5	613+	May enroll in MATD 0390, MATH 1332, 1333, or 1342 regardless of listed prerequisite. Must take the COMPASS test for placement into any other mathematics course.

Most entering students will have an entry Math Level assigned as a result of some placement test.

Math Levels by Completed Courses

Entering students who have completed a college-level course in the second column below will have an initial Math Level assigned on the basis of their previous courses.

Entering students who have only completed developmental classes at other institutions must take the COMPASS test for placement and the Math Level will be set by that.
