Useful Terms

First-Time in College Student - a student who has never attended college or any other postsecondary institution. Students are not reported as first-time-entering college until they have completed their high school work.

First-Time Transfer Student - a student who is entering ACC for the first time but is known to have previously attended another postsecondary institution at the undergraduate level.

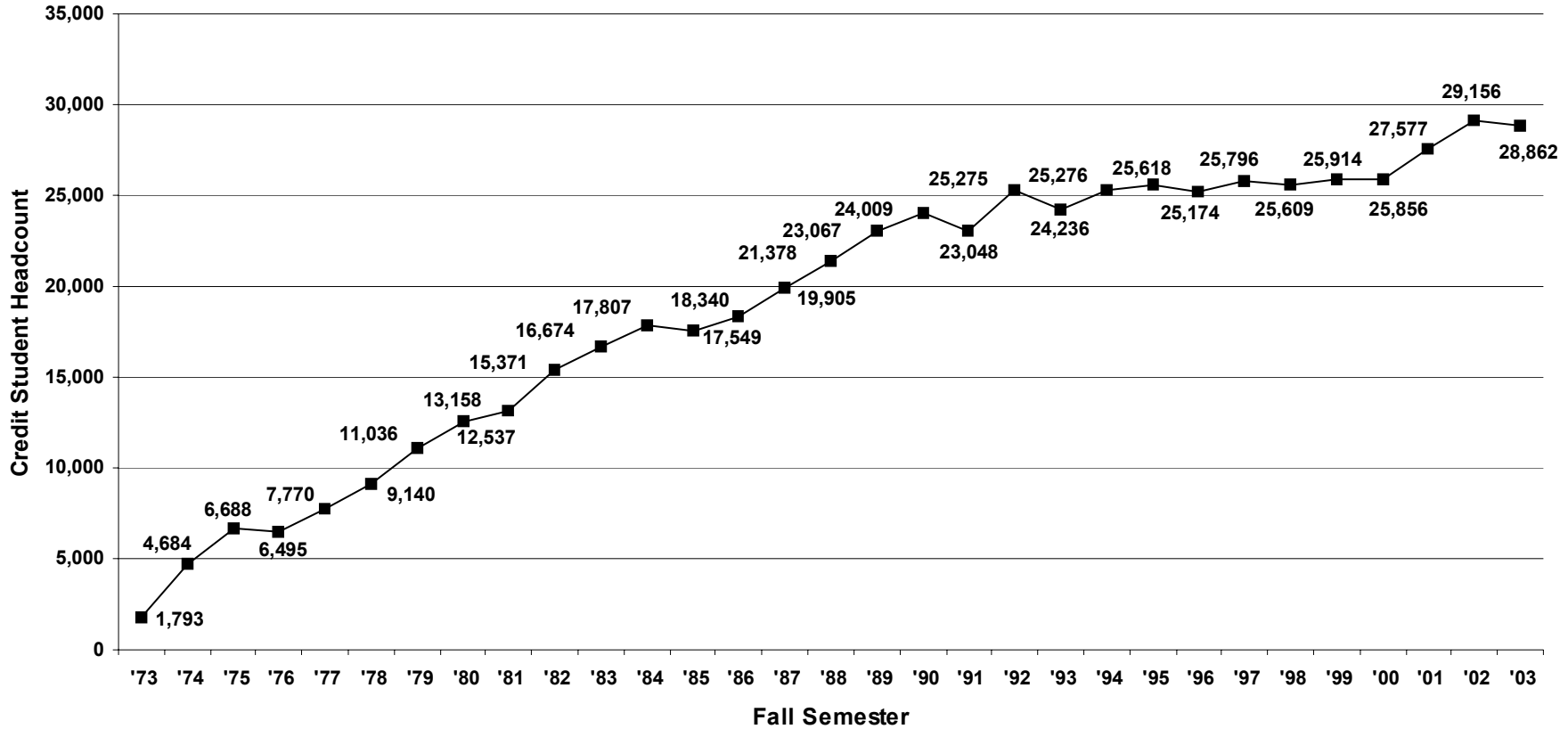
Headcount - the number of students enrolled in one or more courses.

High School Concurrent Enrollment - the number of students enrolled in high school (as juniors and seniors) and in college. These students receive college credit and may receive high school graduation credit for the classes they take at ACC.

College Credit Student Profile Summary

- Nearly 29,000 college credit students enrolled in classes at Austin Community College in Fall 2003.
- Fifty-six percent of Fall 2003 college credit students were between the ages of 18 – 24. Examination of age distributions over the last five fall terms revealed no discernible shifts.
- Fifty-six percent of Fall 2003 college credit students were female. The percentage of females at ACC has increased slightly each term since Fall 1999.
- Thirty-five percent of Fall 2003 college credit students were minorities.
- Twenty-six percent of Fall 2003 college credit students were full-time students, an increase of two percent from the previous fall term.
- Full-time students, those that were enrolled in 12 more semester credit hours, attempted twice as many semester credit hours than part-time students (13 vs. 6 semester credit hours, respectively).
- Analysis of enrollments by time of day revealed that nearly half of college credit students took day-only classes in Fall 2003, a consistent trend the last four fall terms.
- Seventy-one percent of Fall 2003 college credit students were in-district students. Over the last five fall terms, there have been slight fluctuations in college credit student district status.
- Examination of college credit student headcount by zip code region in Fall 2003 revealed slight decreases for students from Central Austin, South Austin, and Southeast Austin compared to Fall 2002. In addition, Fall 2003 student headcount from Cedar Park/Leander increased slightly from Fall 2002.
- High school concurrent enrollment statistics revealed that Austin ISD (Independent School District), Georgetown ISD, and Round Rock ISD accounted for nearly one-third of all High school concurrent enrollments in Fall 2003 (the total Fall 2003 High School concurrent enrollment was 1,457).
- Seventeen percent of the nearly 2,300 first-time transfers to ACC in Fall 2003 were from the University of Texas at Austin (11%) and Texas State University at San Marcos (6%).
- Forty-five percent of the nearly 1,000 Fall 2003 international students at ACC originated from Asia.

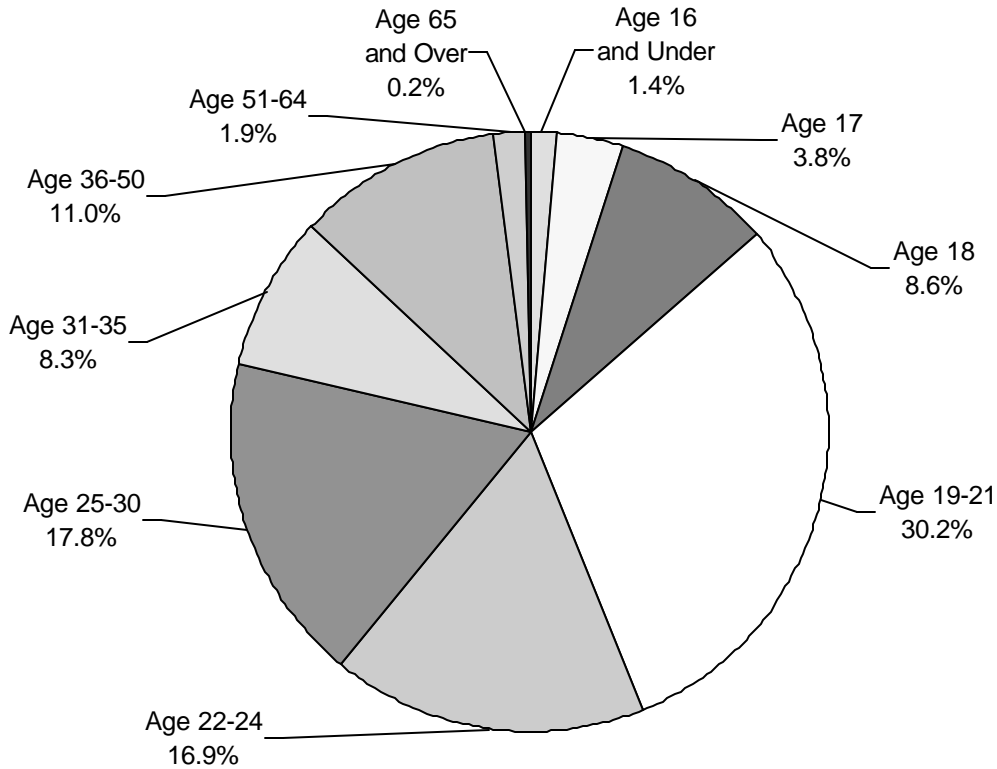
Credit Student Headcount Fall 1973 - 2003

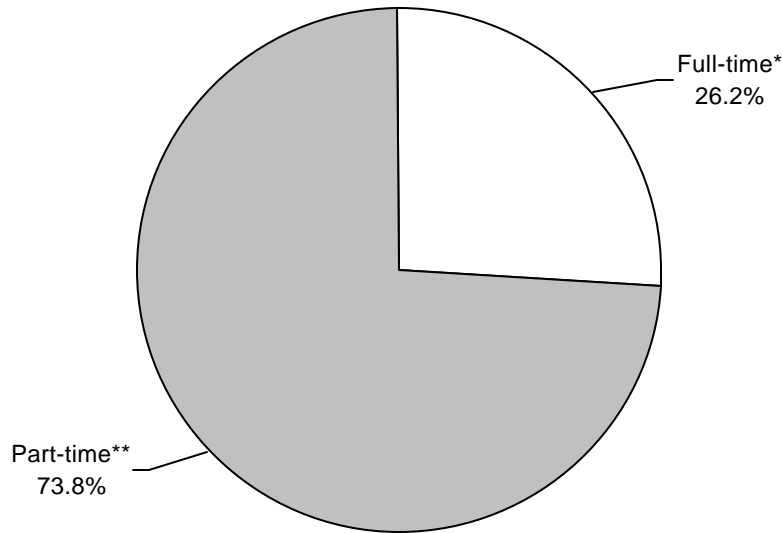

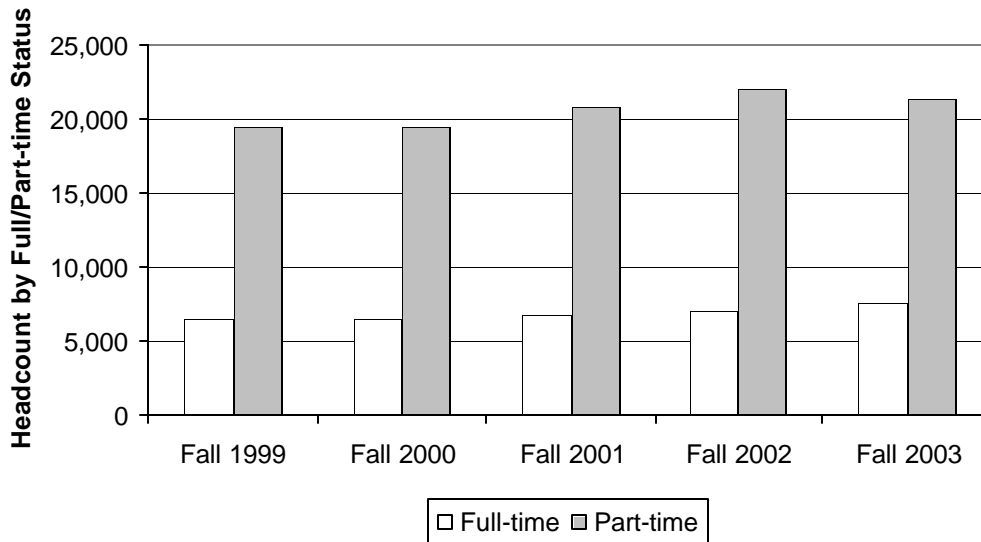

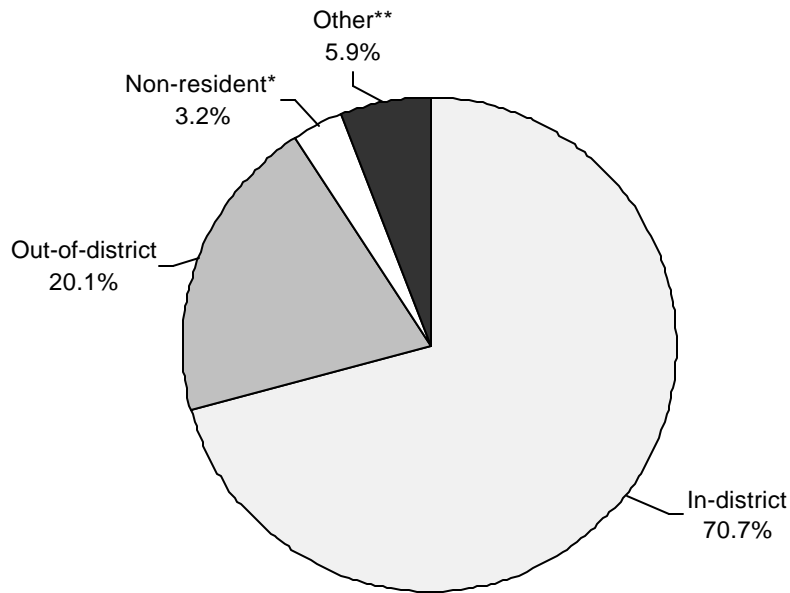

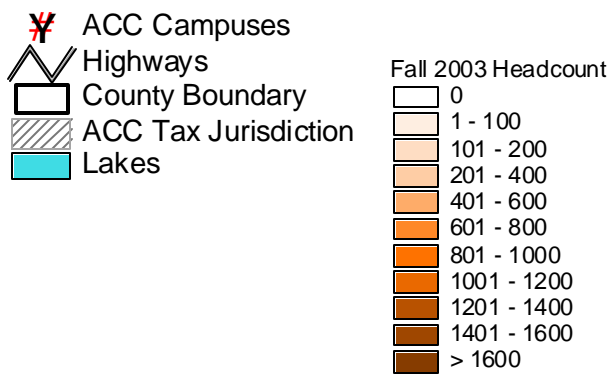

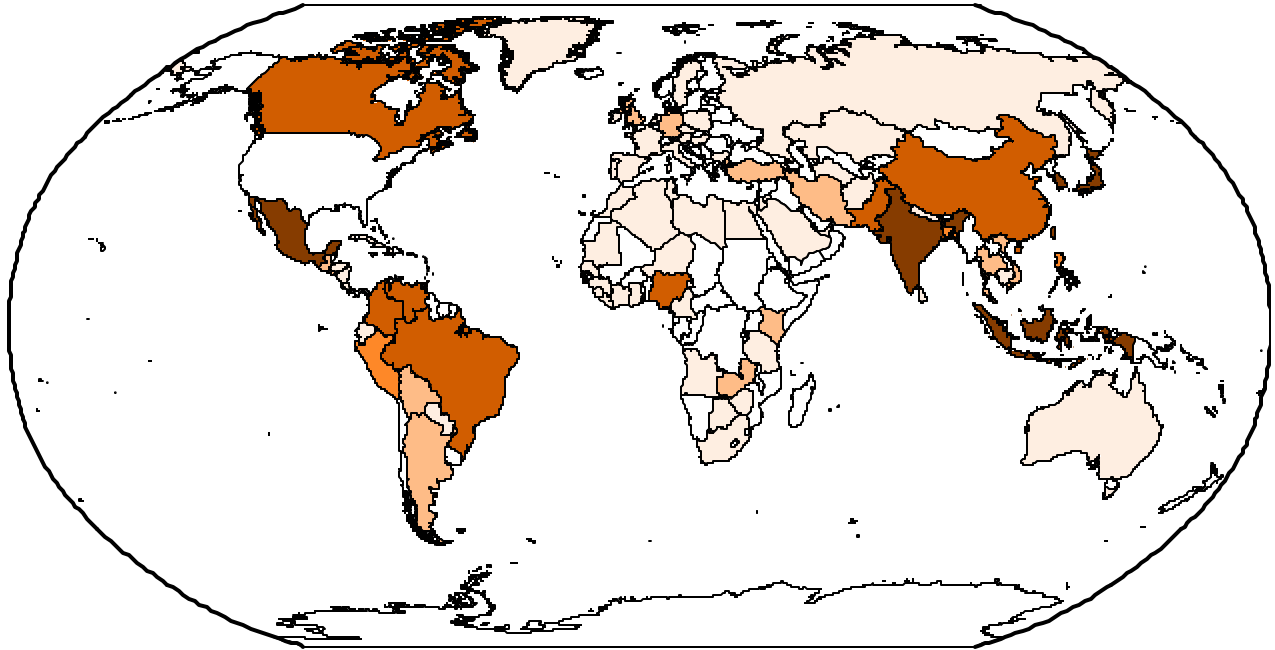

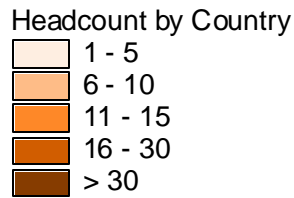

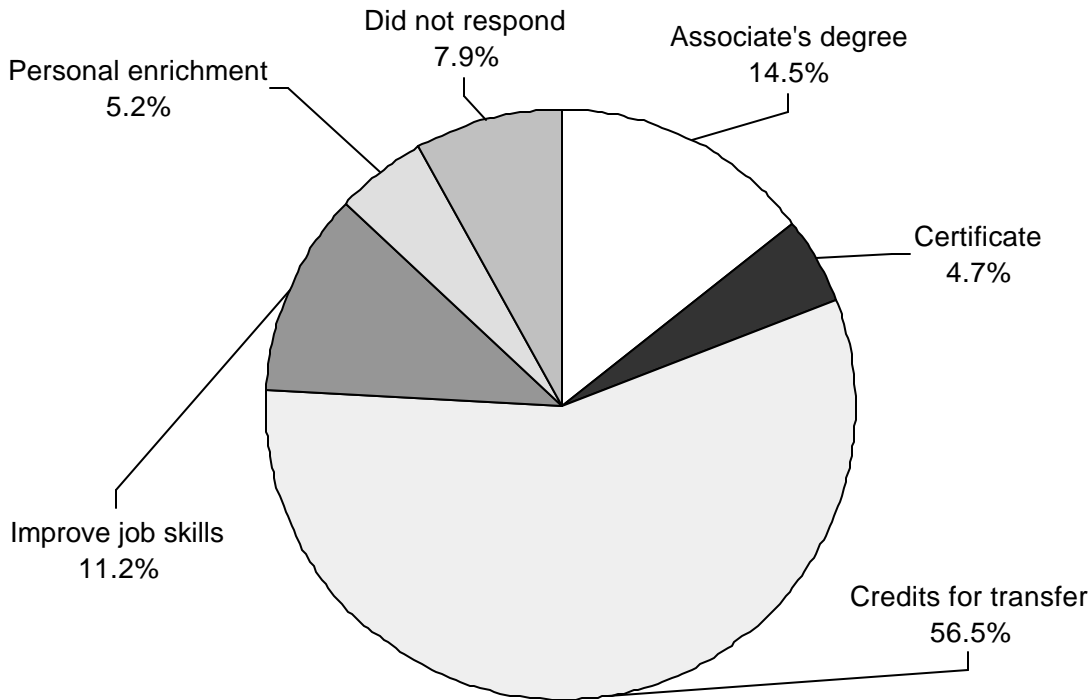
International Students by Country Map
