What improvements have been planned/implemented:

Overall Eastview Campus signage improvement and installation plan. The Eastview Campus has had several renovations and department moves within FY10-12 . When renovations take place on the campus, the changes to the signage is not included as part of the project. Therefore, most of the campus internal and external directional signage need a complete overhaul to make all the necessary changes, mainly when departments have moved to a different location.
