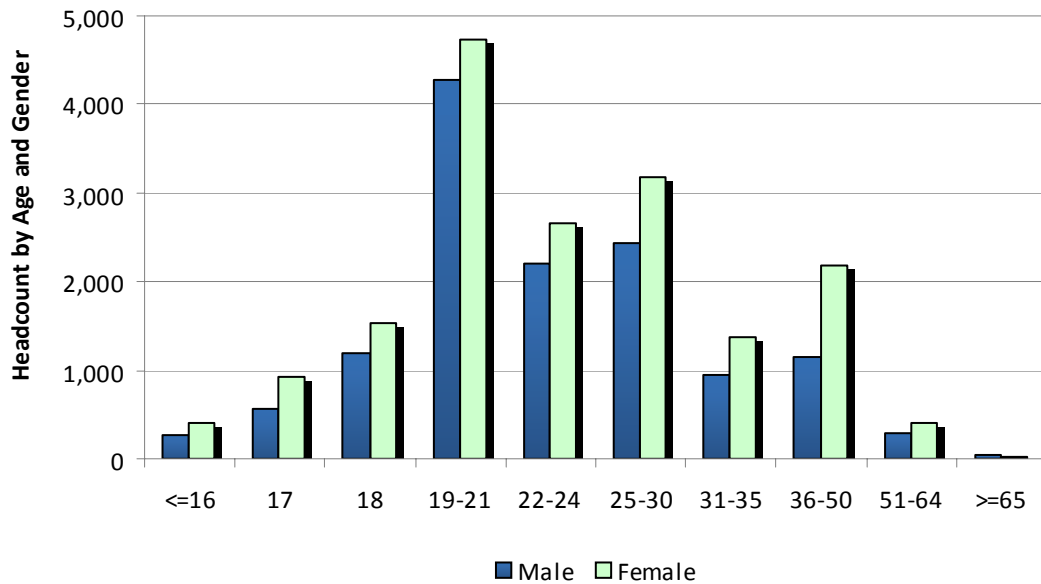

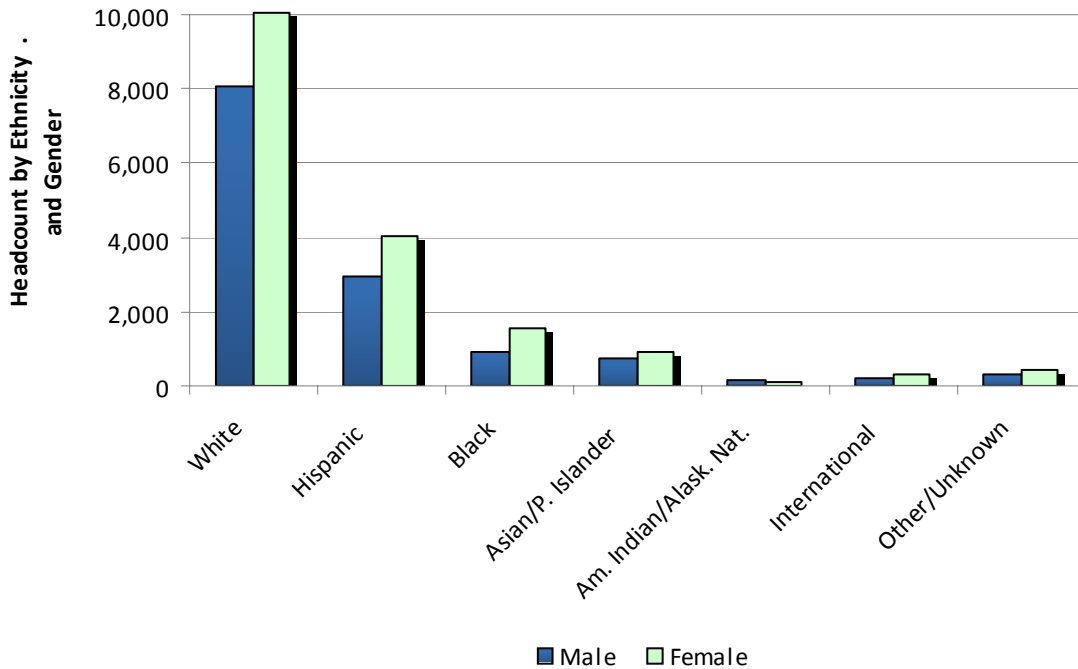

NOTE: First-time transfers are students who enter ACC for the first time but are known to have previously attended another postsecondary institution at the undergraduate level.

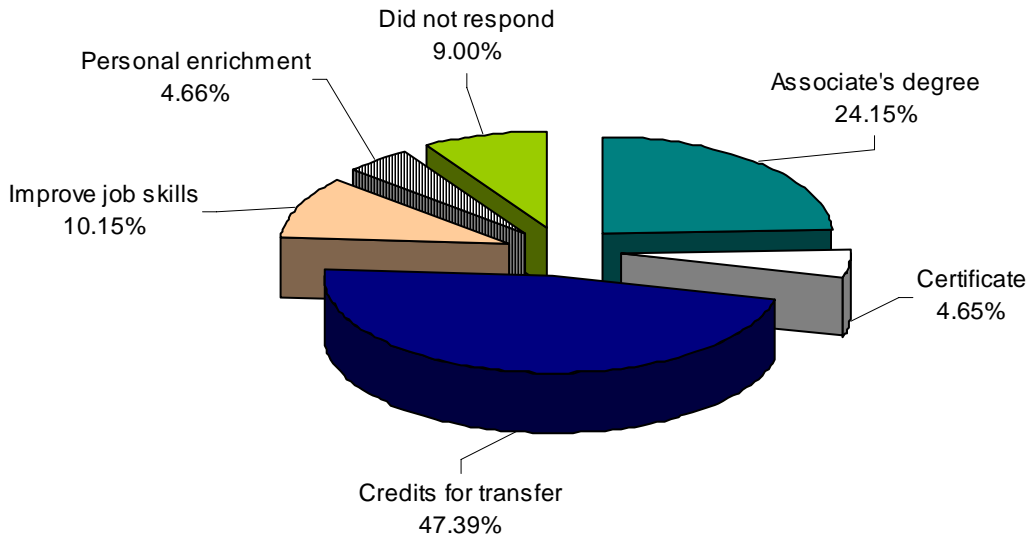
