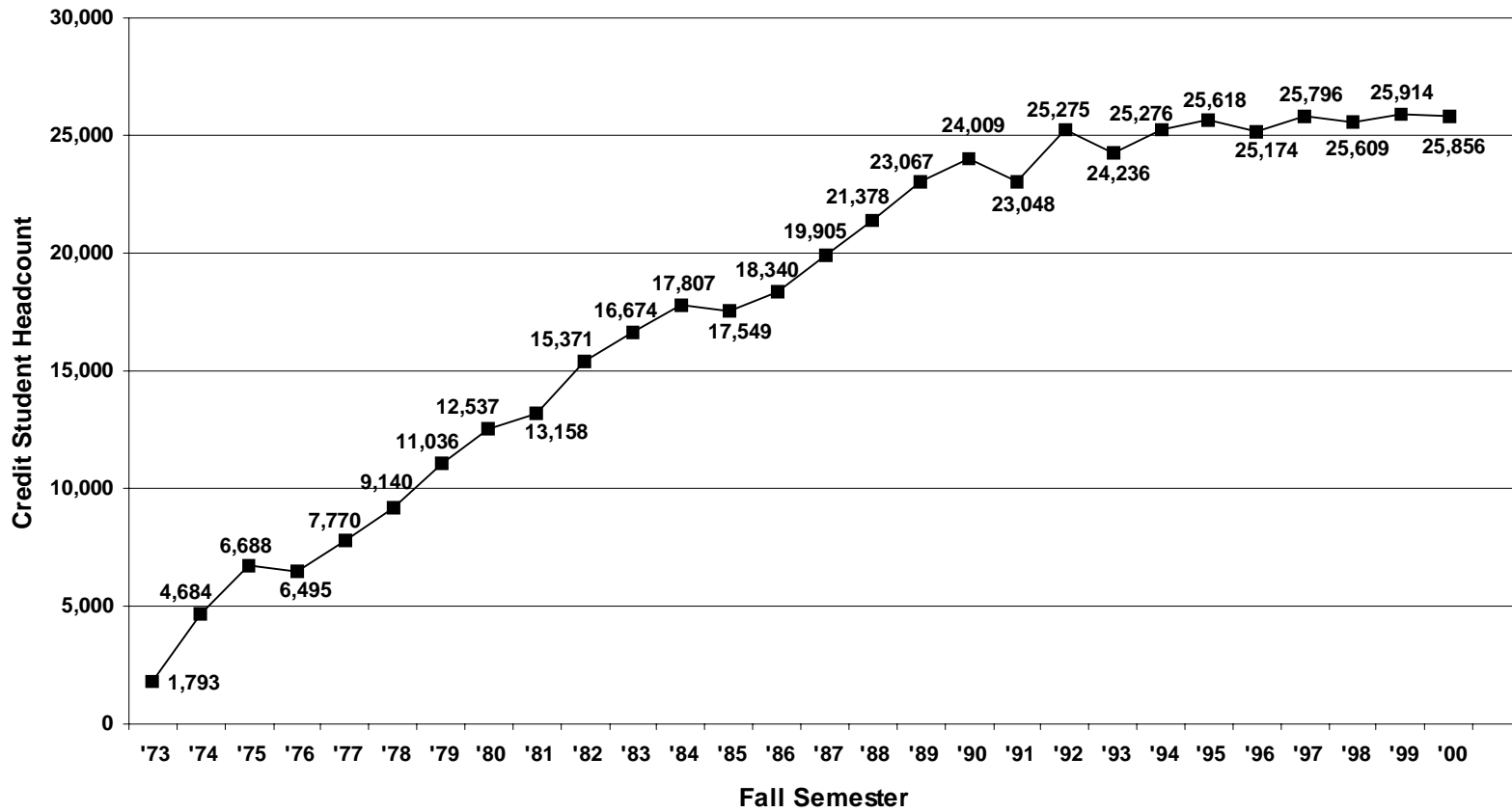


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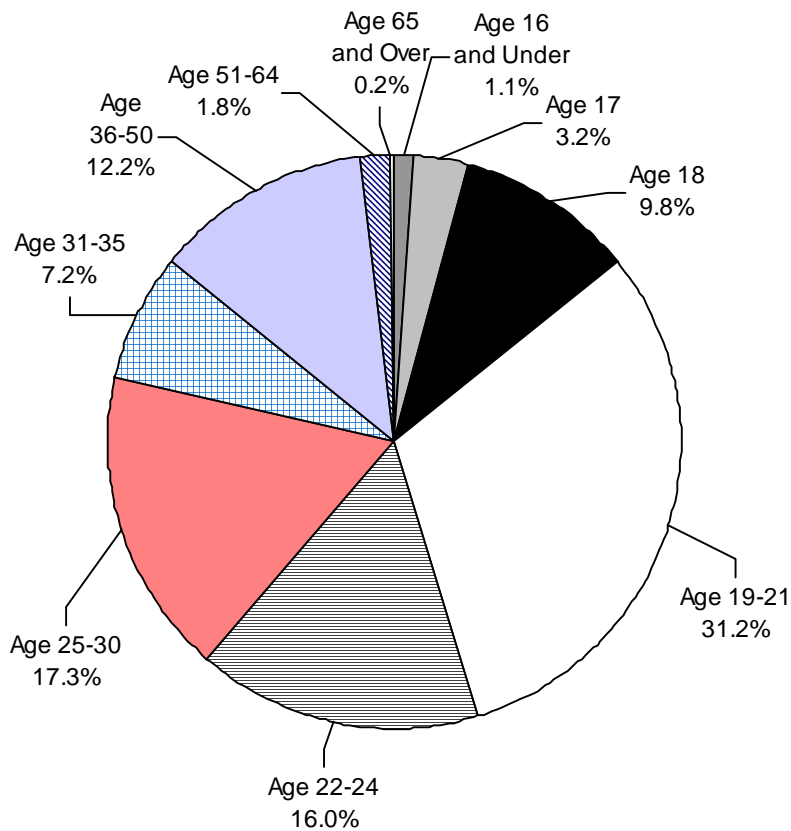
## Credit Student Headcount Fall 1973 - 2000

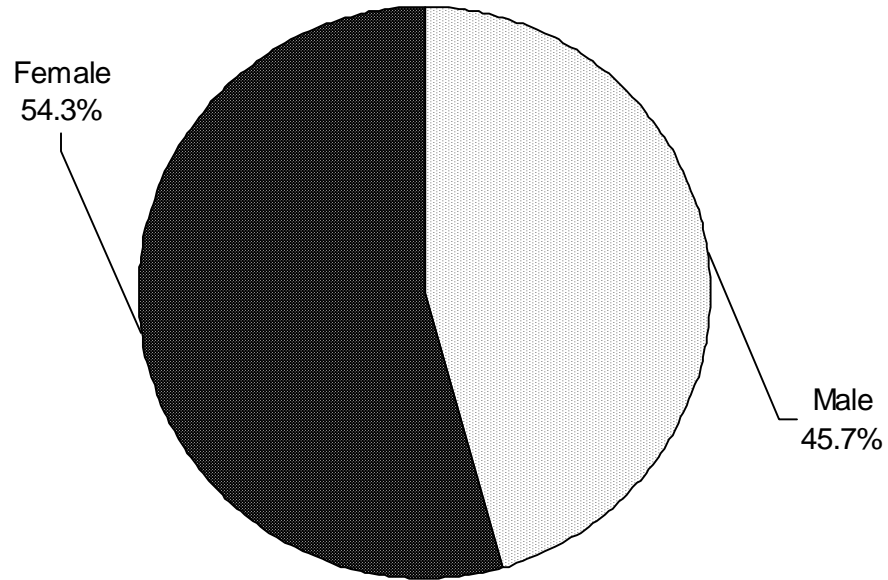

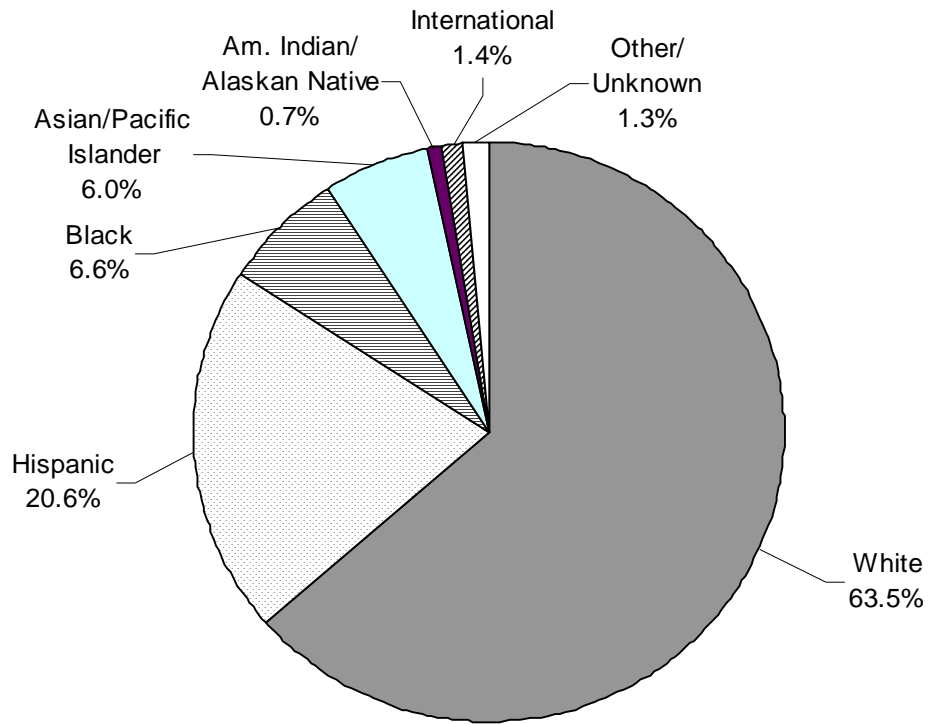

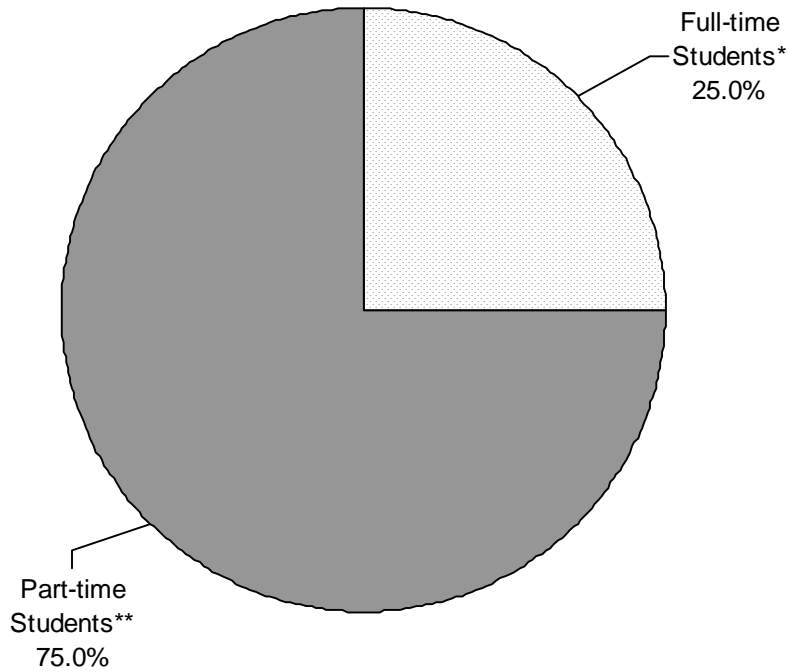

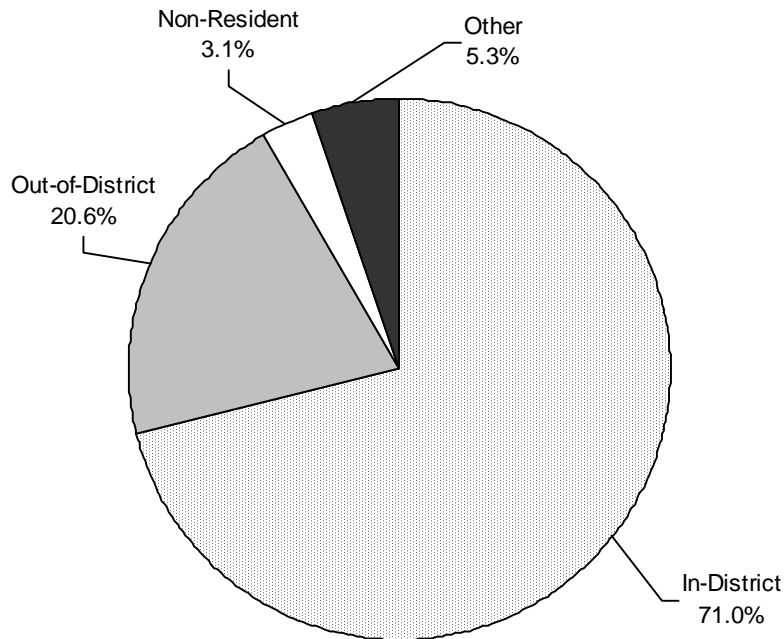

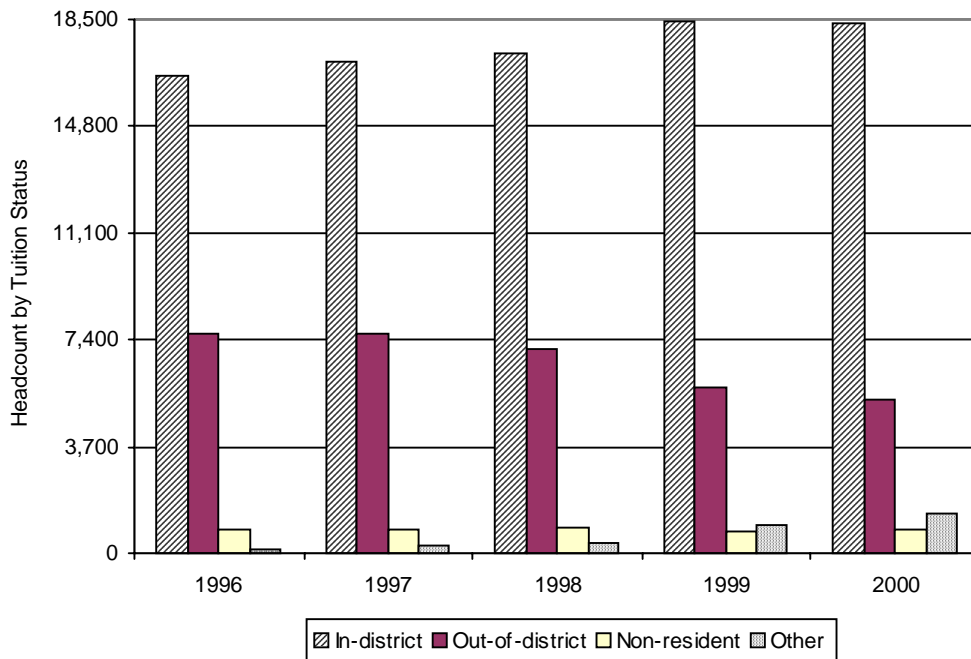

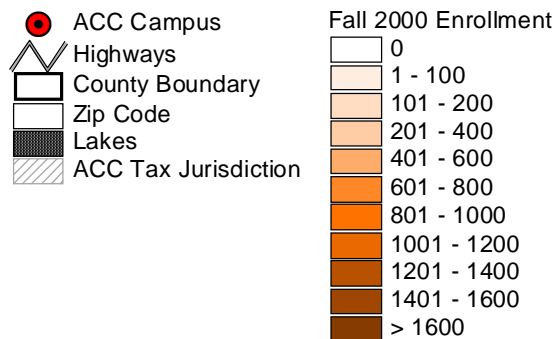

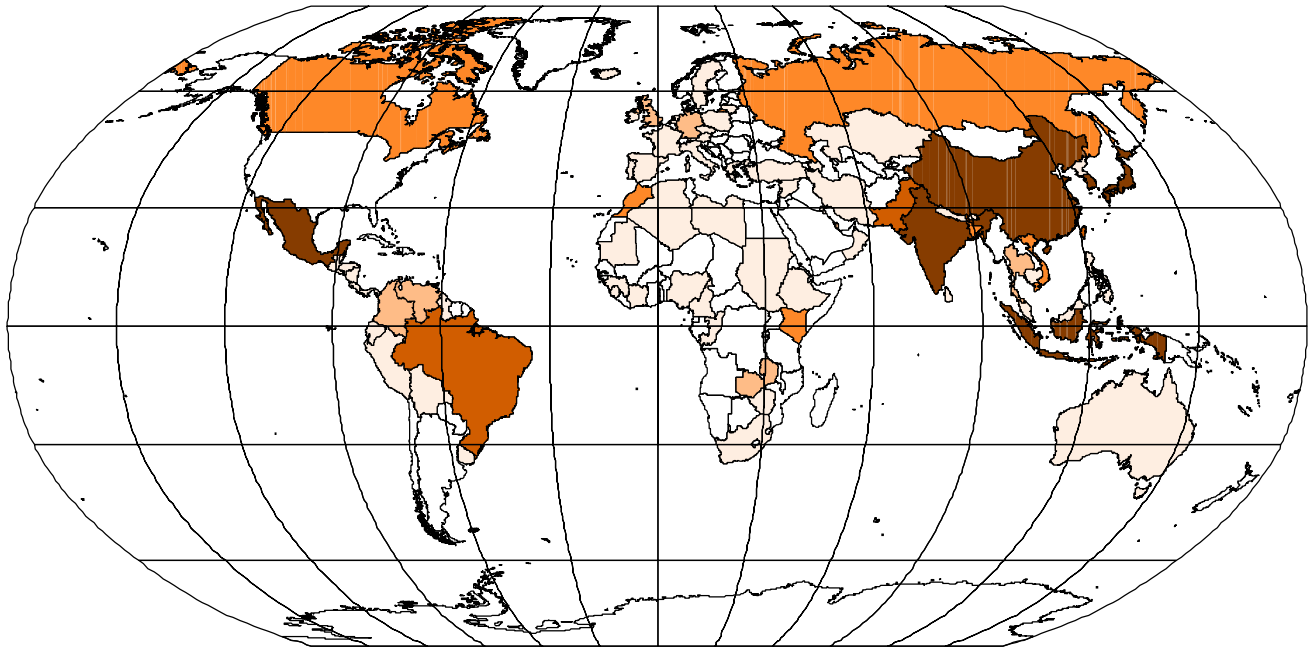

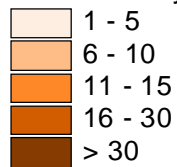

### International Students by Country



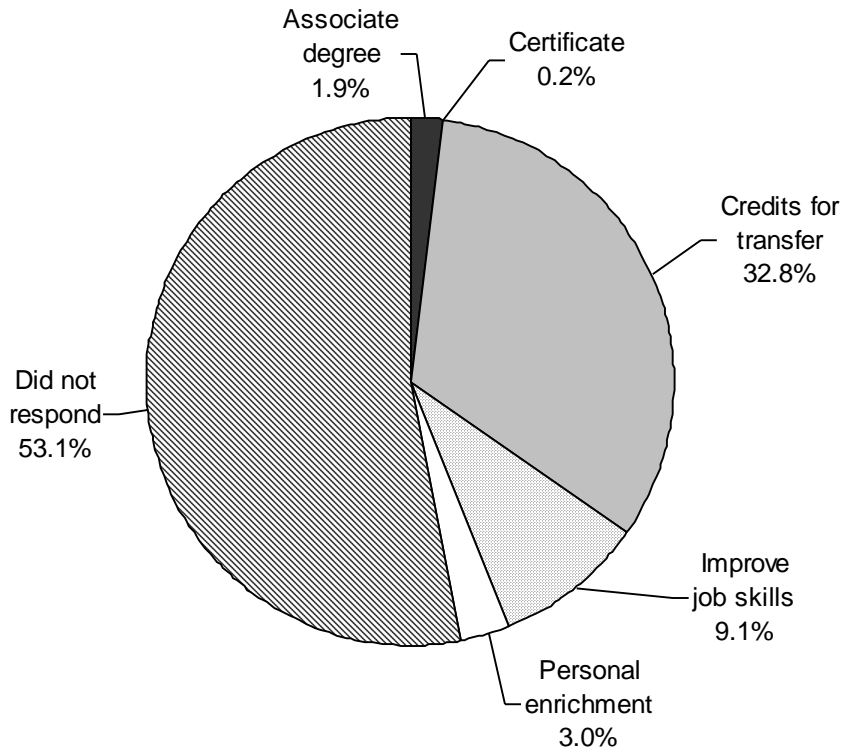
