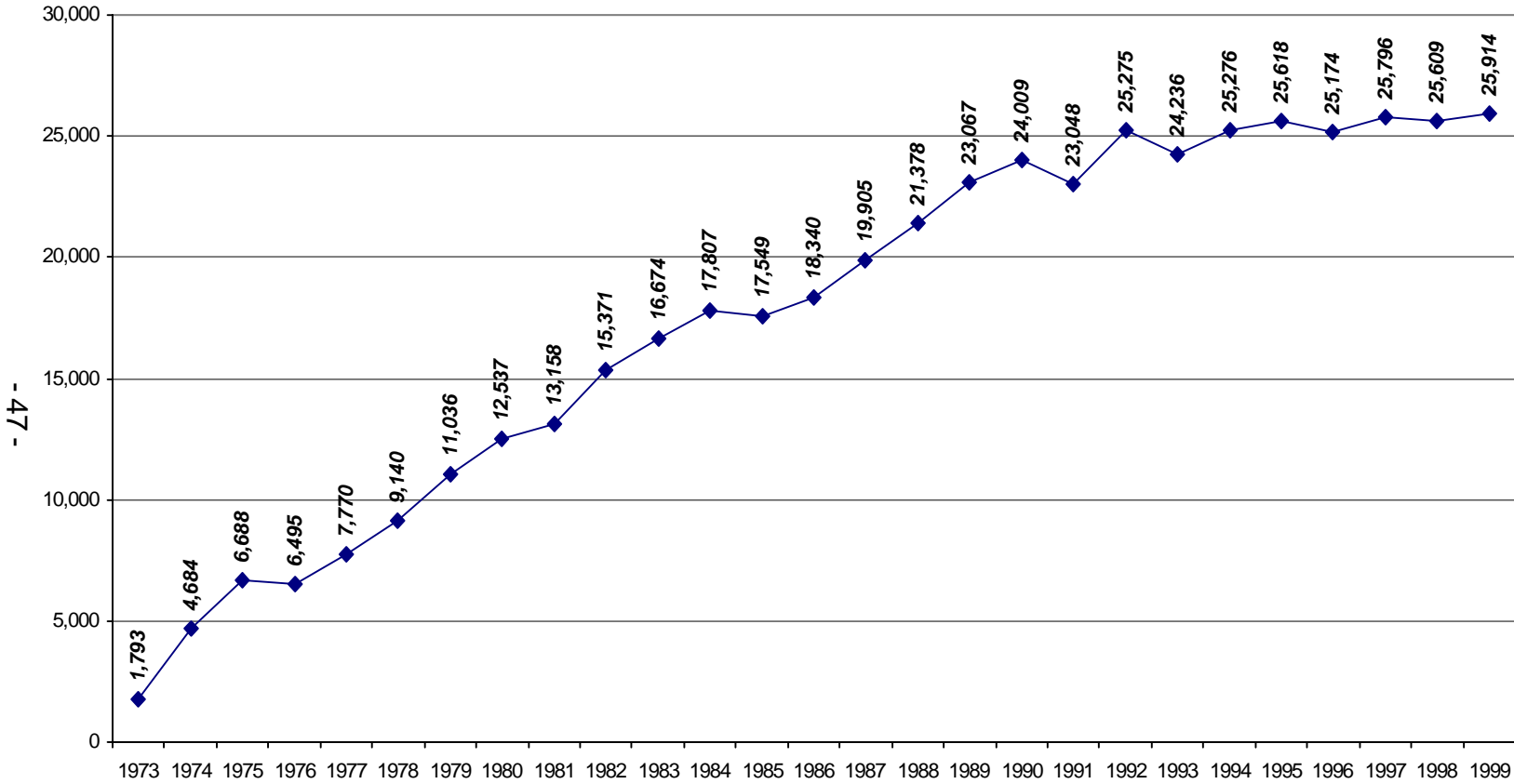

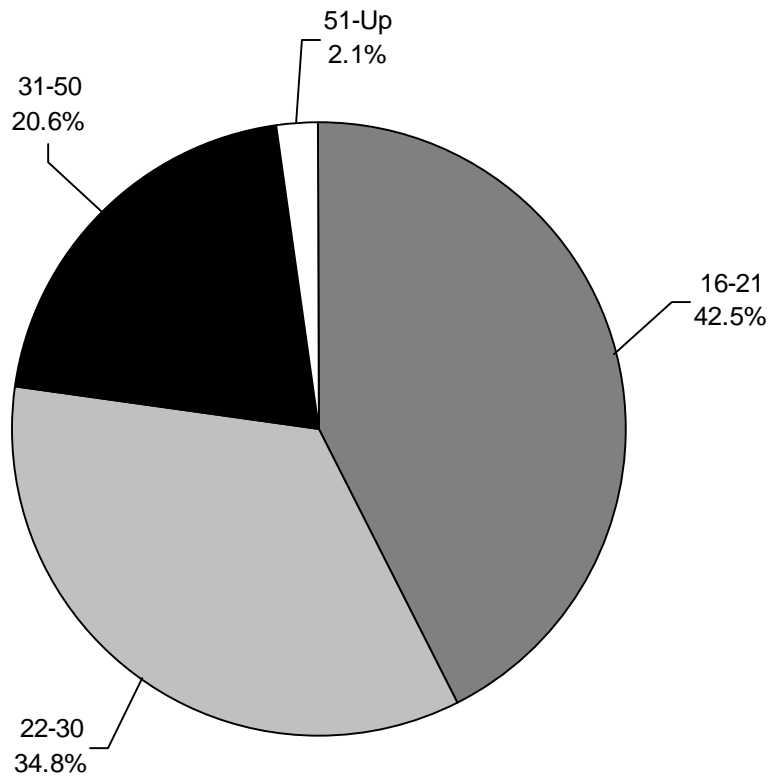
## Fall Credit Student Headcount 1973 - 1999

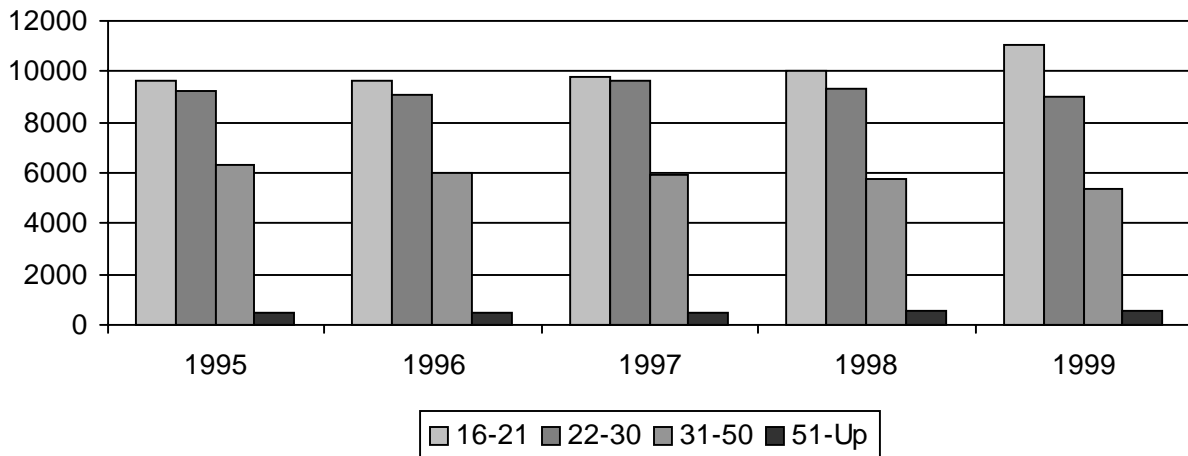

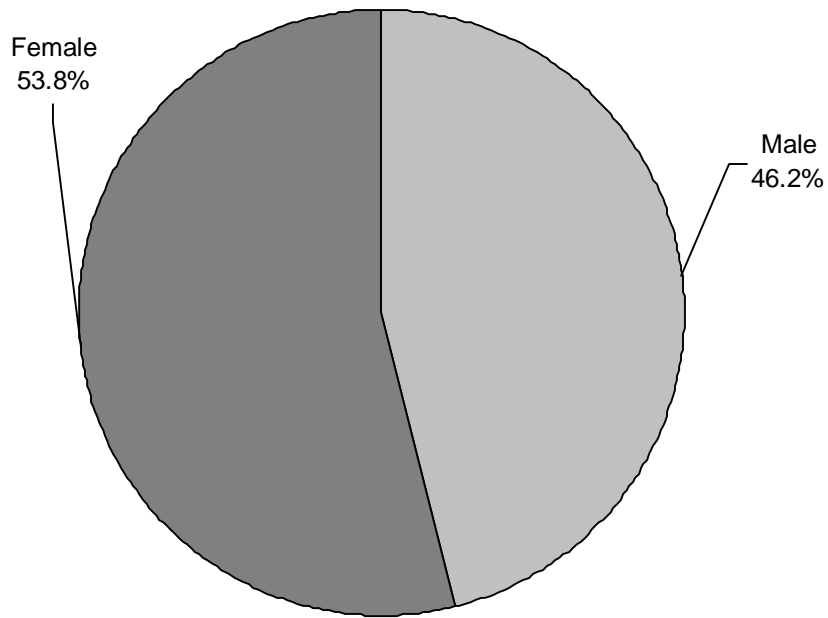

Fall 1999**

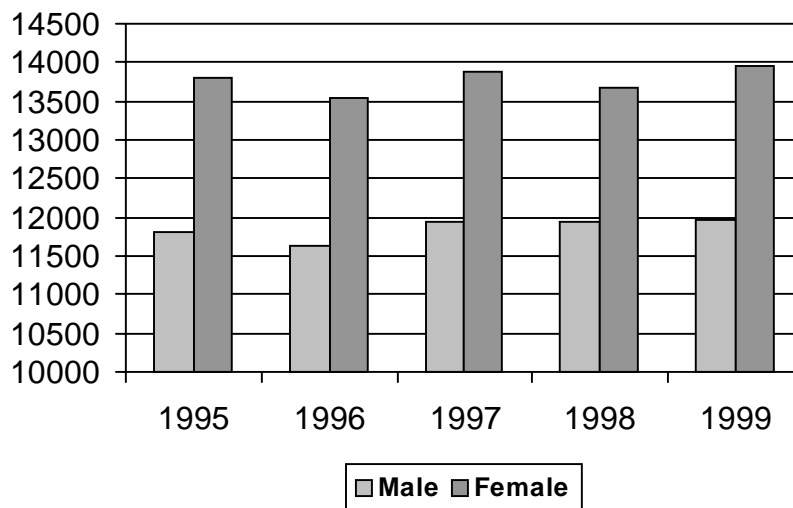

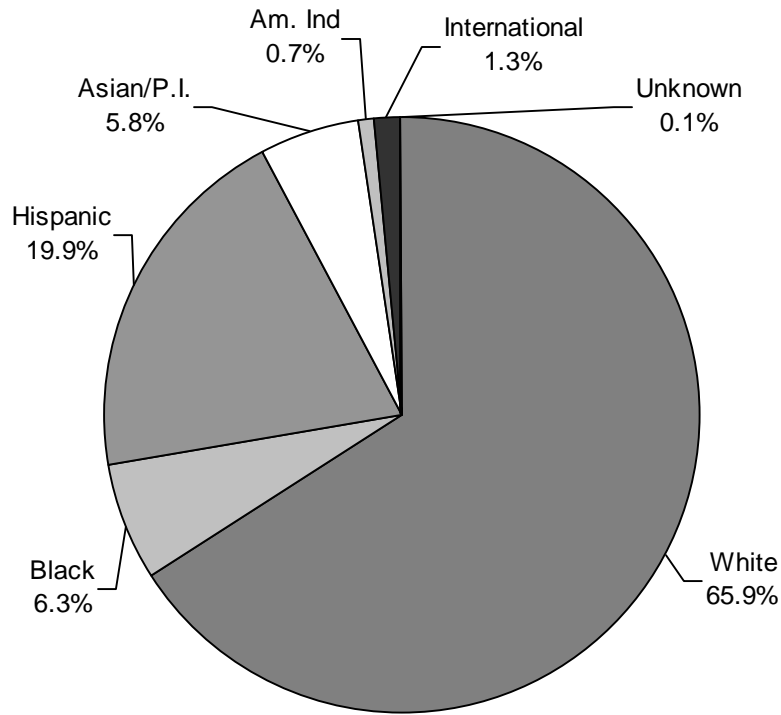

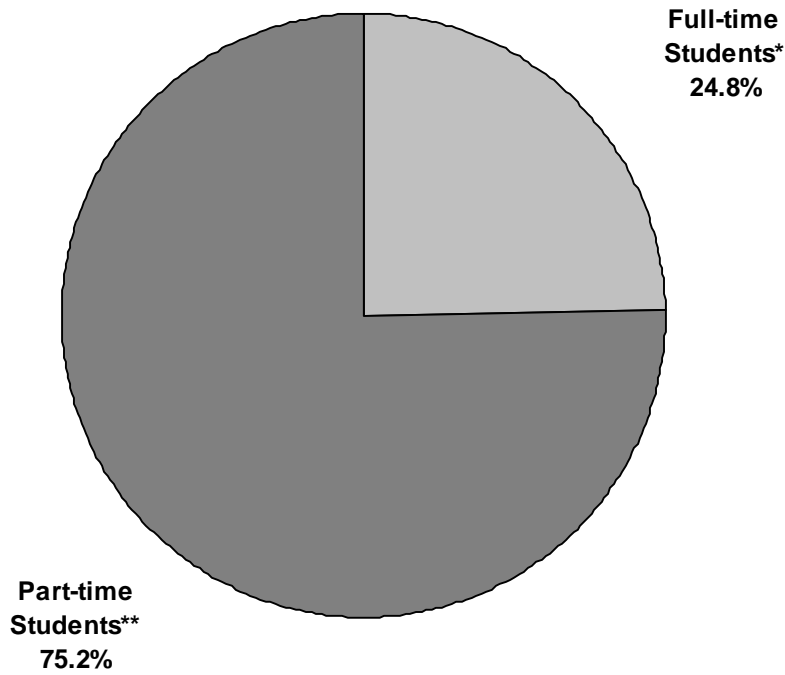

Fall 1999**



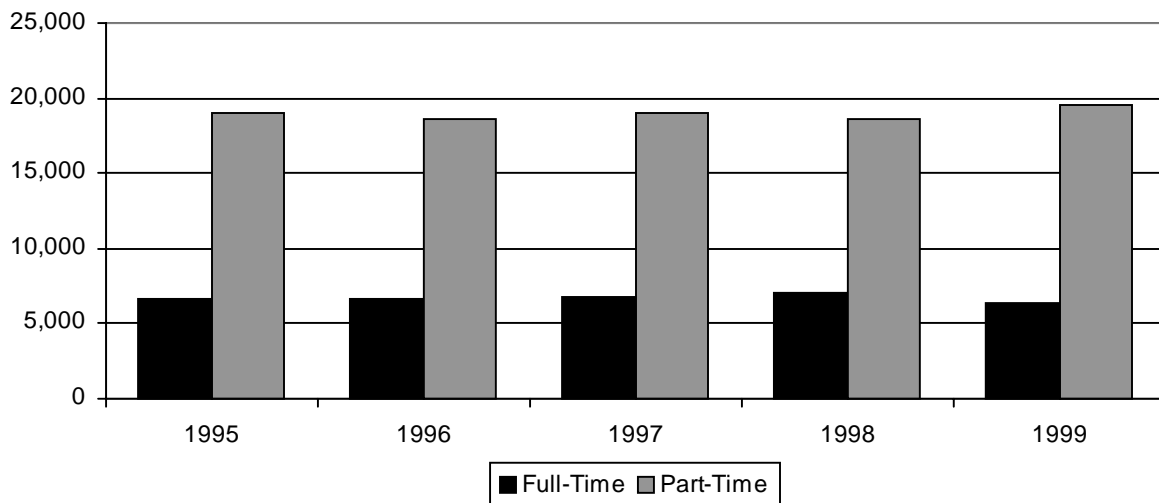

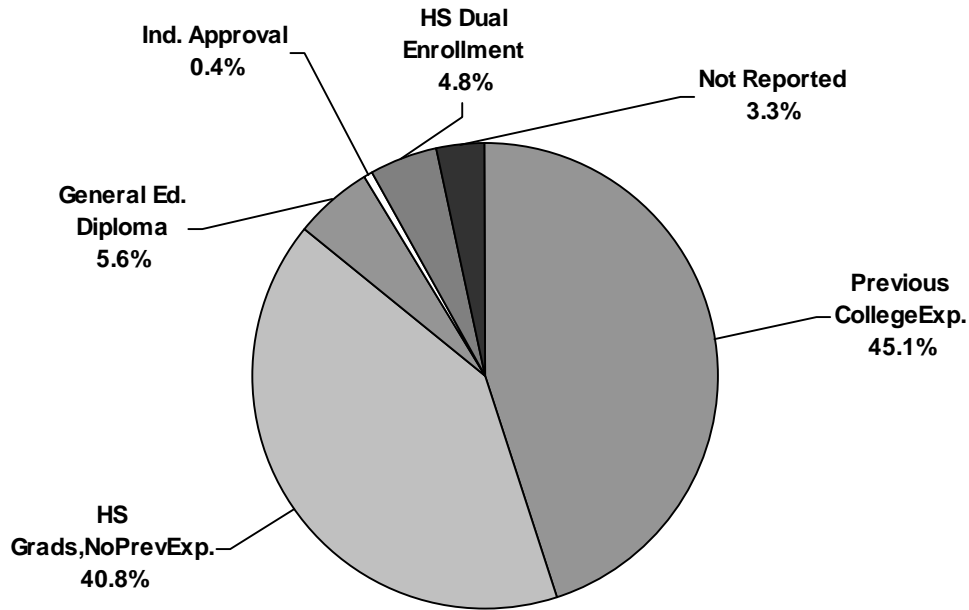

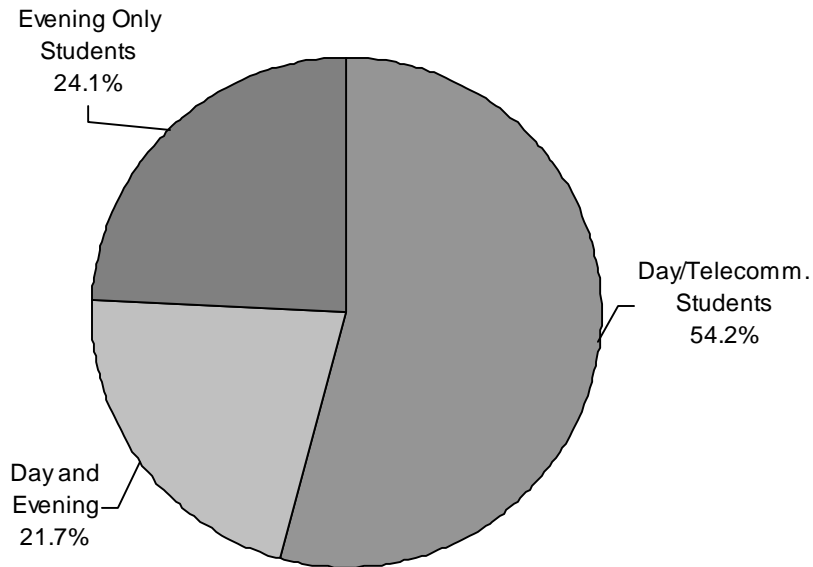

### Student Characteristics Headcount by Day/Evening Classification Fall 1999



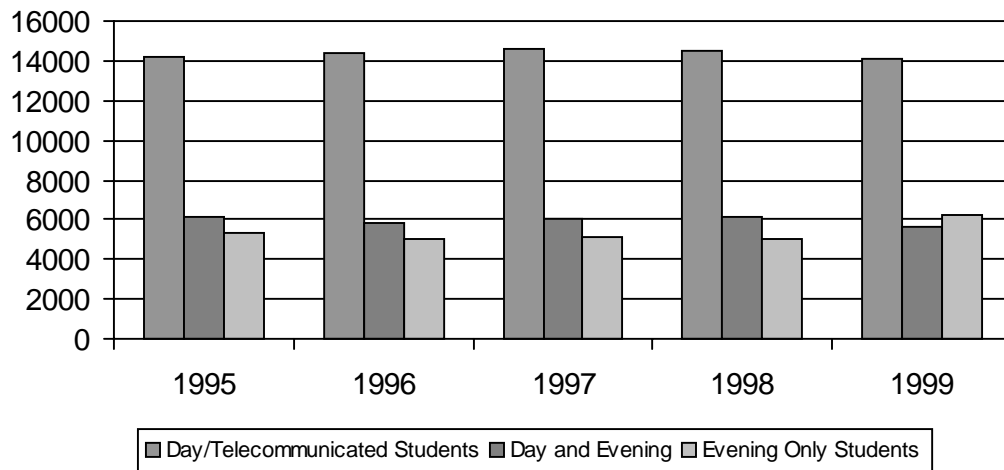

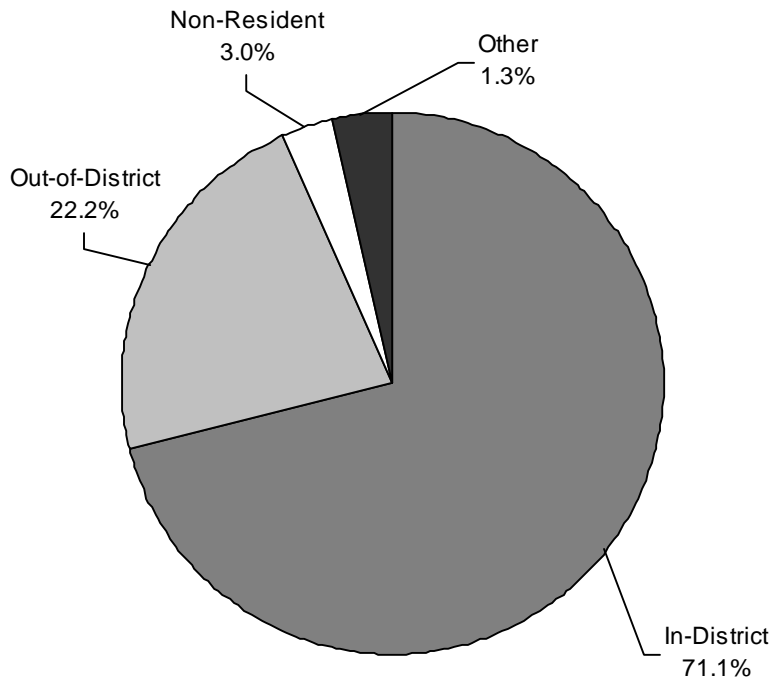

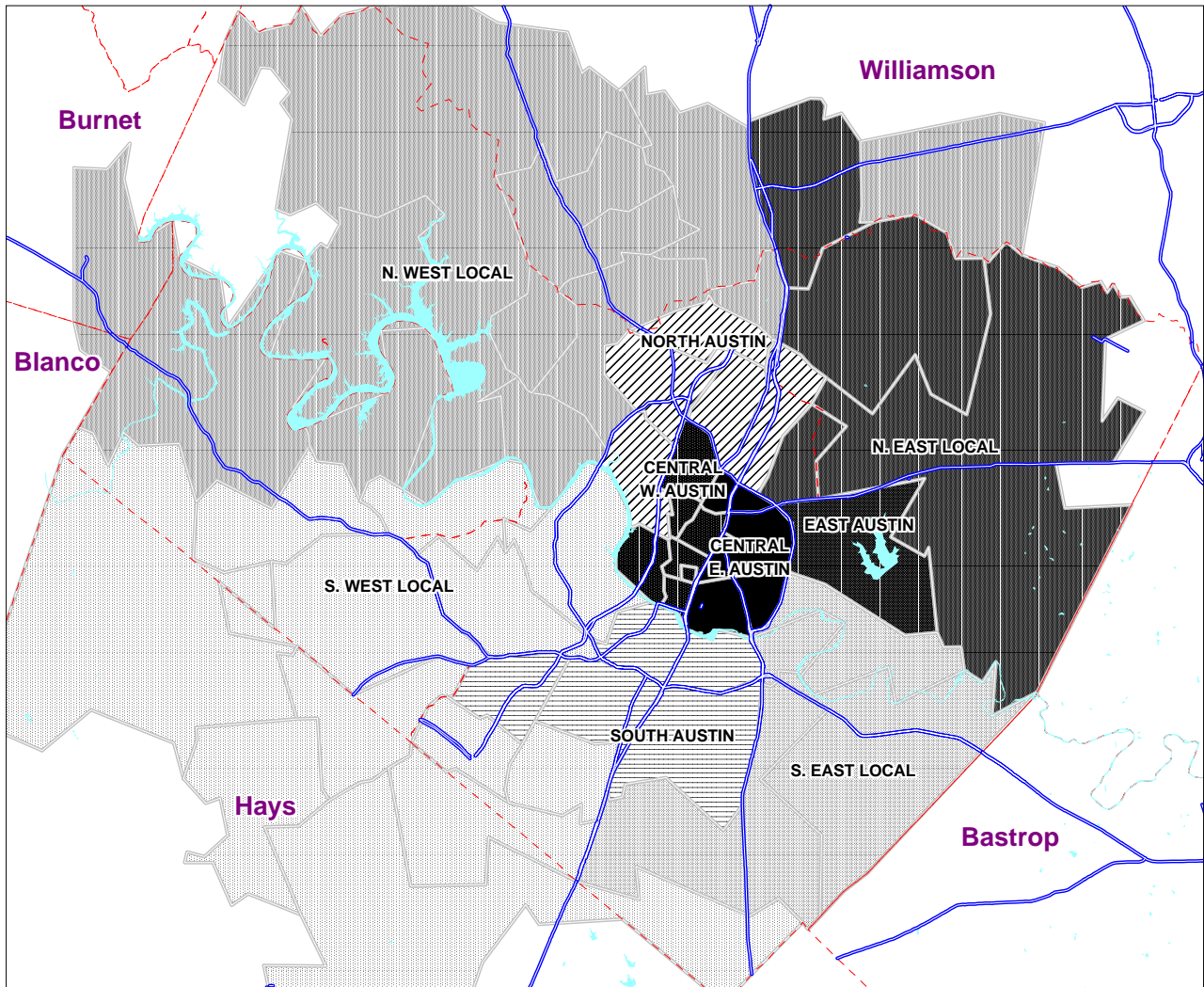

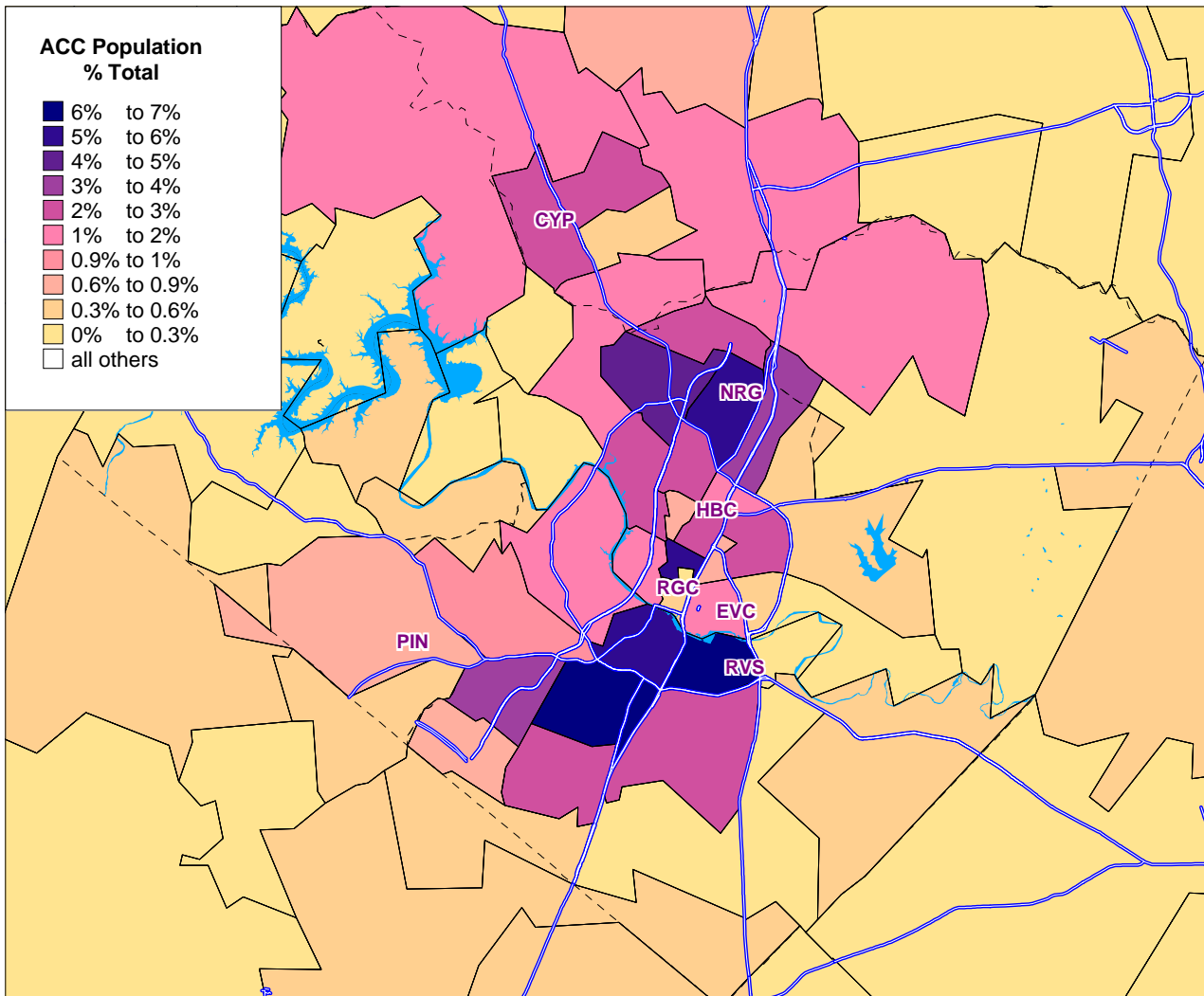

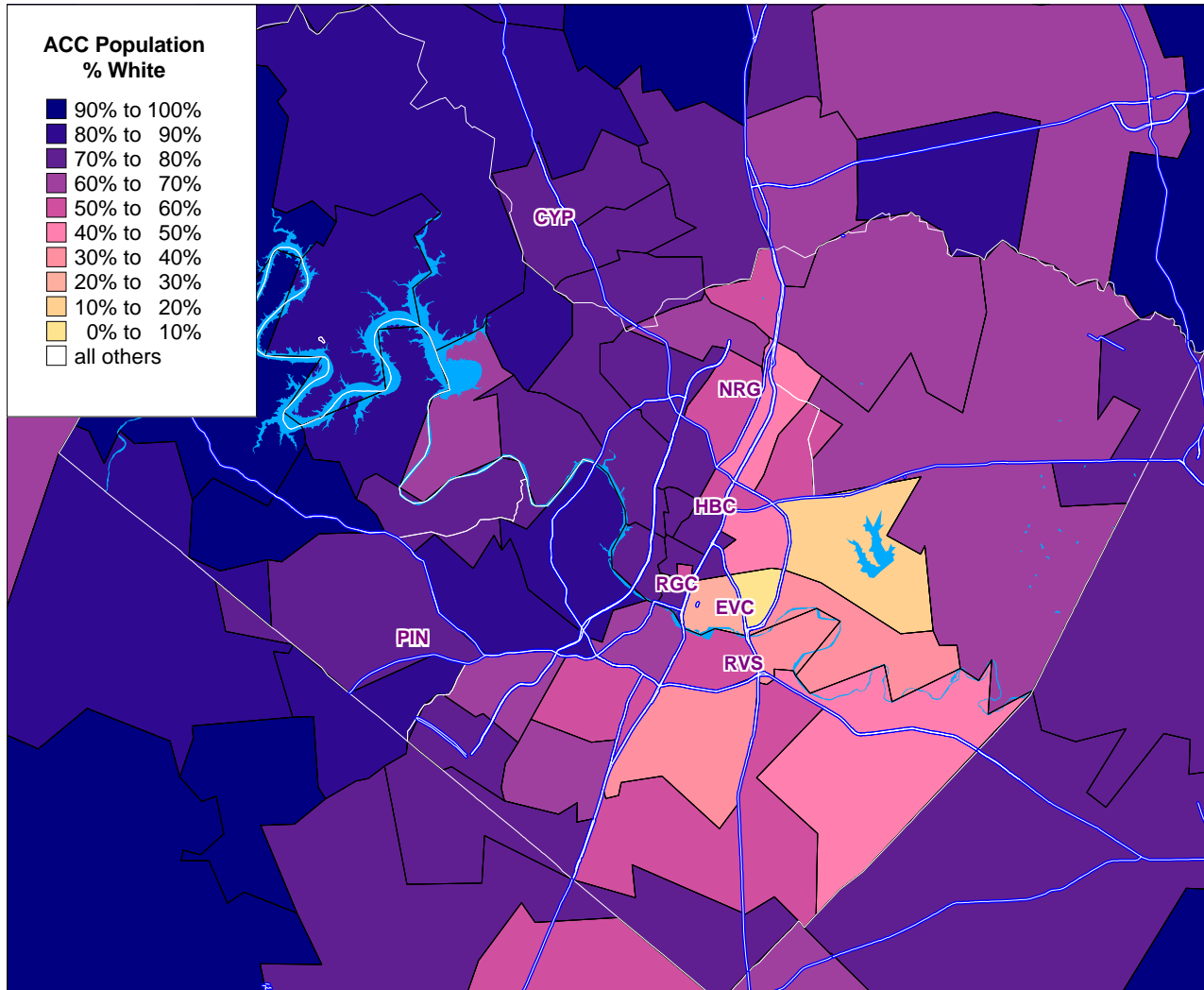

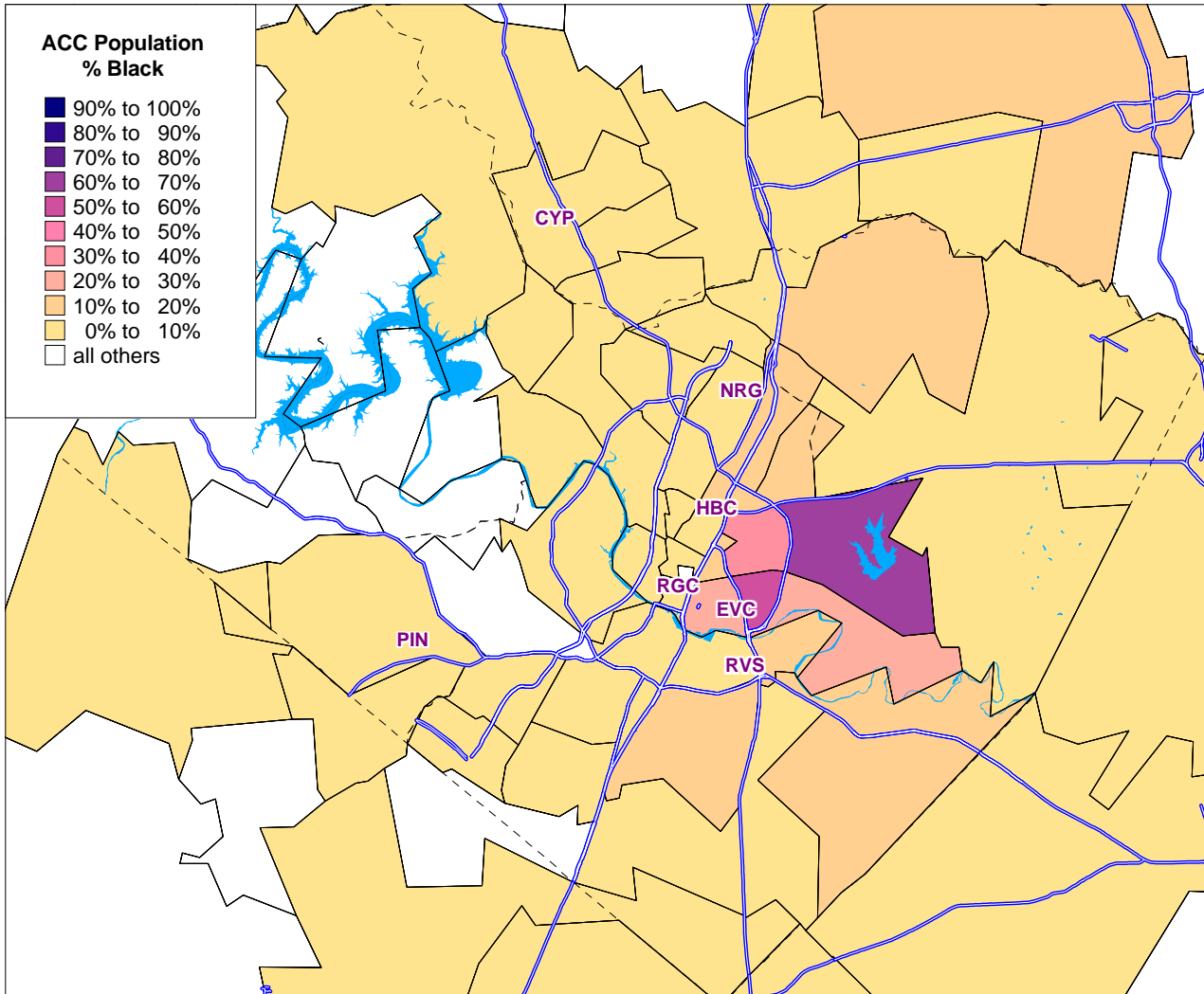

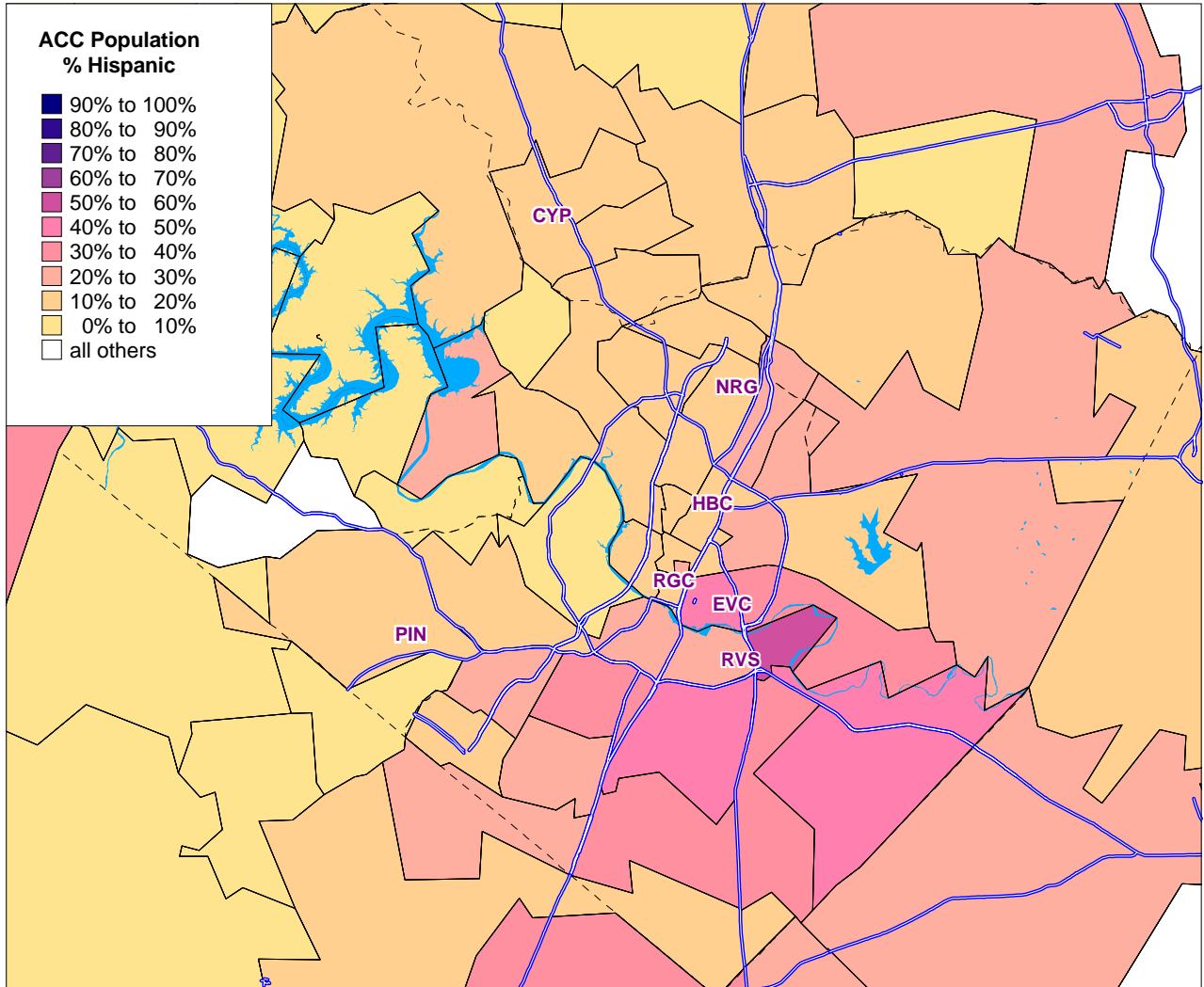
