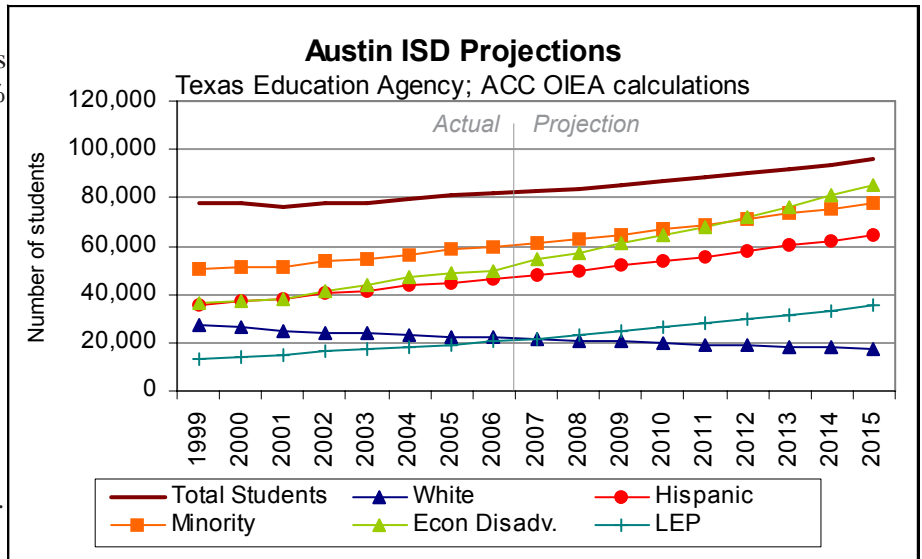

ACC Data Profile - Fall 2008

Observations

Austin ISD data gathered by the Texas Education Agency indicate a small 5% increase in overall students enrolled between 2000-01 and 2006-07; this growth has been fueled by a significant (26%) increase in Hispanic students.

Data comparisons between 2000-01 and 2006-07 also reveal increases in the number of Economically Disadvantaged students (a 34% increase), Bilingual Program students (a 57% increase), and Limited English Proficiency students (a 50% increase).

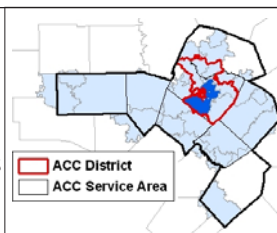

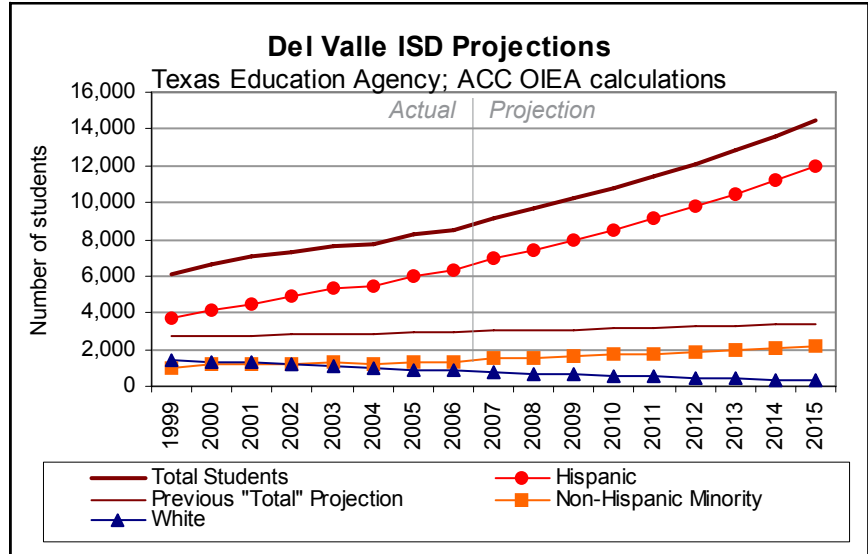

ACC Data Profile - Fall 2008

Observations

Del Valle ISD data gathered by the Texas Education Agency indicate a 27% growth in overall students enrolled between 2000-01 and 2006-07; this growth can be attributed to the strong growth in Hispanic students between the two academic years (a 51% increase, representing an additional 2,152 students).

Economically Disadvantaged students represent over three-quarters of the overall student population in 2006-07. In addition, one-quarter of 2006-07 students are in Bilingual Programs, as well as being flagged with Limited English Proficiency.

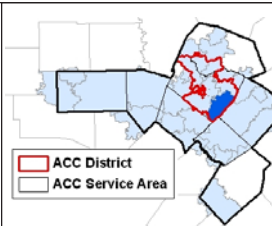

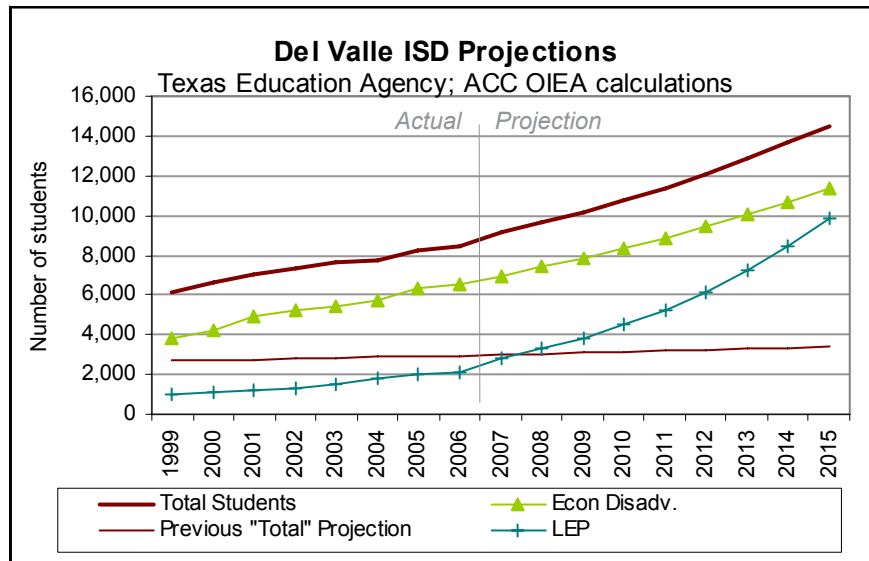

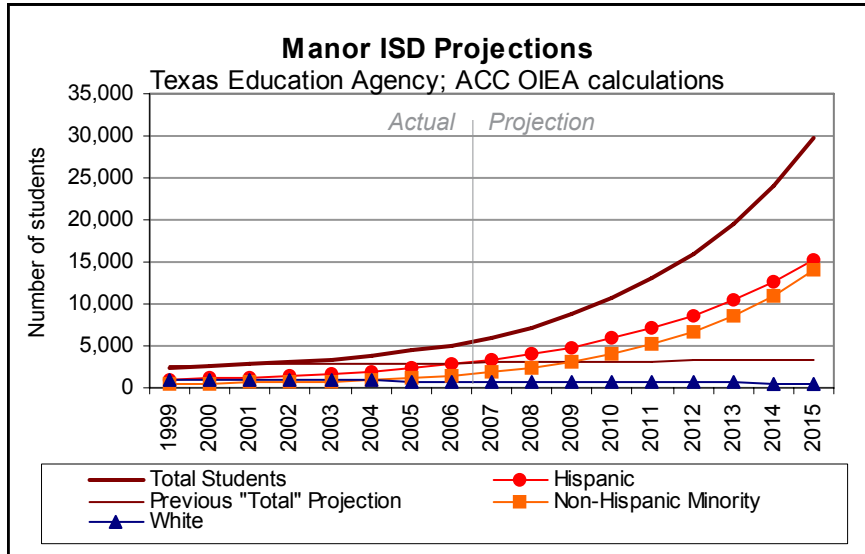

Manor ISD data gathered by the Texas Education Agency indicate a large growth in overall students enrolled between 2000-01 and 2006-07 – an additional 2,400 students are now part of Manor ISD, a 88% increase.

Seventy percent of 2006-07 Manor ISD students are Economically Disadvantaged; and 22% and 24%, respectively, are in Bilingual Programs, and are flagged with Limited English Proficiency.

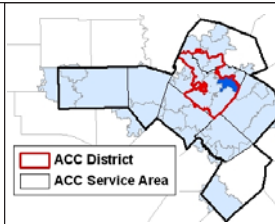

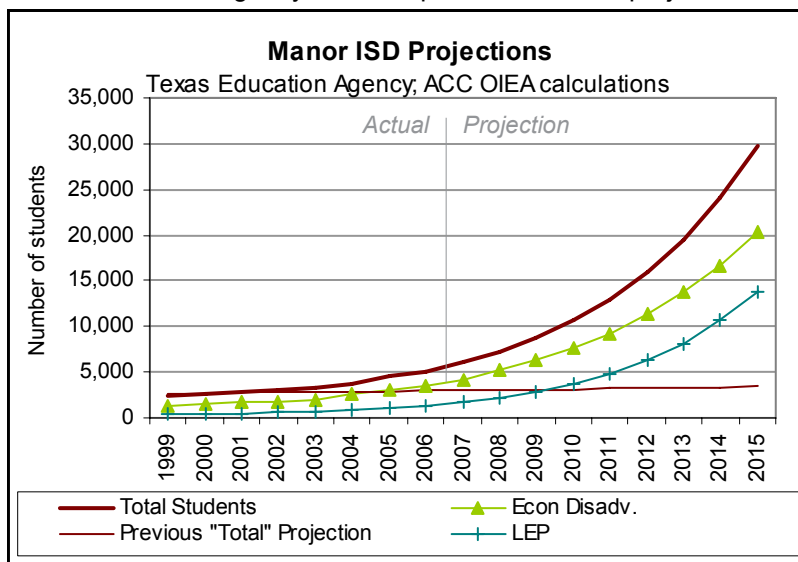

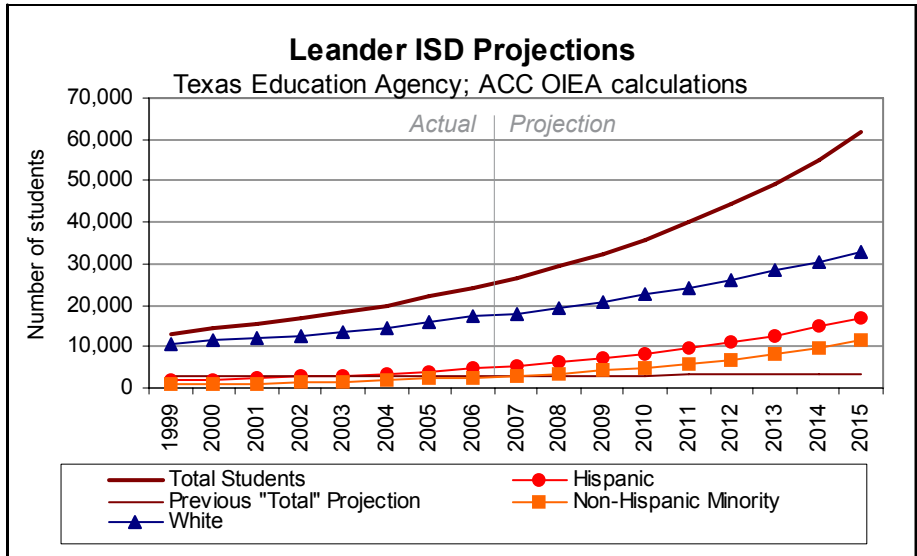

Observations

Leander ISD data gathered by the Texas Education Agency indicate a 67% increase in overall students enrolled between 2000-01 and 2006-07. Whereas Black and Hispanic students comprised 18.5% of the student population in 2000-01, in 2006-07, they comprised 24.8%. Overall, the Black and Hispanic student population grew by 148% and 118%, respectively. The White student population has also increased, but at a smaller rate (51%).

Among all the ISD's profiled, Leander ISD has the highest increase in graduated students – a 68% increase between 2000-01 and 2006-07.

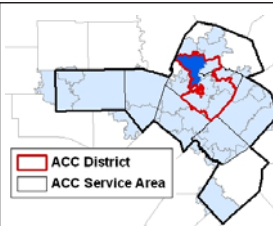

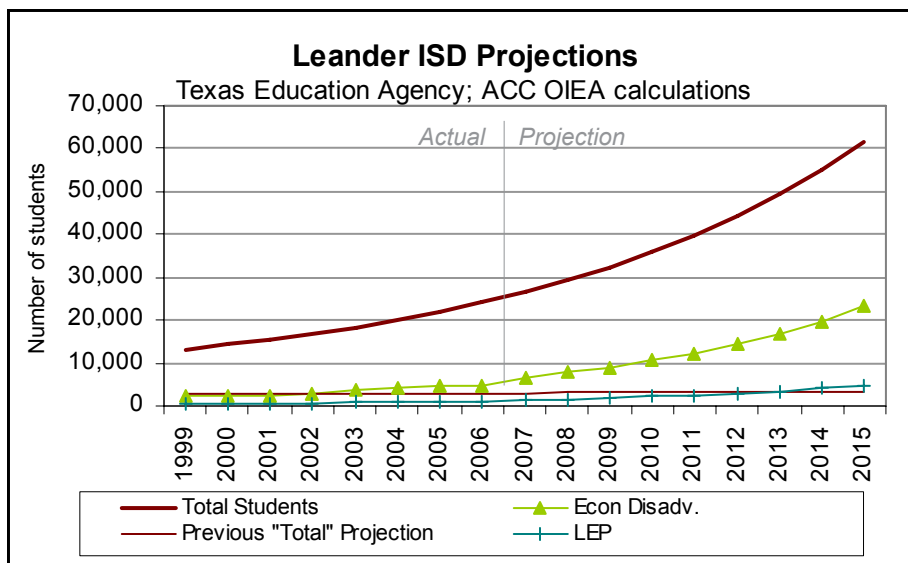

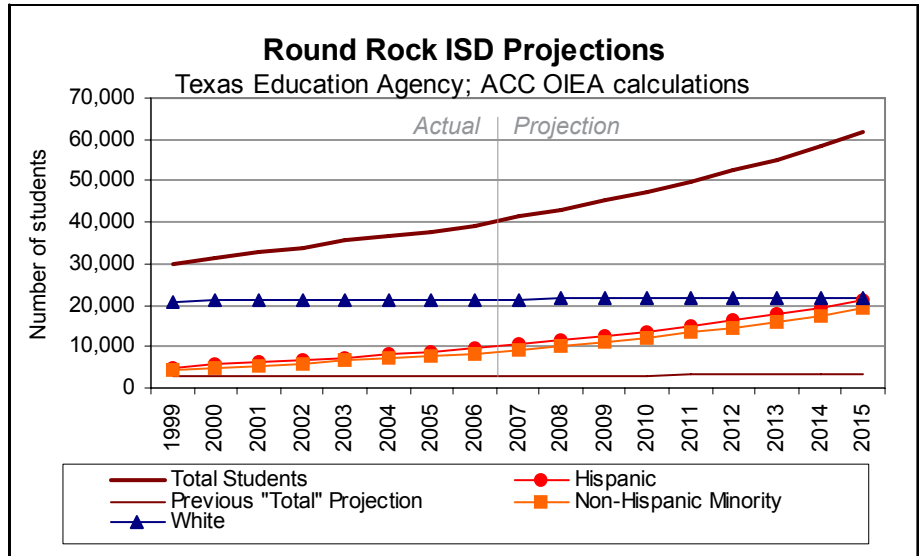

Observations

Round Rock ISD data gathered by the Texas Education Agency show a 24% increase in overall students enrolled between 2000-01 and 2006-07; this growth is fueled, primarily, by the growth in Black students (a 64% increase), Hispanic students (a 70% increase), and Asian/Pacific-Islander students (a 84% increase).

The data reveal a more than 100% increase between 2000-01 and 2006-07 in Economically Disadvantaged students (a 128% increase), Bilingual Program students (a 180% increase), and Limited English Proficiency students (a 124% increase).

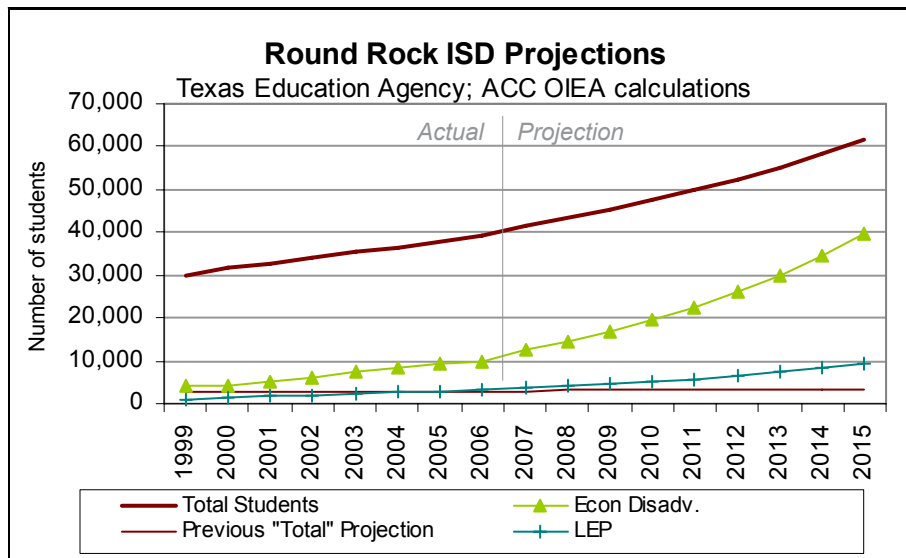

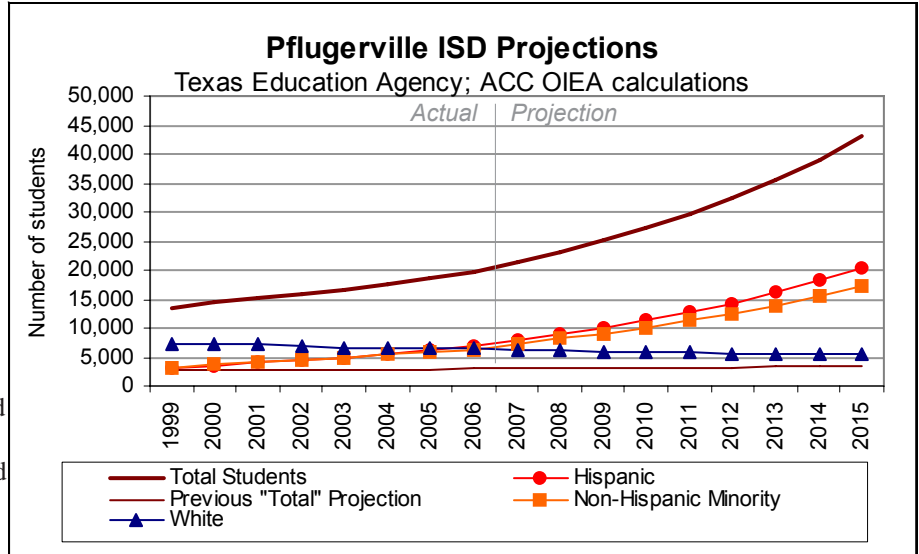

Pflugerville ISD data gathered by the Texas Education Agency indicate a 36% increase in overall students enrolled between 2000-01 and 2006-07; the growth is attributable to the increase in Black students (a 79% increase), Hispanic students (an 89% increase), and Asian/Pacific-Islander students (a 59% increase).

Additional data reveal that there were sharp increases between 2000-01 and 2006-07 in Economically Disadvantaged students (an 86% increase), Bilingual Program students (a 155% increase), and Limited English Proficiency students (a 151% increase).

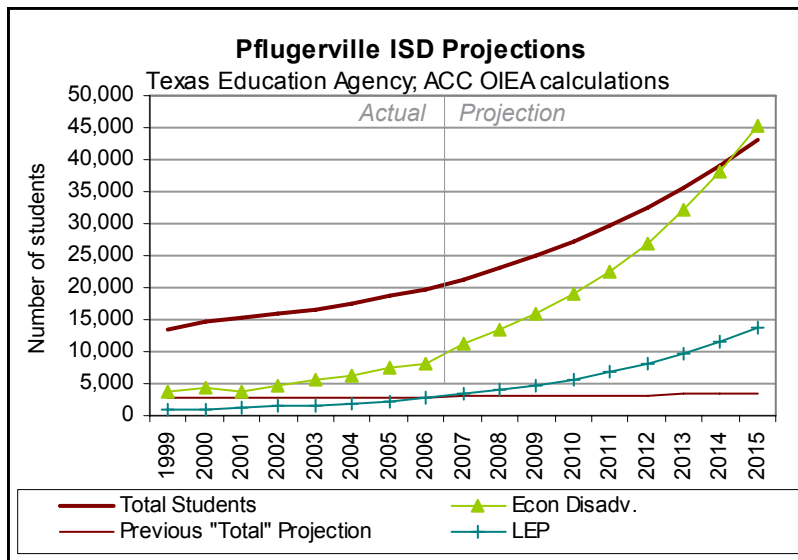

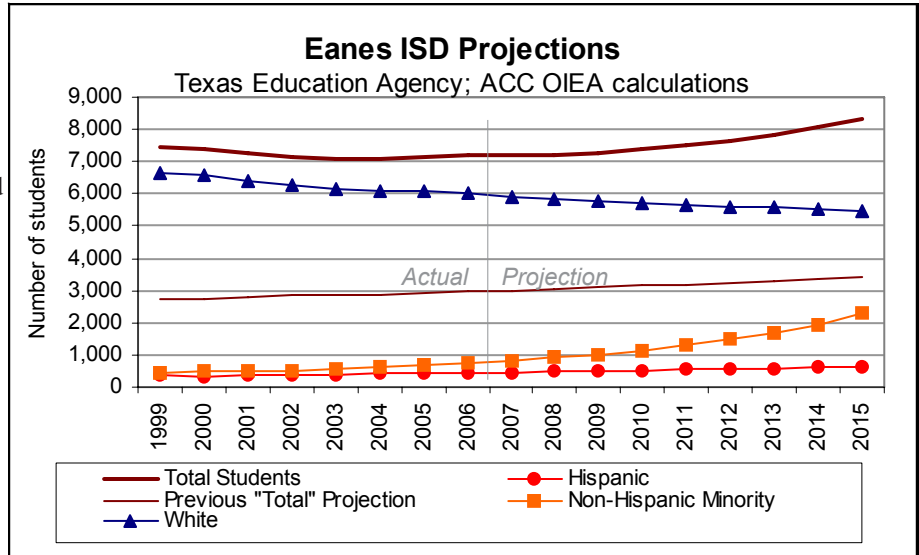

Eanes ISD data gathered by the Texas Education Agency indicate a 2% decrease in overall students enrolled between 2000-01 and 2006-07, the only ISD of those profiled which experienced a decline in students between the two academic years. Among all ethnic groups, White students were the only group who declined in enrollments. Among all ISD's profiled, Eanes ISD had the lowest percentage of Economically Disadvantaged students (2.7% in 2006-07), Bilingual Program students (1.2% in 2006-07), and Limited English Proficiency students (1.9% in 2006-07).
