

Effectiveness Update



Adult Education Effectiveness Measures Report for Academic Year 2000-01

PURPOSE

To Improve educational opportunities for adults who lack the level of literacy skills requisite to effective citizenship.

INTENDED OUTCOME

1. Adults who need basic education skills necessary for literacy functioning will complete the literacy program.

CRITERIA

Based on data reported to the State

1a. Fifteen percent (15%) of Beginning Literacy-Adult Basic Education (ABE) students will advance to intermediate level ABE courses.

1b. Seventeen percent (17%) of Beginning Literacy –English as a Second Language (ESL) students will advance to intermediate level ABE courses.

1.c Twenty percent (20%) of Beginning ABE students will advance to intermediate level ABE courses.

1d. Twenty-two percent (22%) of Beginning ESL students will advance to intermediate level ABE courses.

RESULTS

Based on data reported to the Texas Education Agency, none of the criteria for this outcome were met this year.

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INTENDED OUTCOME

2. Adults who complete intermediate basic education will have sufficient basic education to enable them to benefit from job training and retraining programs and obtain productive employment

CRITERIA

- 2a. Twenty-three percent (23%) of Intermediate ABE students will advance to advanced level ABE courses.
2b. Twenty-three percent (23%) of Intermediate ESL students will advance to advanced level ABE courses

RESULTS

Based on data reported to the Texas Education Agency, none of the criteria for this outcome were met during the 1999-2000 year.

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INTENDED OUTCOME

3. Adults who desire to continue their education will advance to at least the level of completion of secondary school.

CRITERION

Thirty percent (30%) of Advanced ABE students will obtain a GED.

RESULTS

Based on data reported to the state, the criterion for this outcome, that 30% of Advanced ABE students would obtain a GED, was met during the 1999-2000 year, with 61.3% of Advanced ABE students obtaining a GED.

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INTENDED OUTCOME

4. Students who take ABE classes will complete the initial 12 hours of class.

CRITERION

Eighty percent (80%) of all students enrolled in ABE classes at ACC will complete the initial 12 hours of class.

RESULTS

Based on data reported to the Texas Education Agency, the criterion for this outcome was not met during the 1999-2000 year.
