<p><b><u>State Measure:</u></b> The percent of adult learners enrolled in Adult Secondary Education who achieved a GED or diploma within the fiscal year&gt;</p>	23%
<p><b><u>Federal and State Measure: Placement in Postsecondary Education and Training</u></b> Percent of adult learners <u>with a goal</u> of entering postsecondary education or training who entered postsecondary education or training during the fiscal year.</p>	25%
<p><b><u>Federal and State Measure: Employment</u></b> Percent of adult learners who are unemployed at the time of enrollment and <u>have a goal</u> of obtaining employment, who entered unsubsidized employment by the end of the first quarter after the <u>program exit quarter</u>.</p>	24%
<p><b><u>Federal Measure: Retention in Unsubsidized Employment</u></b> Percent of adult learners who retained employment in the third quarter after the program exit quarter.</p>	25%
