

Notes on Uploading to Blackboard

1. Per the syllabus, program assignments uploaded to Bb must be zipped (compressed) solution/project folders which contain the entire contents of your project.
2. Usually, your project folder is under VS 2008/projects but that can be changed under Tools | Options in Visual Studio.
3. So, if you have named your project Program4, you should select the Program4 directory/folder in the VS 2008/projects directory and zip (compress) that folder. To compress, right-click and select | Send To | Compressed Folders. When the folder is zipped, it will create a file with a .zip extension.
4. Submit (upload) the .zip file to the appropriate Assignments folder in Blackboard.
5. **Highly important** - Test your submission by downloading what you have uploaded to Bb. Double-click on the .vbproj file and see if it opens VS 2008 and runs correctly. If it does not work for you, it will not work for me.
