

Elementary Statistics Students

Meeting the TSI requirement for MATH 1342 Elementary Statistics is not always enough for some students to be successful in this course. If you find yourself struggling in the first few weeks you should consider moving to our 12 week StatPath program to better prepare you, there will be no additional fall semester tuition. This StatPath option is a two-semester sequence designed to move students to and through our college-level statistics course, MATH 1342. In the fall 12 week semester students will take MATD 0455 Foundations for Mathematical Reasoning (non credit). In the spring students will complete their sequence by taking specific sections of MATH 1342 Elementary Statistics. Successfully completing MATD 0455 in the fall will guarantee a seat in a specified MATH 1342 statistics course. StatPath is offered at the following times and campuses.
