

Goals and Process of Student Access Success Committee Grant

The SASC grant is a simple mechanism to help support or fund faculty and staff initiatives to improve ACC students' access and success.

Steps for the SASC Grant

1. Submit a typed, copy of the grant application to SASC Grant Committee for approval (fax: 223-7052 or via intercampus mail: HBC 504.4)
2. Implement project within a time frame of 1 year.
3. Complete and submit Status Report to SASC Grant Committee at midway point.
4. Complete and submit Final Report 1 month after completion of project.
5. Present project and outcomes to SASC Committee within 6 months of project end.

SASC Grant Questions

Who can apply for a grant?

All ACC employees are encouraged to apply. They may apply individually or in partnership with community or students.

What are the criteria for the grant?

A sustainable project or activity that will result in improved enrollment, retention, or completion in ACC courses or programs. The projects maybe be funded up to \$2,500. final report as well as a verbal report presented to the SASC Committee within 6 months of the project ending.

Where will the project take place?

Wherever it is appropriate to implement the project.

When does the grant have to be completed?

One year from initial grant disbursement date.

Why does the grant exist?

The grant supports ACC's efforts in the Closing the Gaps initiative to improve student access and success by drawing on ACC's wealth of creative ideas within its own college community.

How is a grant approved?

Applications are submitted to the SASC Grant Committee and the committee reviews and approves proposals on a monthly basis.
