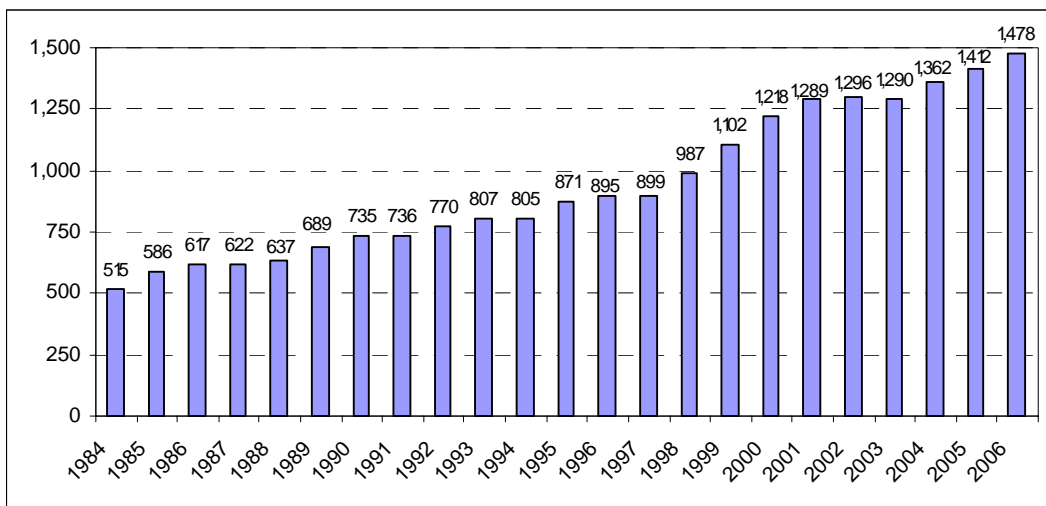

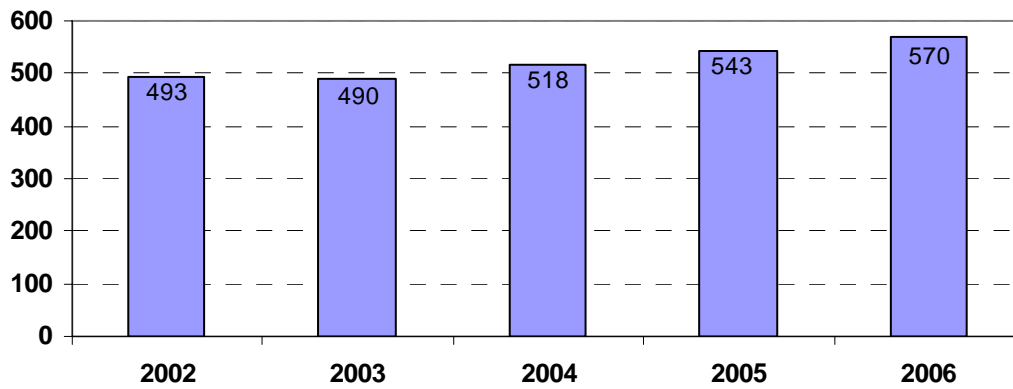

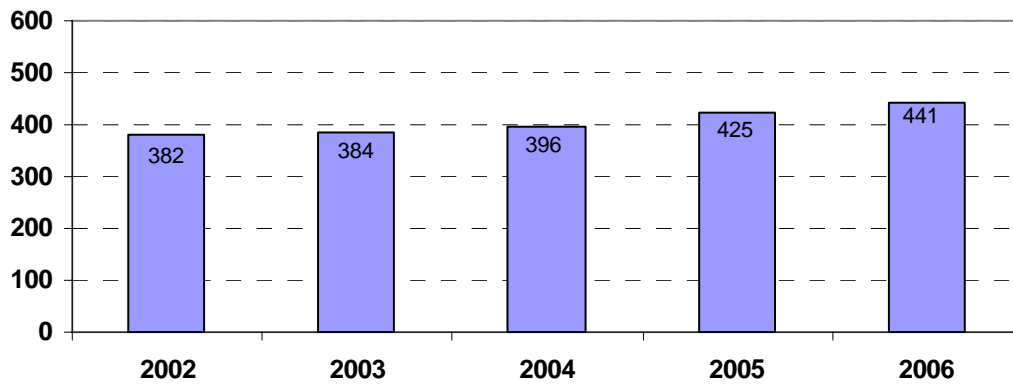

Classified Personnel

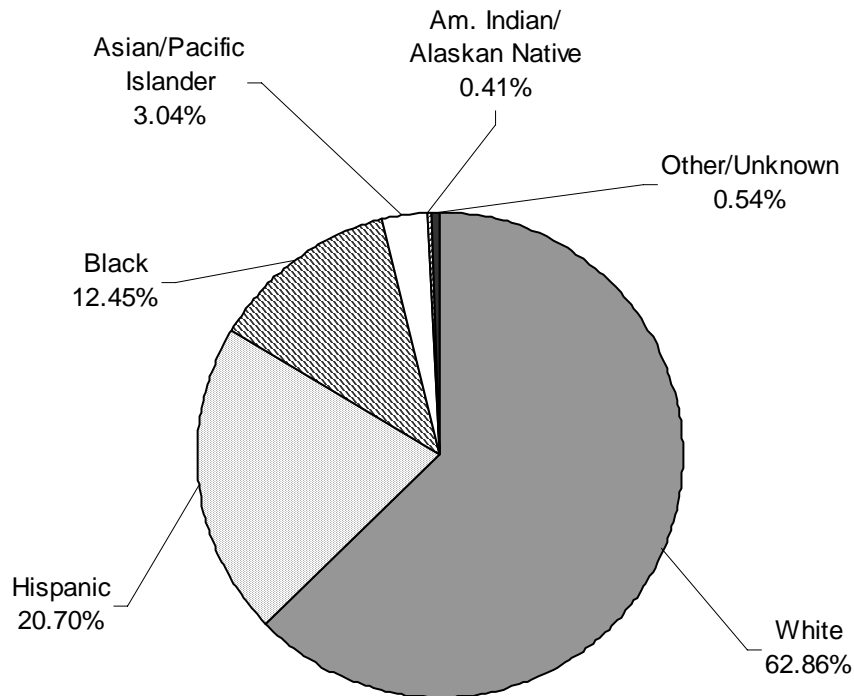


Administrative and Professional/Technical Personnel

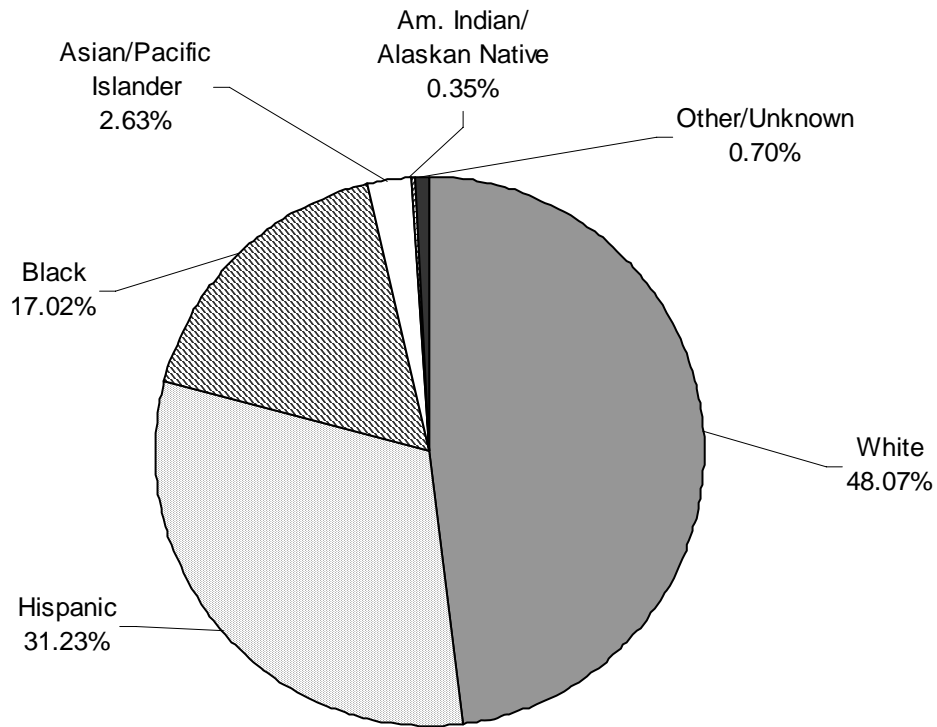

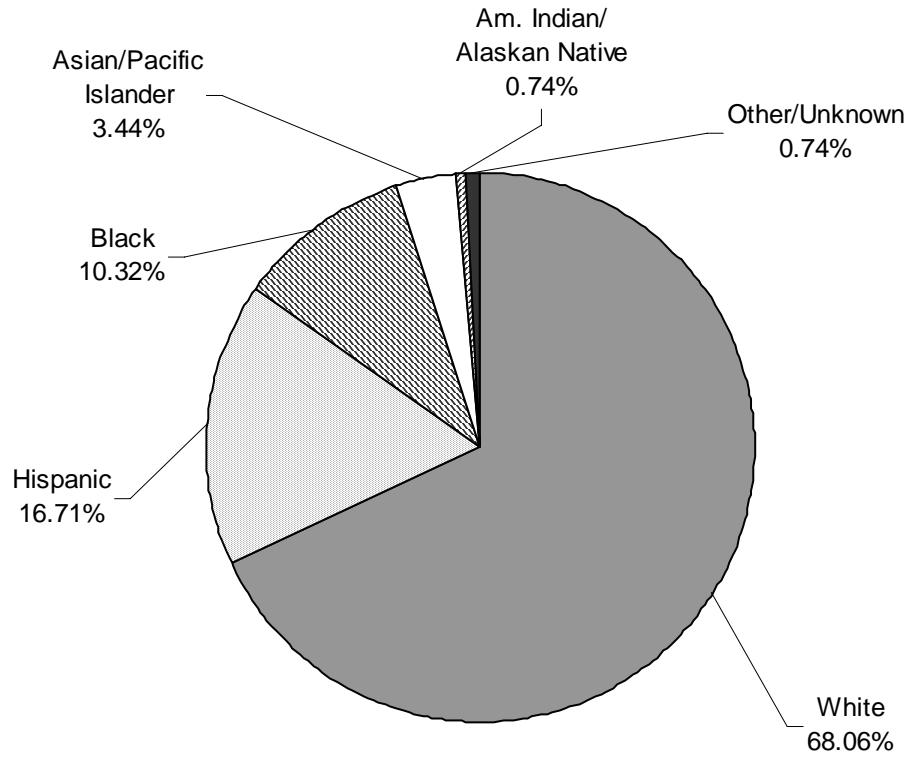

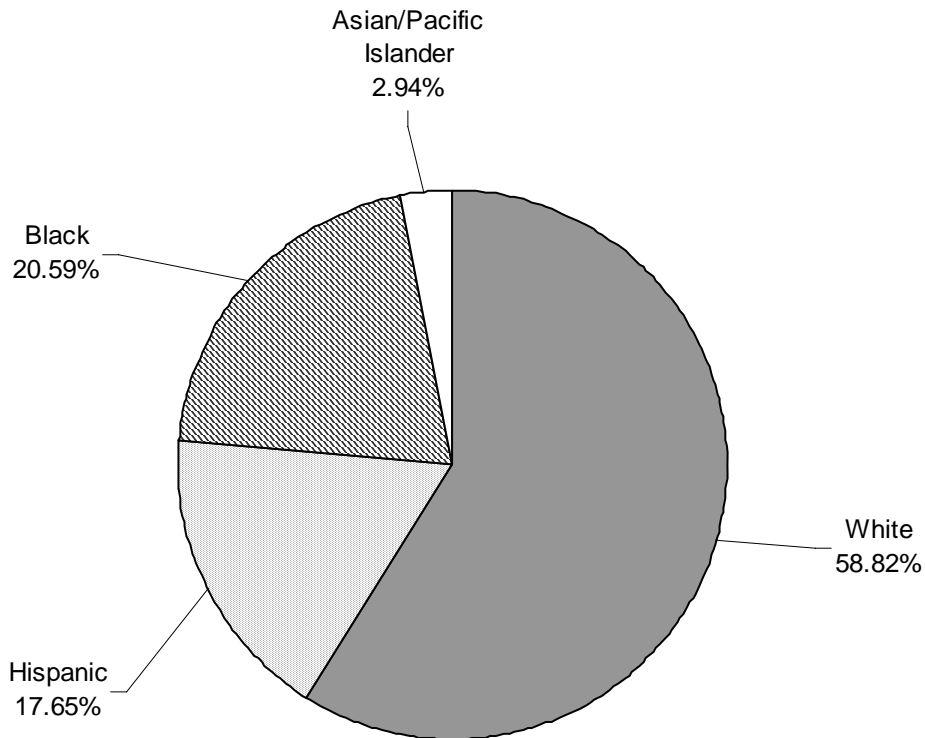

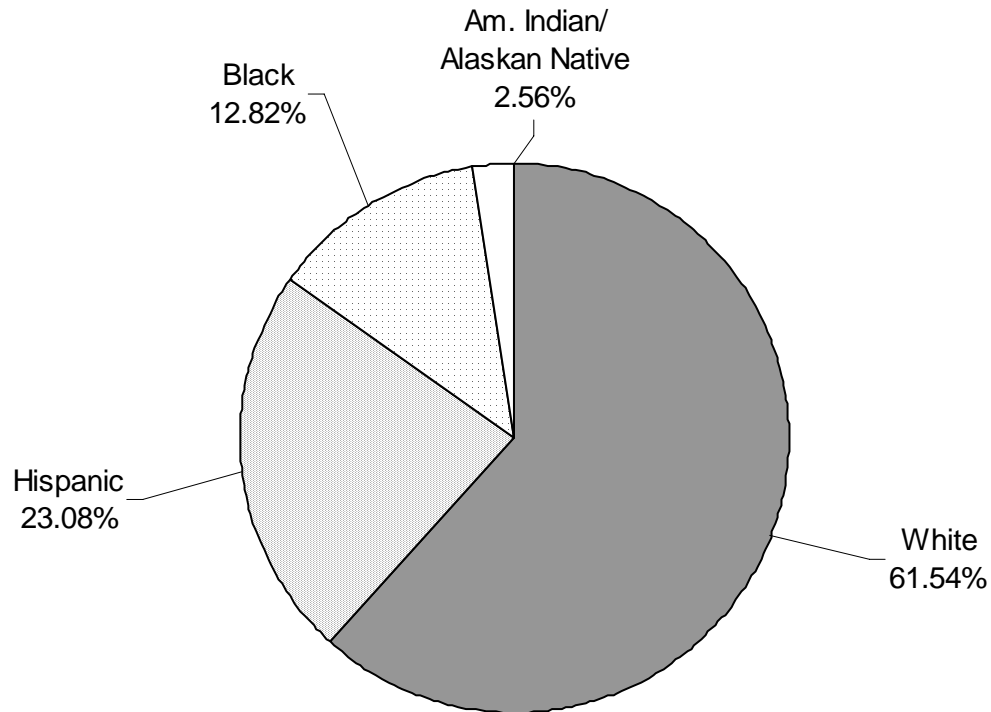

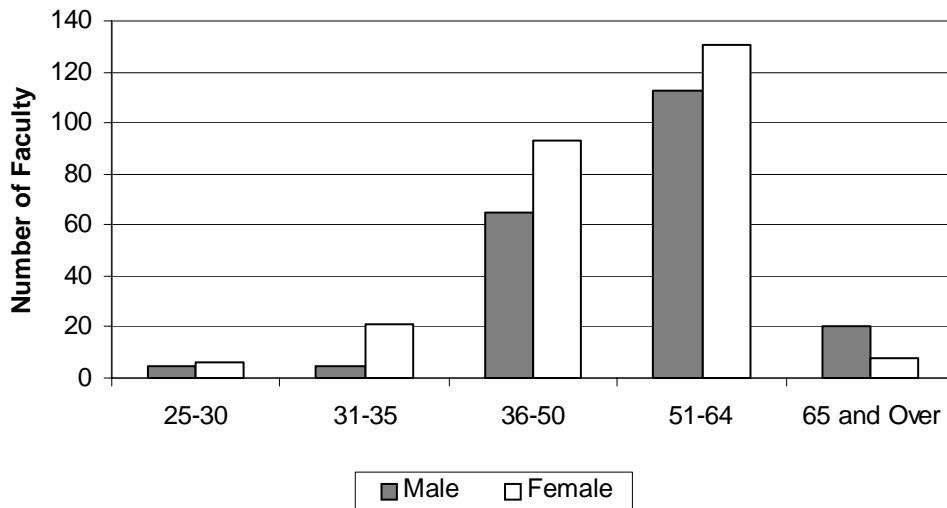

Full-time Faculty¹ by Age and Gender Fall 2006



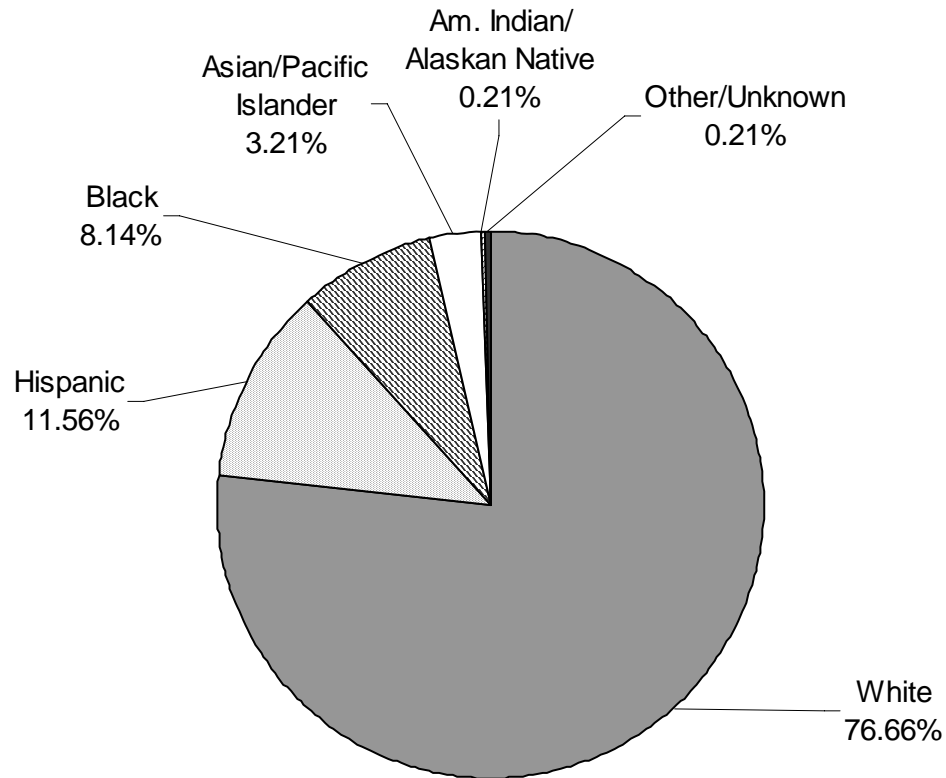

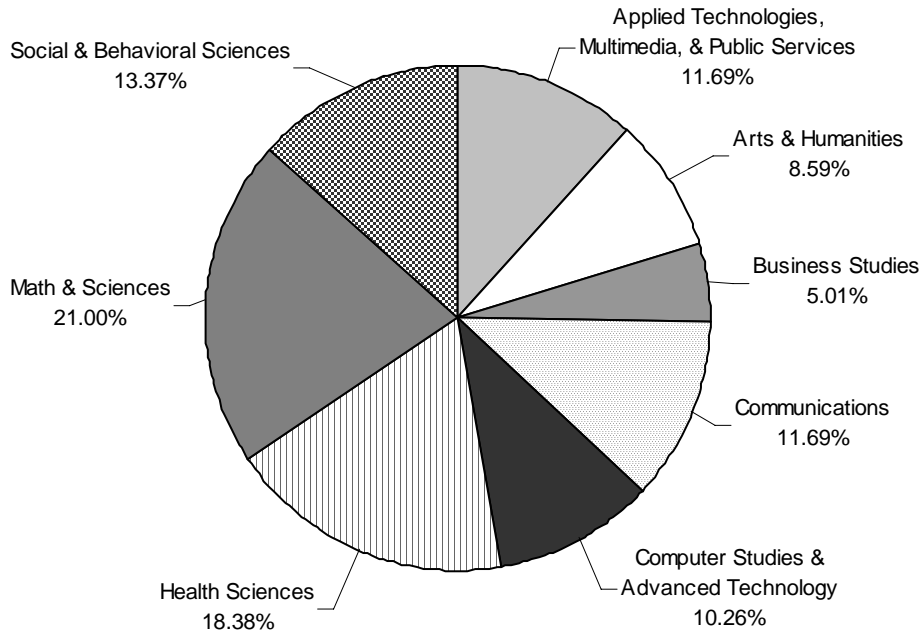

Full-time Credit Teaching Faculty by Dean Area¹ Fall 2006



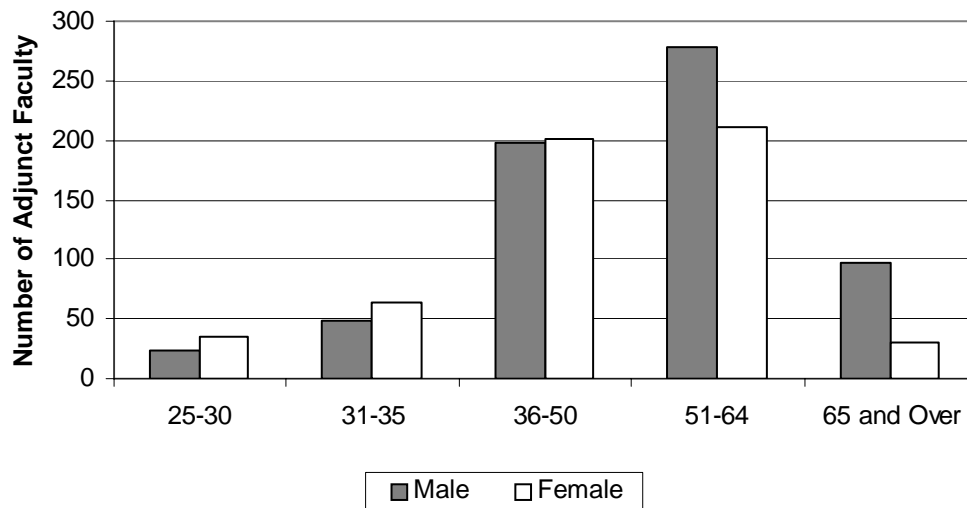

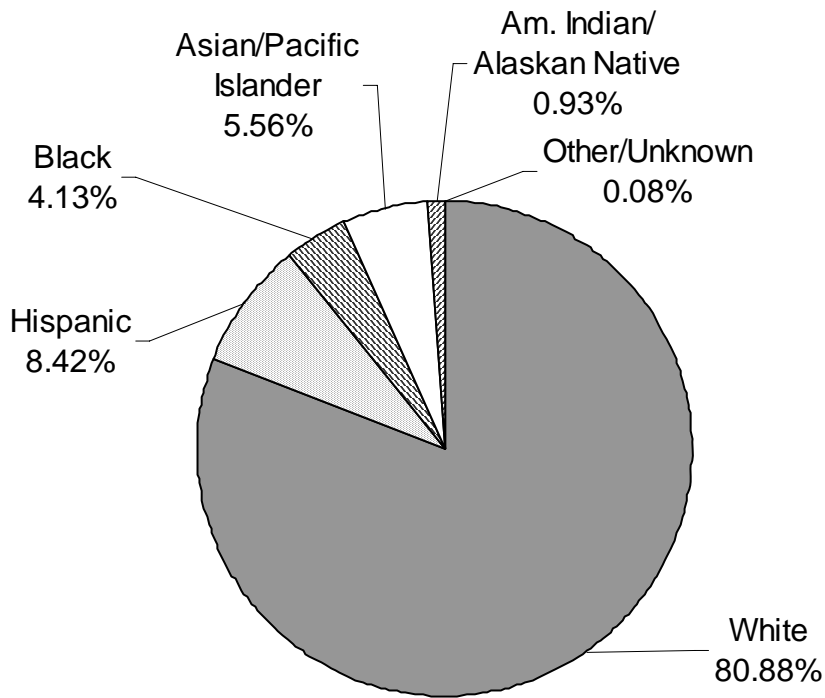

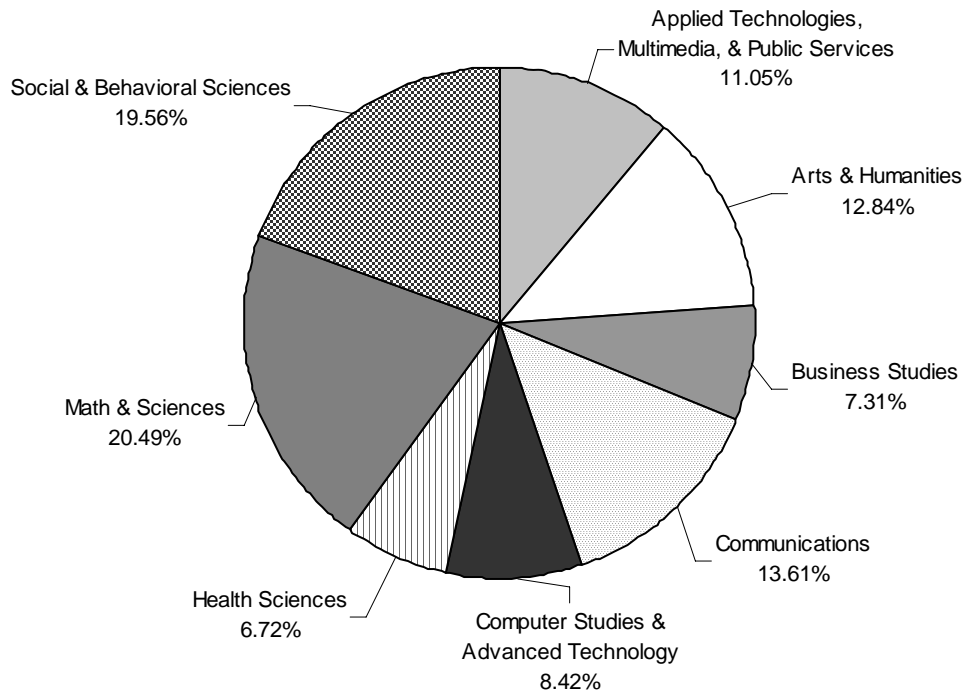

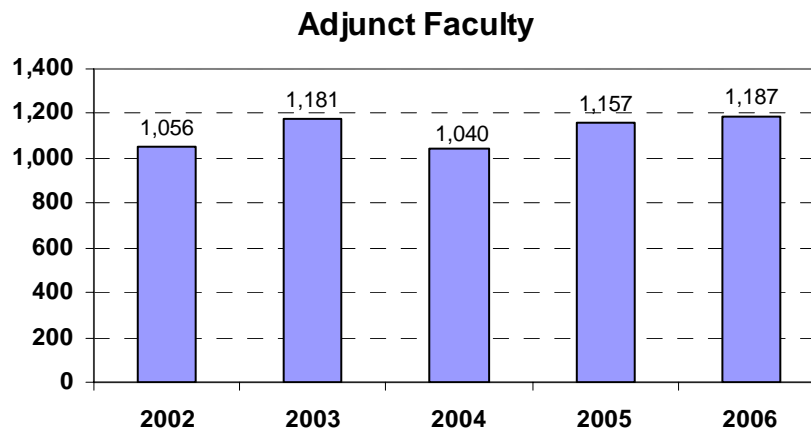
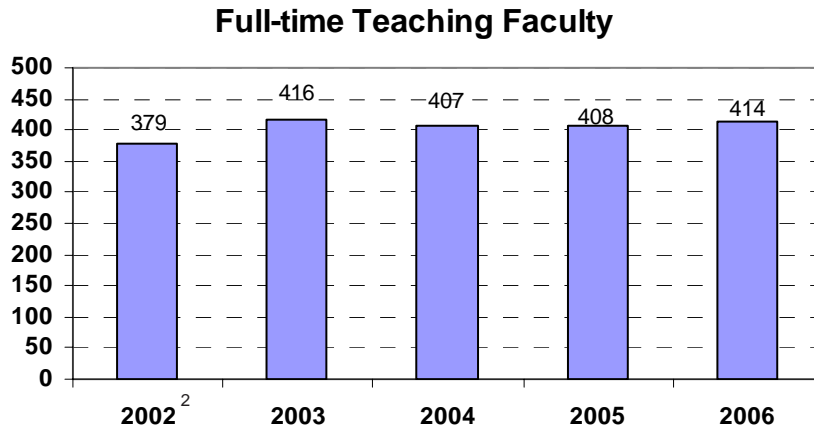
