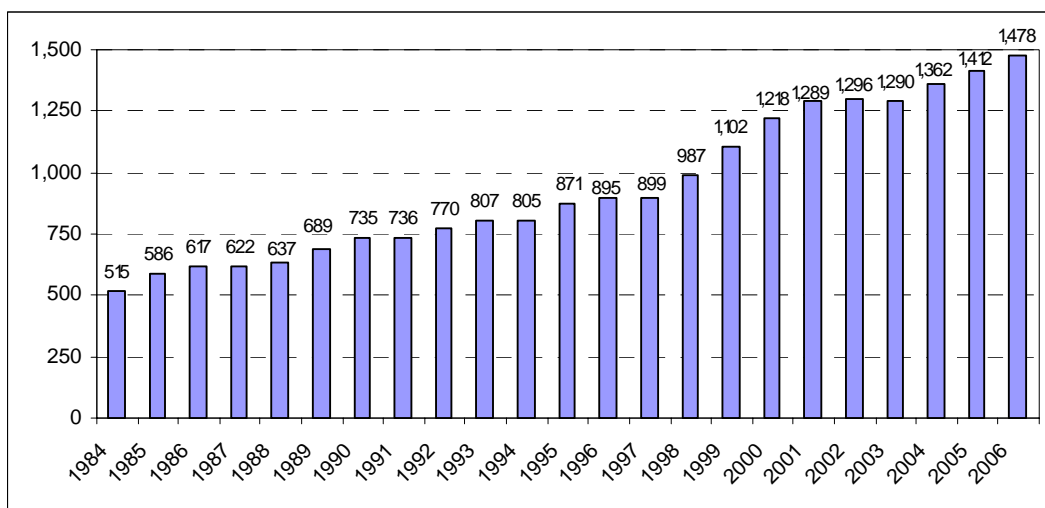

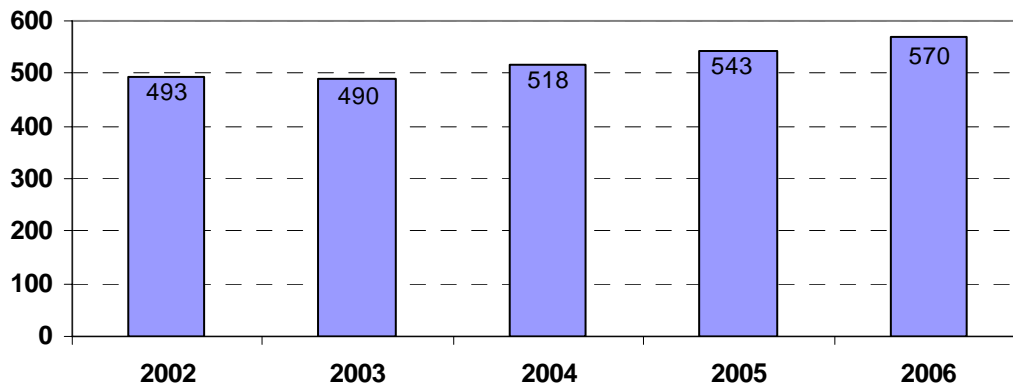

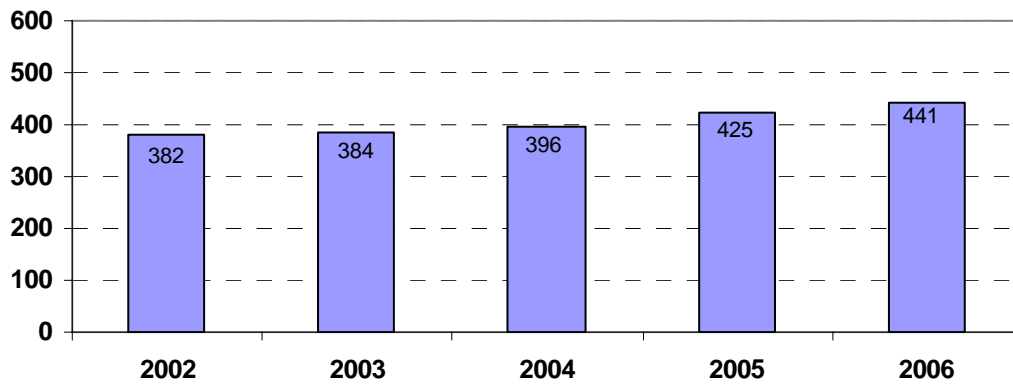

### Staffing Table Personnel by Classification Fall 2002 - Fall 2006

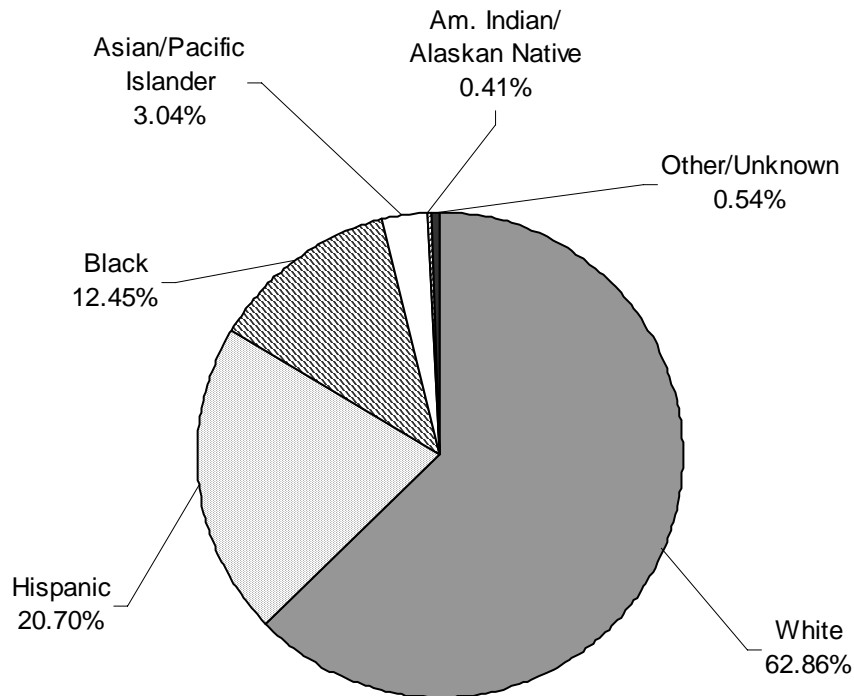
#### Classified Personnel

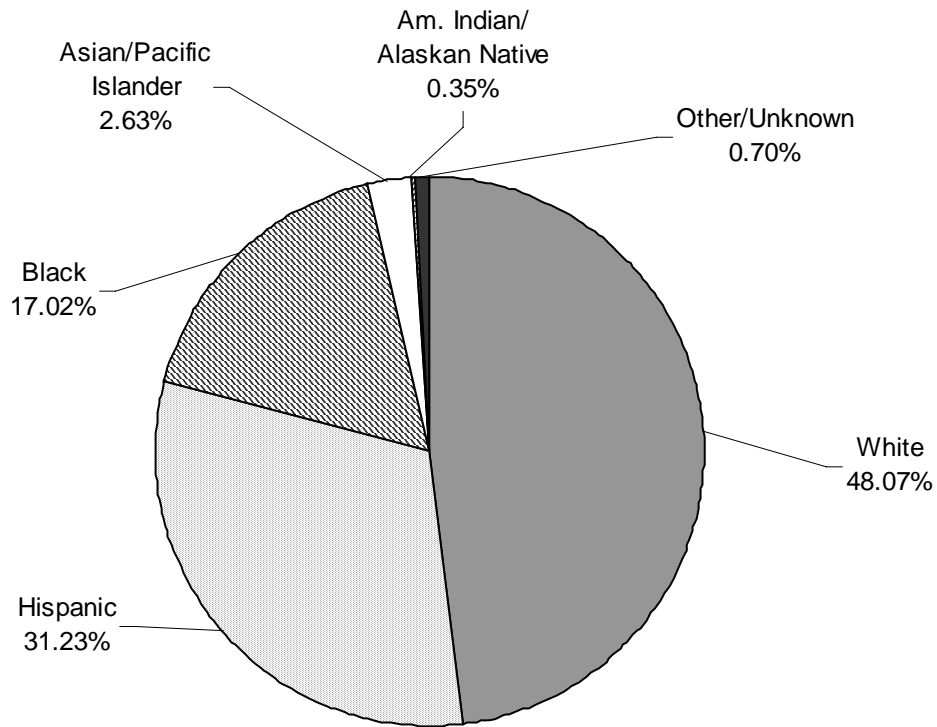

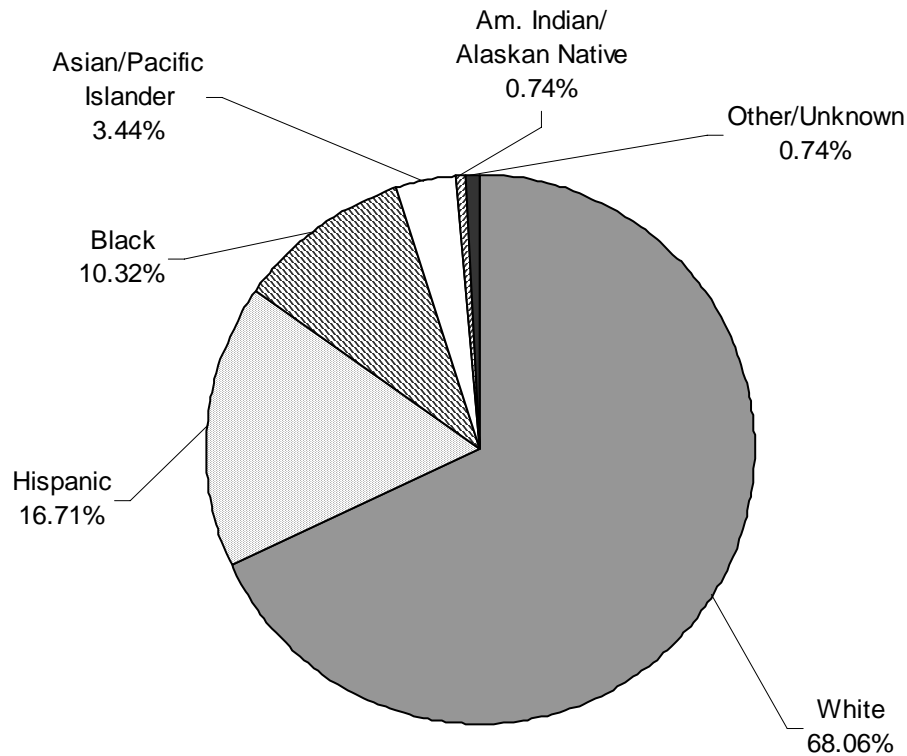

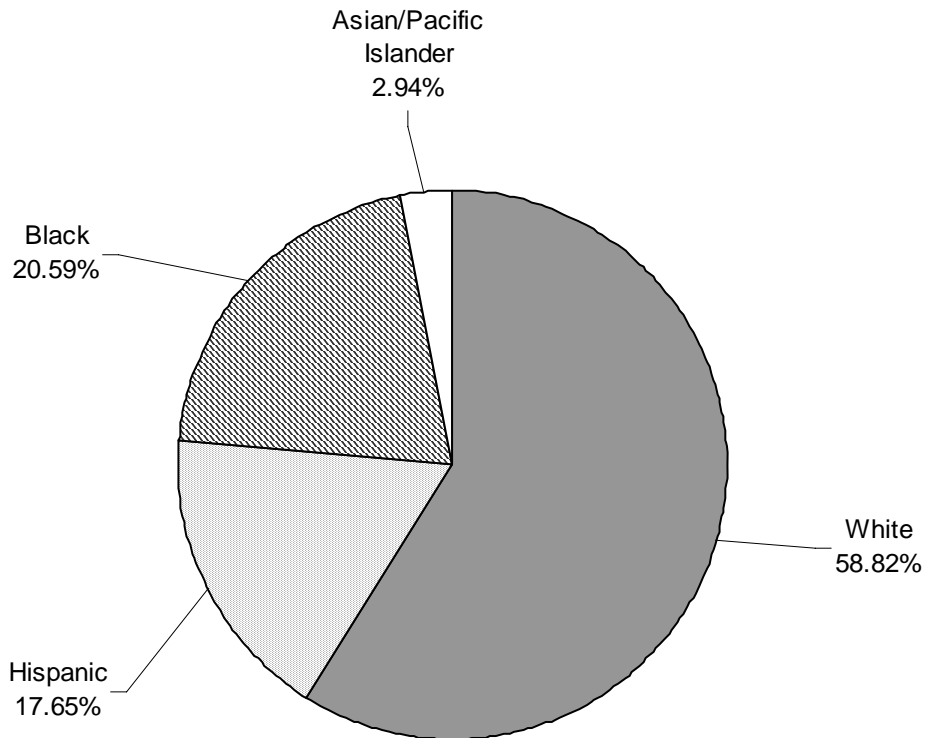

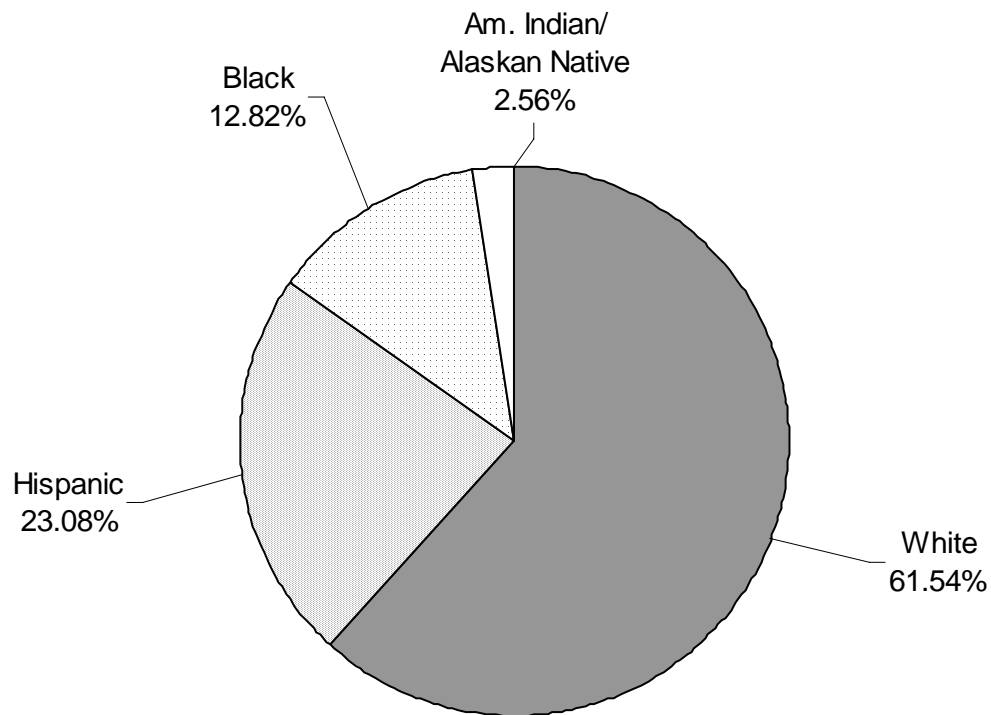

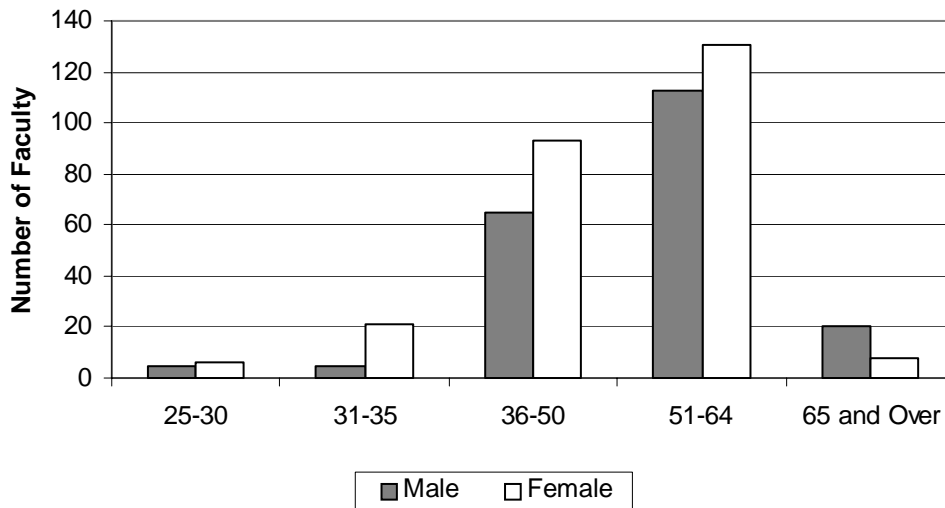

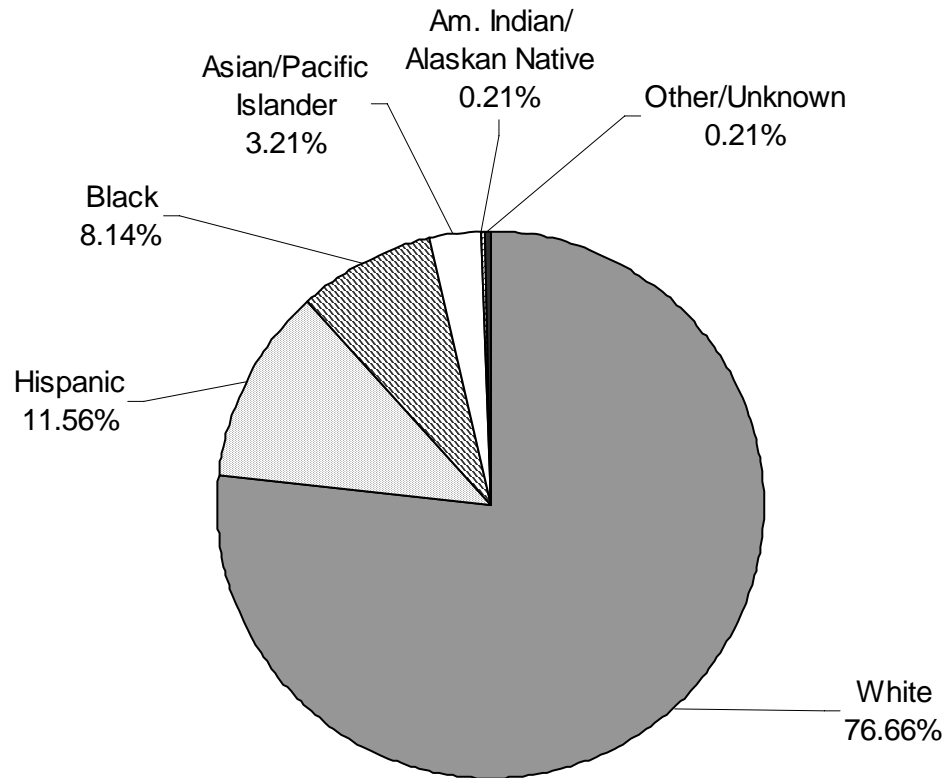

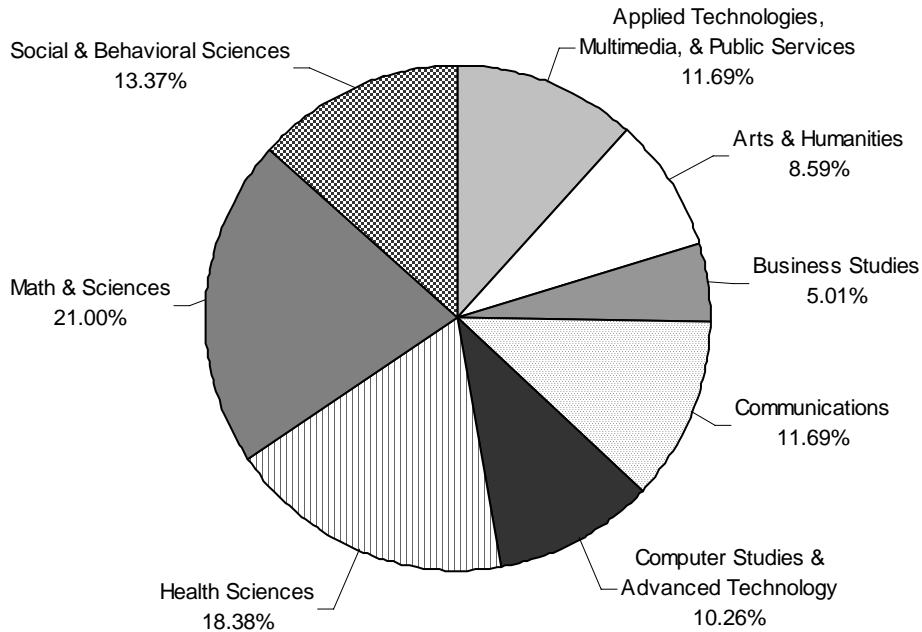

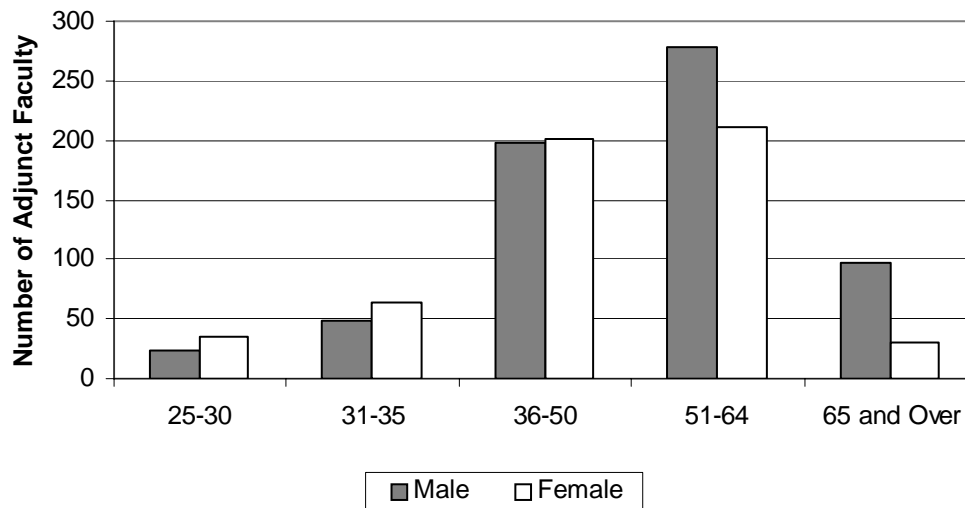

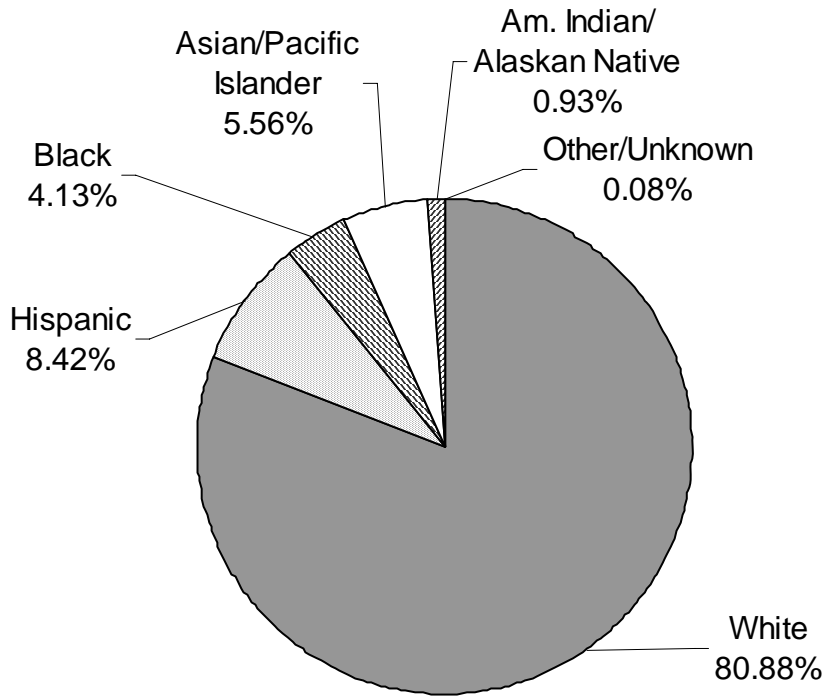

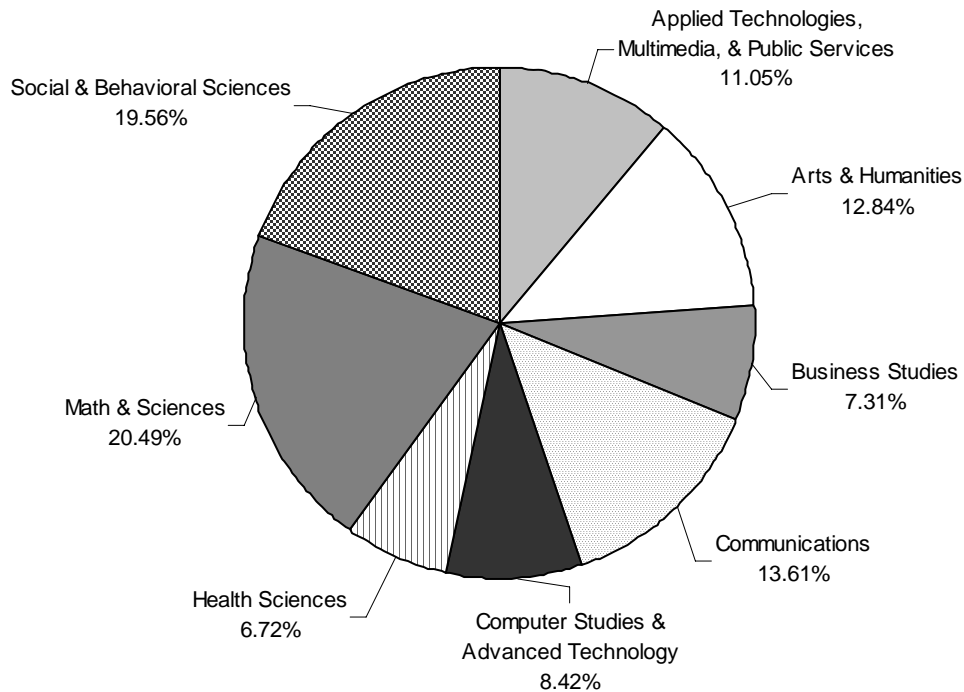

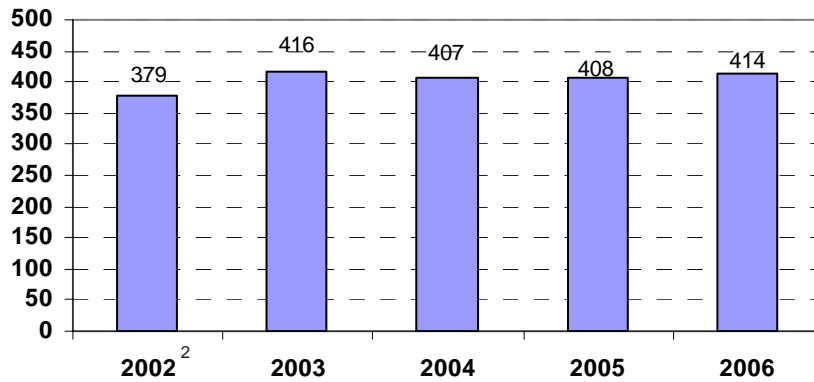

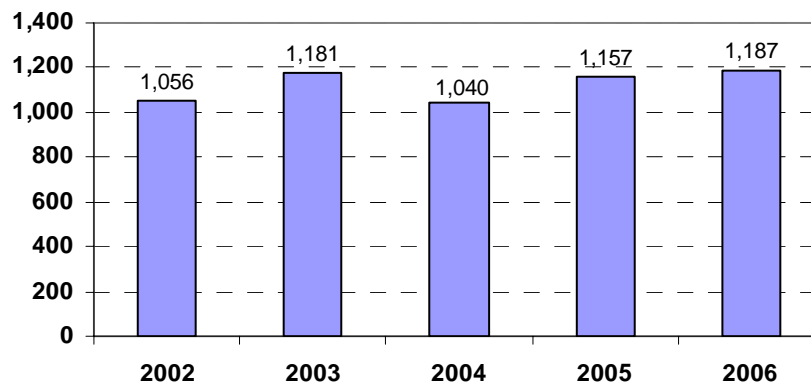
