidelines: Input on the proposed guidelines from the Academic Affairs Council was reviewed and the guidelines finalized. An additional link was suggested for ADA compliance.

9. IT Projects: Gary Weseman and Glenda Keyworth updated the committee on the status of several IT projects related to the web. A Linux server is being prepared to allow for a seamless user interface across the www and www2 servers. (known as "proxy server"). The goal here is to avoid bounces, redirects, or "page not found" messages.

Rick Saylor and Pauline Hargrave are working on an SQL server that will improve the functionality of primary database applications – schedule, phone book, catalog, etc. Target is to have this in place in FY02.

Virtual Personal Network (VPN): targeted for January 02 startup. This will allow home users (i.e., adjunct faculty) to access ACCNET from their own ISP. We will need to consider password protecting select intranet content once this is done.

10. Other:

a. EDU status: ACC should be able to apply sometime this year yet.
