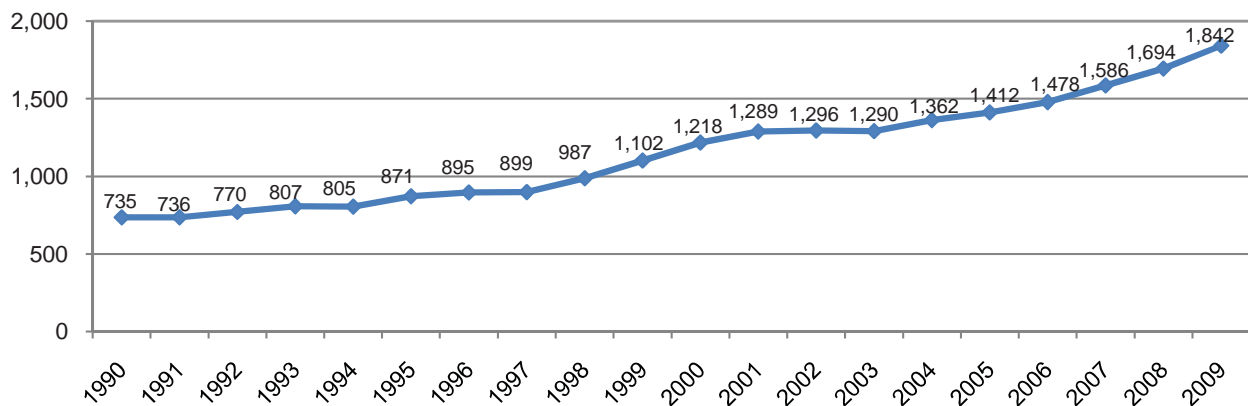

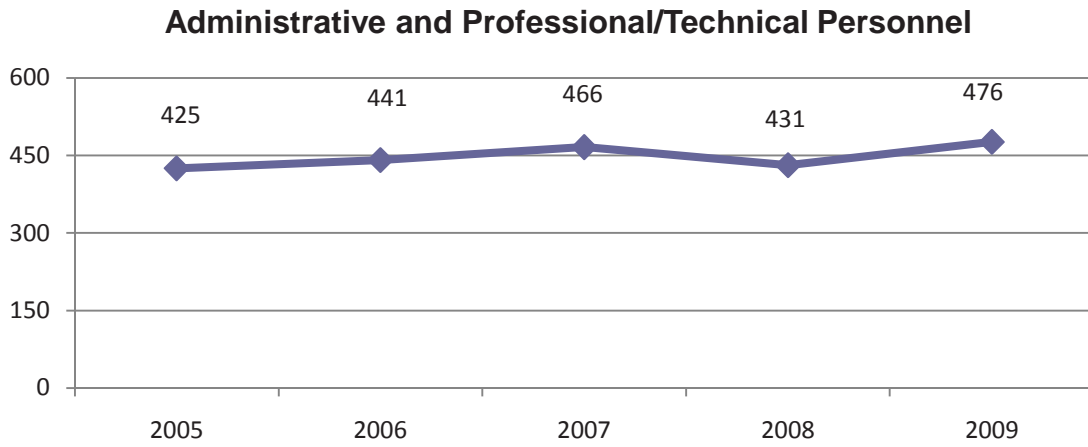

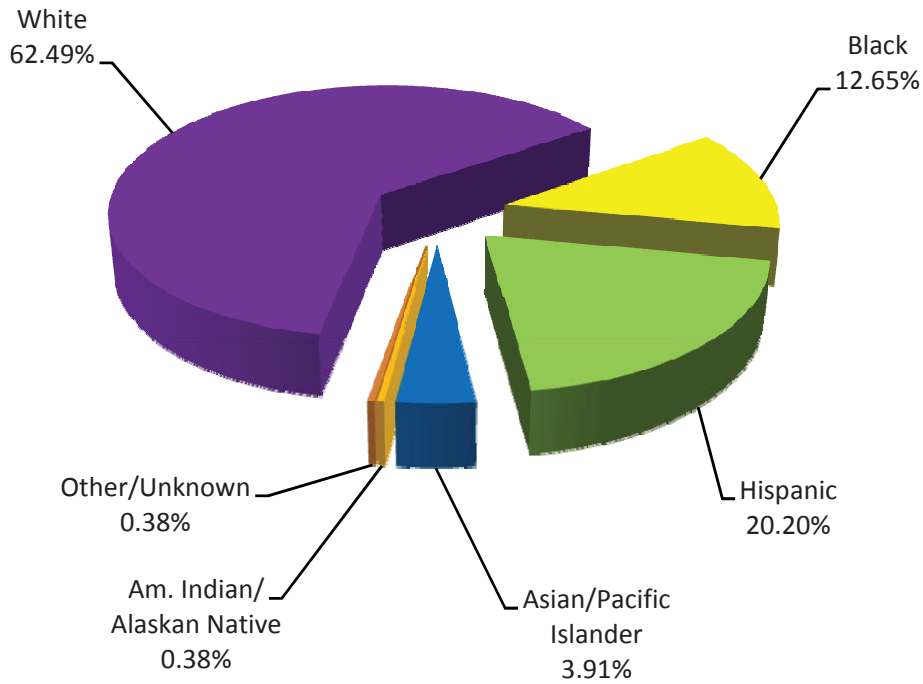

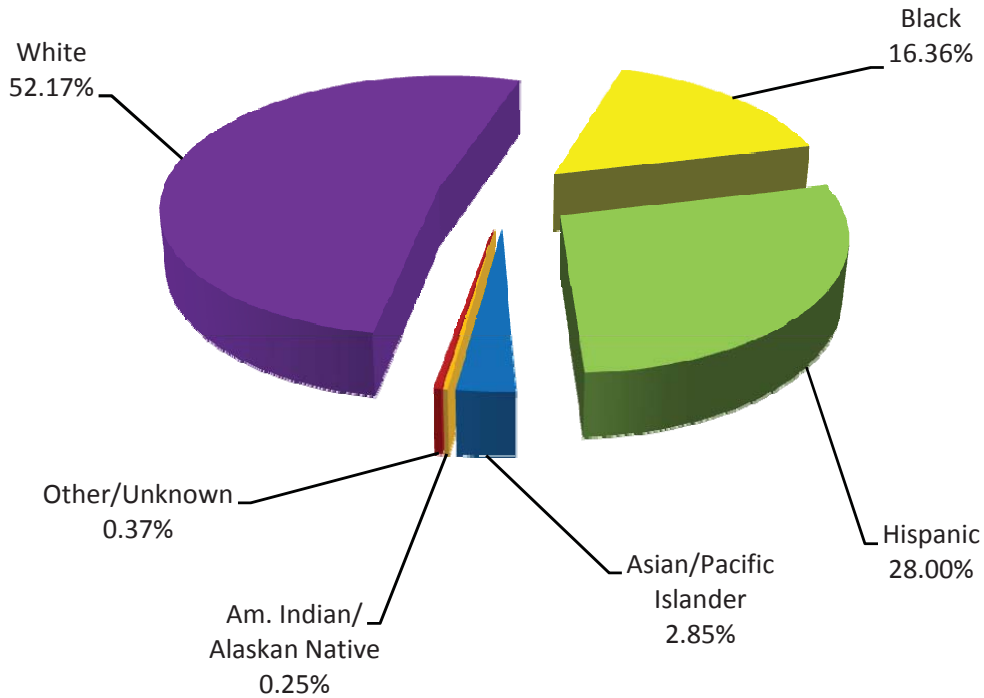

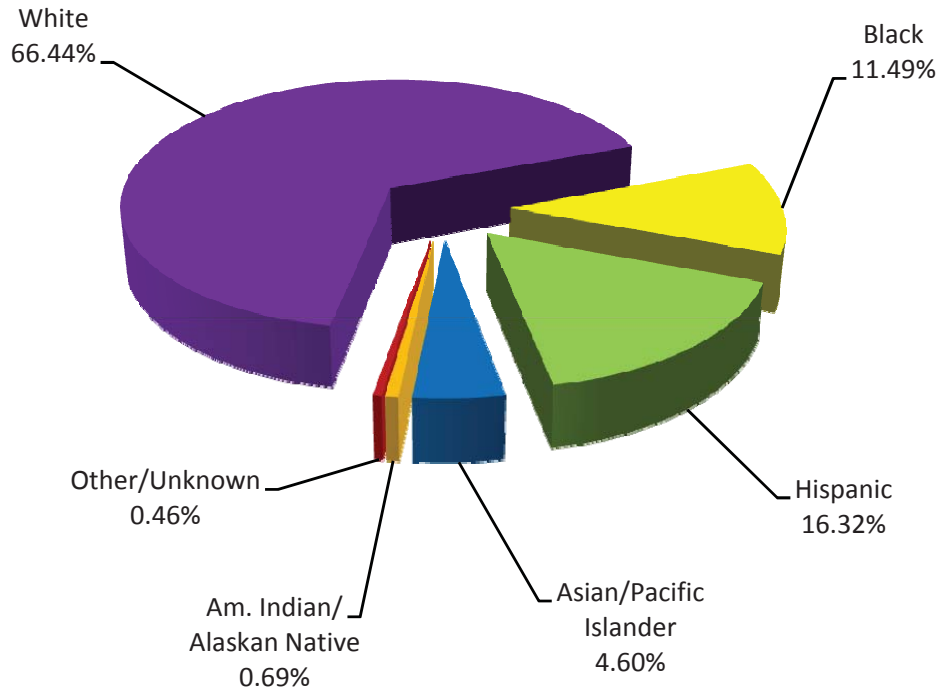

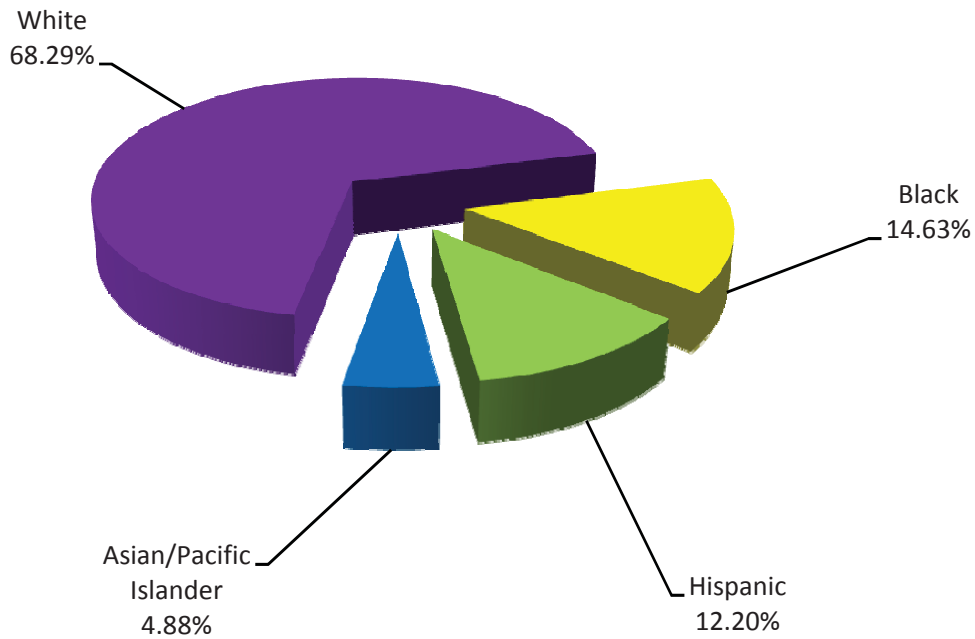

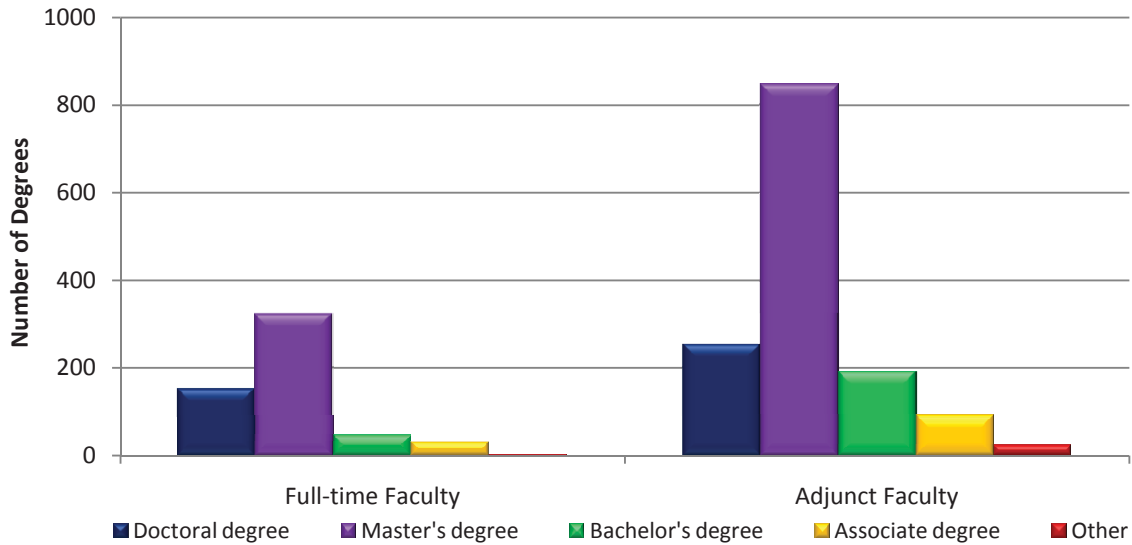

Highest Degree Earned by Faculty Type Fall 2009

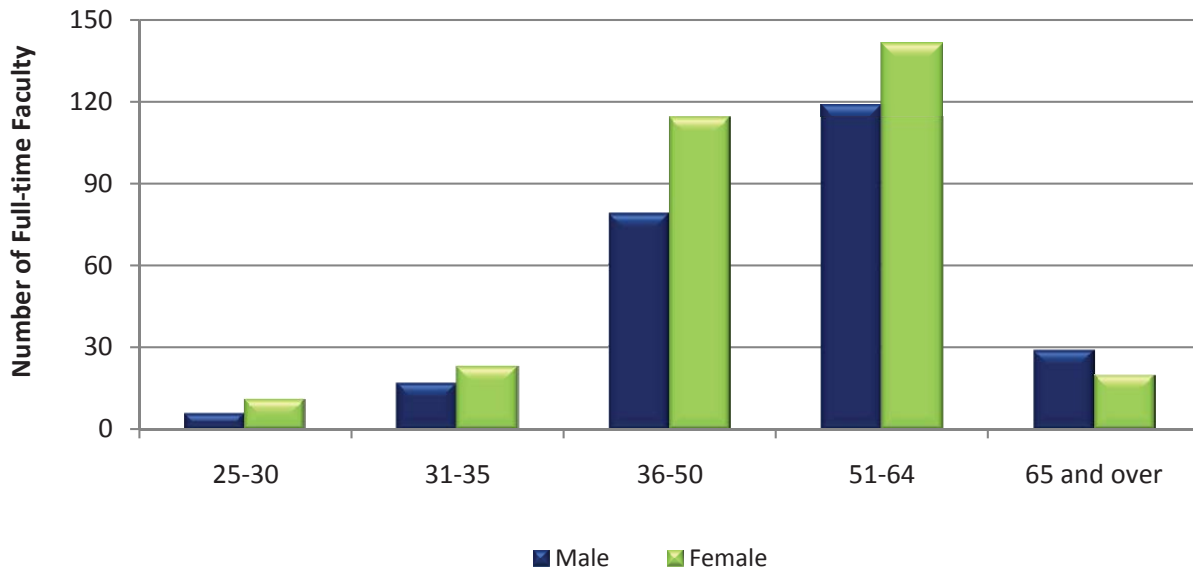

Full-time Faculty¹ by Age and Gender Fall 2009



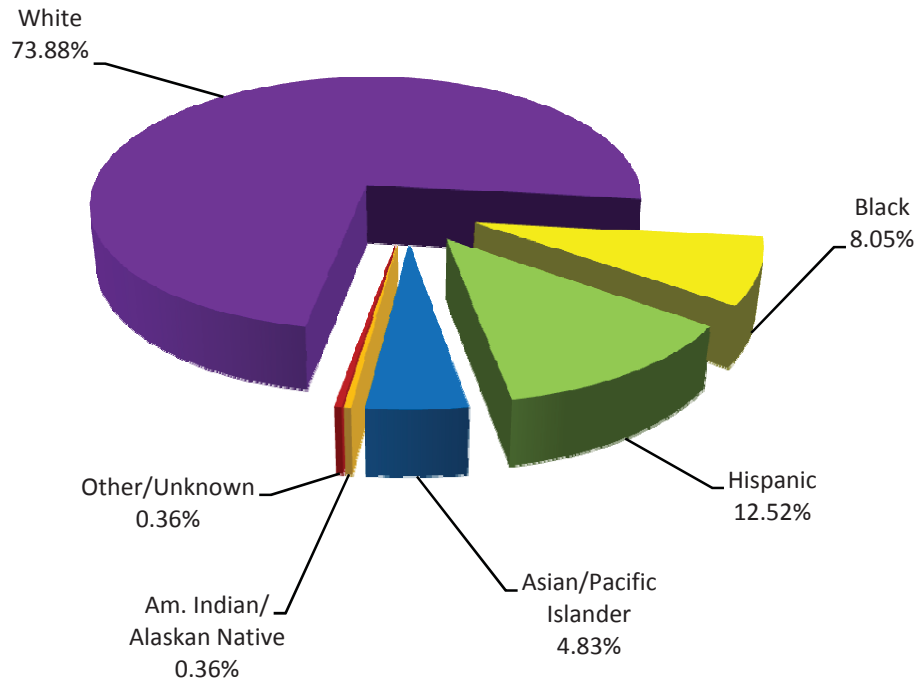

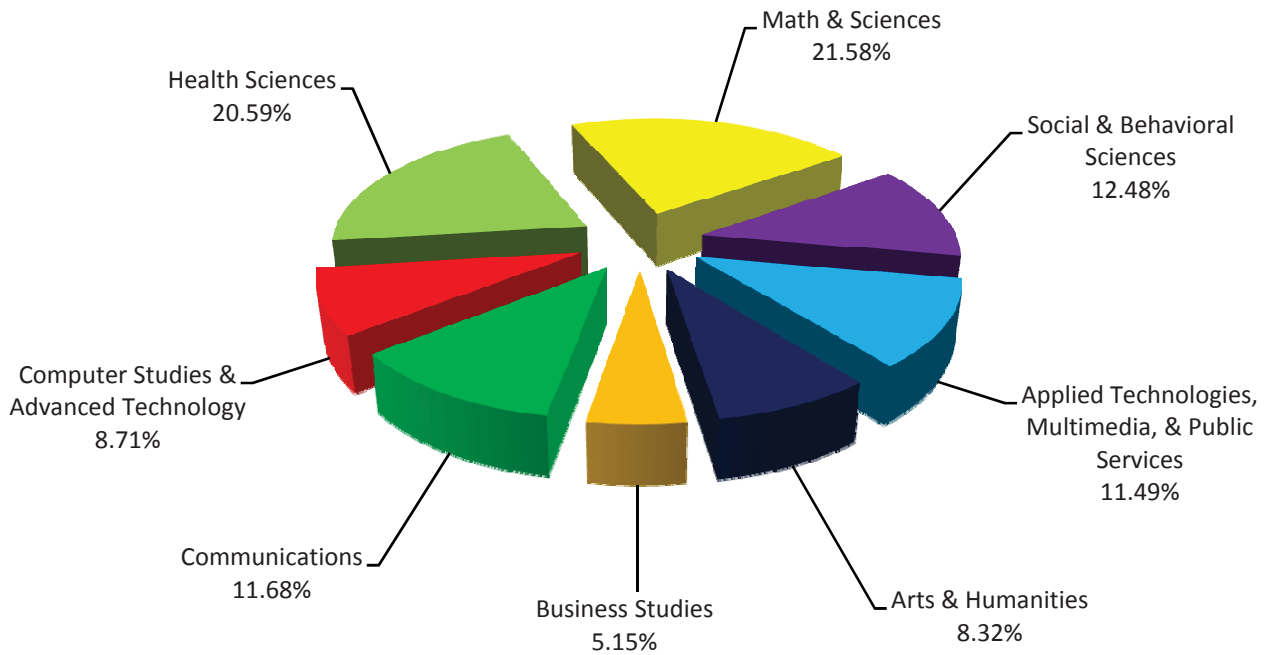

Full-time Credit Teaching Faculty by Dean Area¹ Fall 2009



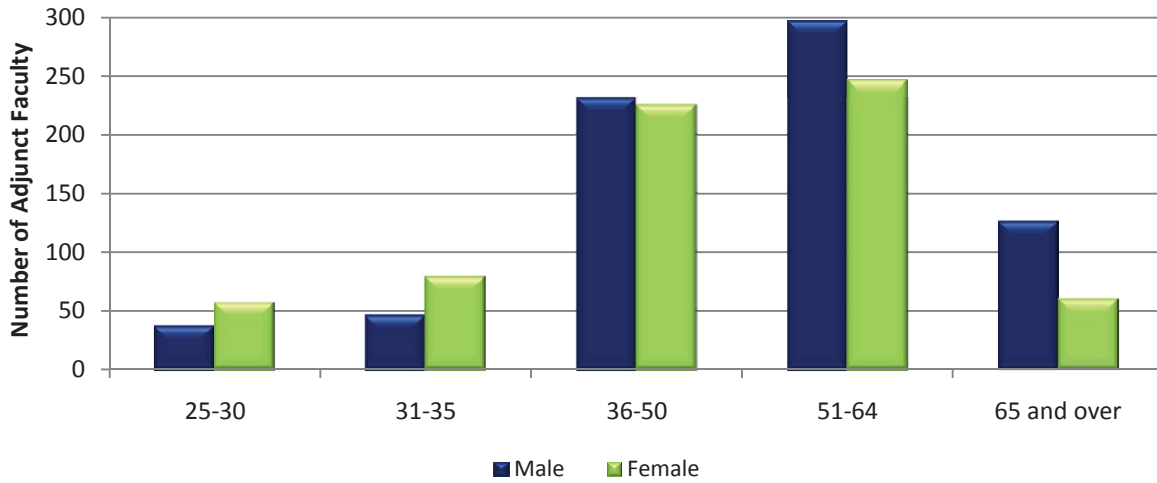

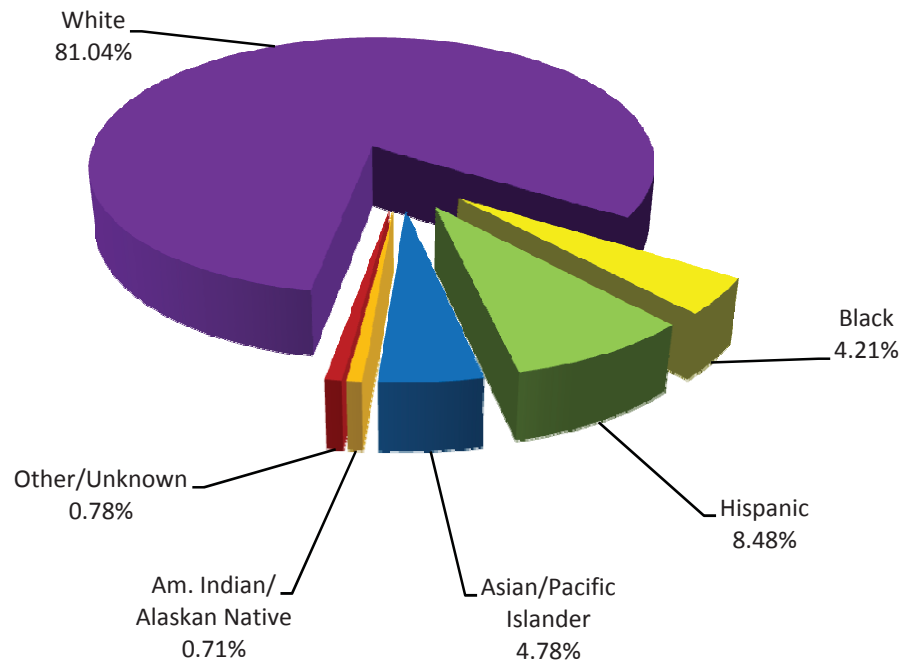

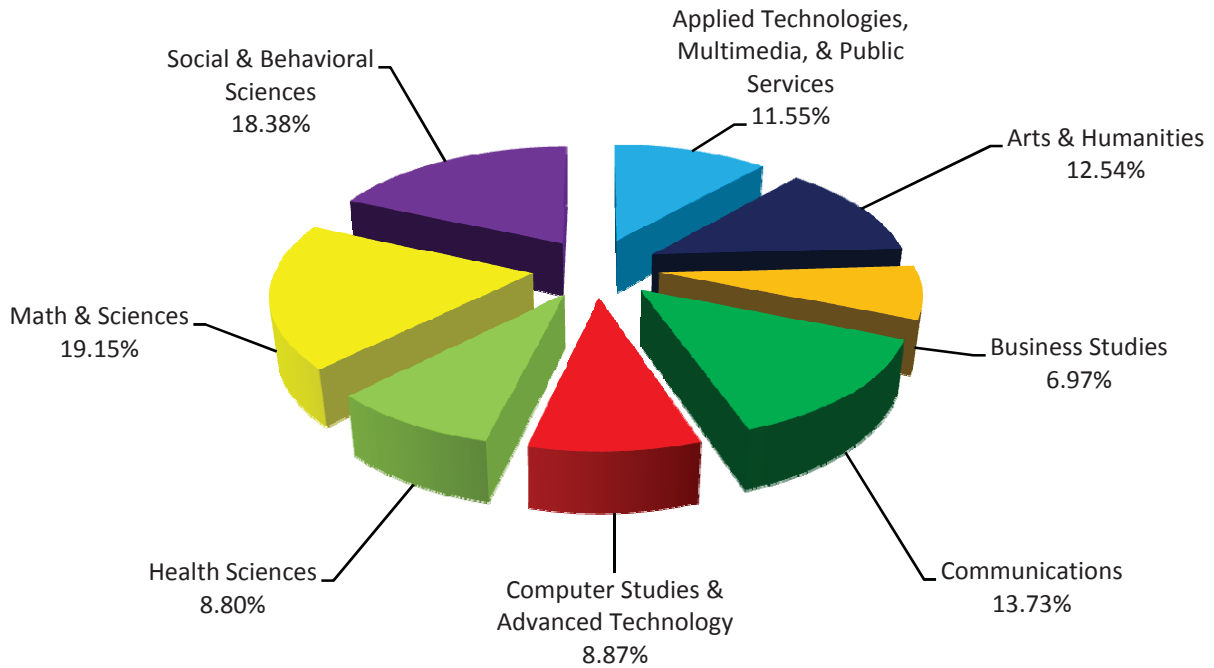

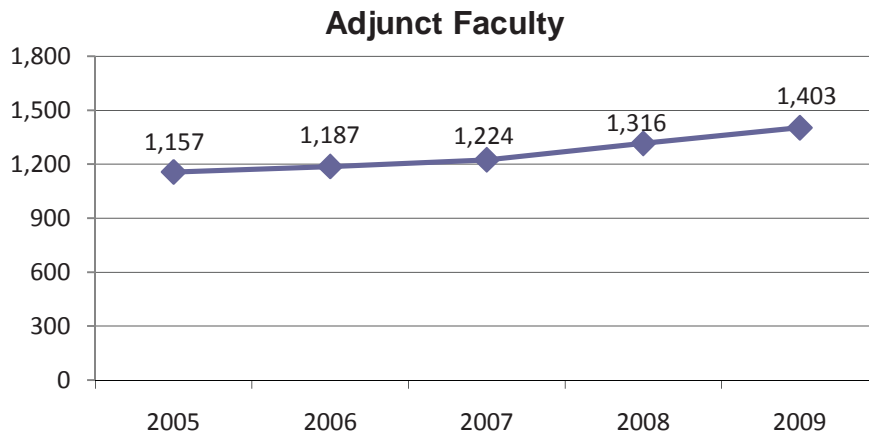
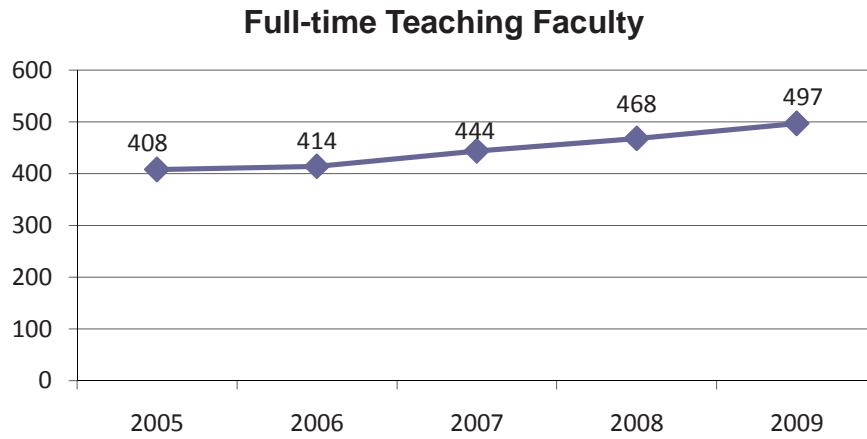
