**Posting Job Description** News 8 Austin, Time Warner's 24-hour news channel in Austin, Texas, offers UNPAID internship opportunities for college students interested in getting valuable work experience in the news industry during the SUMMER 2009 semester.

**ASSIGNMENTS**

Reporting – Shadow reporters in the field, write news stories, interview and assist in the production of news stories.

Photojournalism – Shadow photojournalists in the field, work with electronic newsgathering, lighting and audio and perform non-linear digital editing.

Producing – Shadow producers, write news, work with reporters and anchors to determine story form and content, assemble newscasts. Interns will also learn to produce stories on the News 8 Austin website.

Sports - Shadow sports staff, write sports, monitor and log sports videos and work on videotape editing.

Graphics - Work closely with television graphic designer

Promotions/Human Resources - Work with Promotions Manager and HR Generalist on advertising, promotional events, job fairs, and recruiting. Proficiency with Microsoft Word, Powerpoint, and Excel are required.

Online Content/Web - A unique opportunity to practice your AP-style and work on your own writing style. We are not exactly print, nor magazine, nor TV news style...we're a combination of all three.

Broadcast Engineering - An opportunity for CAD and electrical engineering students to gain hands-on experience.

IT - An opportunity to learn system administration, desktop support, and web support by working in the IT department.

Production - Work closely with master control operators and technical directors with video and audio transmission and quality control of on-air content.

Weather - Work closely with meteorologists reporting local weather.

**QUALIFICATIONS**

Candidates for intern positions MUST:

1. Be enrolled in a degree program (associate's, bachelor's, master's or doctorate) and in good academic standing.
2. Receive academic credits for the internship.

A successful intern will need to have a "learning attitude" as News 8 Austin staff will often teach the skills needed for various tasks. The intern will work independently at times, and as a team member at others.

**EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE**

Course work and previous internship experience in TV production, journalism, information technology, electrical engineering, human resources management, advertising, graphic design, or photojournalism preferred.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURES**

1. Interested students must submit a cover letter and resume online at [www.timewarnercable.jobs](http://www.timewarnercable.jobs) before April 1, 2009 and before all the intern positions are filled.
2. Please specify the areas you are interested in and the rationale in the cover letter.
3. Pre-selected candidates will be requested to send an academic letter, which authorizes them to do the internship for academic credits.
4. Pre-selected candidates will then be invited to an onsite interview.
