## Useful Terms

**4th Class Day Data (Second 5½ week session)** – data for all summer classes, as of the 4<sup>th</sup> day of class of the second 5 1/2 week session. **(Official Reporting Date for the Summer Semester)**

**12th Class Day Data** - data for all fall or spring classes, as of the 12th day of class of the 16 week session. **(Official Reporting Date for the Fall and Spring Semesters)**

**Contact Hour** - an instructional unit of time in which a student has contact with an instructor; includes both lecture and laboratory time.

**Enrollment** - the number of courses students have registered for.

**Headcount** - the number of students enrolled in one or more courses. This number may be duplicated or unduplicated.

**Reporting Dates** – Fall/Spring: 12th Class Day  
Summer: 4th Class Day of the second 5½ week session

**Semester Credit Hours (SCH)** – one clock hour of class per week. For example, PSYC-2301 meets for three hours a week and is worth three semester credit hours.

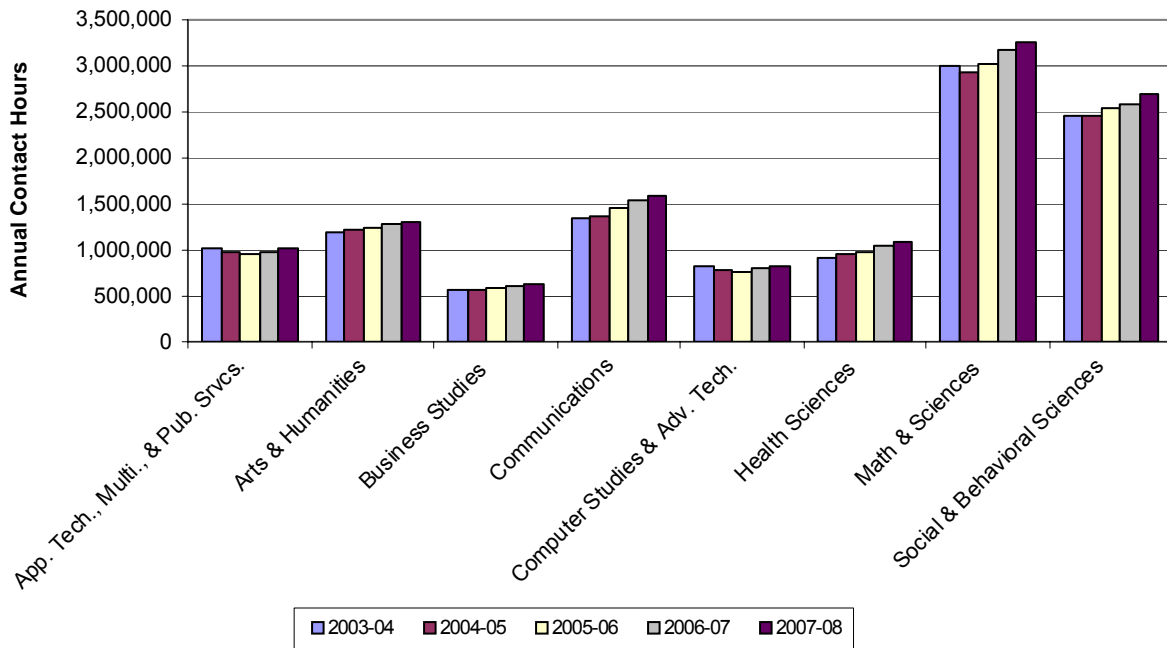
