

## Enrollment Comparison: Spring 1999 and Spring 1998

The following tables display headcount, demographic, credit hour, contact hour and FTSE data for all Spring 1999 sessions, with comparisons to the same data for all Spring 1998 sessions. The numbers reported here are not preliminary twelfth class day numbers reported to the THECB. Rather, they were obtained by modifying the *mainframe SPSS dailyhed report* to include demographics and running it for Spring 1999 and Spring 1998. All deleted sections and accompanying enrollments are excluded. The new discipline to dean crosswalk that went into effect on October 23, 1998 is reflected in the numbers below. All data are as of March 26, 1999

Notes: There is no Spring 1998 comparative data for EVC as Spring 1999 is its first semester of operation. There is no Spring 1999 comparative data for ERG as Fall 1998 was its last semester of operation.
