

This document is to let you see the format of the test and the way the instructions will be given. This is not a comprehensive list of the exact instructions you will be given, but I believe it will help you be more comfortable with the test to see this much in advance.

Obviously I omitted the problem statements. They are where the line of xxxxxxxxxxxxxx appear. There are between 12 and 15 problems on each version.

Materials allowed:

blank paper, graph paper,
2 pages of handwritten notes,
non-graphing calculator,
ruler,
tables.

Show all your work and answers on the test itself.

Use the backs of the pages as necessary. In that case, put a note in the place where the solution should be to direct me to the appropriate back of a page to see your solution.

For all problems where you are required to actually compute numbers from your formulas, you'll see COMPUTE at the beginning.

For all problems where you are not required to actually compute numbers from your formulas, you'll see CAREFUL! LITTLE OR NO COMPUTING!

I have provided additional instructions on what to do on many of the problems, in this unusual font.

Do not do more work than is requested on a problem. Not only will you not receive extra credit, but I will write negative notes like "Surely you don't have the energy to do all of this!" or "Finish what is required before you do extra work!"

Before you turn it in, stack your papers:

1. Test itself
2. Any scratch paper.
3. Your notes.

Then put the tables in your other hand, and give all of this to the Testing Center Monitor, so that that person will staple your pages in the correct order.
