## Continuing Education Overview

The Continuing Education Division at Austin Community College offers programs in the following areas:

The **Business Assessment Center (BACT)** provides the Central Texas community with a comprehensive range of professional testing services. BACT has partnered with numerous testing companies and educational institutions, both nationally and internationally, to administer educational, performance-based, and high stakes assessments for higher education, business, industry, and international agencies. The center has been recognized as a leader in the development and utilization of innovative techniques for securing and managing exams. BACT is the only GED testing center in the three-county Central Texas area and adheres to the testing standards of the National College Testing Association and Consortium of College Testing Centers.

The **Teaching and Learning Center (TLC)** offers college and career readiness training for students and teachers, including parenting classes, childcare training, ParaEducator training, as well as teacher certification and professional development. As a part of the ACC Student Success Initiative, courses are added as needed to help local students and parents prepare for the future.

Our **Community Programs** area provides classes that are designed to challenge the creative mind, increase and refine vocational skills, develop individuals personally, and promote lifelong learning.

Community Programs are made up of three major program areas, including:

*Interior Design Institute* - provides floral design, landscape design and horticulture. These programs offer premier training for individuals wanting to enter these specific industries.

*Institute of Language and Culture* - provides a variety of language classes which focus on speaking skills in a language.

*Personal Enrichment* - provides programs in recreational courses, arts and crafts, photography, financial seminars, State Theatre classes, Event and Wedding Planning, Assessment Test Preparation and many more.

**Corporate Training Solutions (CTS)** provides a one-stop source for training solutions that support business, industry, and governmental agencies. By collaborating with organizations to analyze learning needs, Corporate Training Solutions tailors educational experiences that help to develop employee talent and improve performance. Programs are flexible, on target, convenient and a value-added resource, making Corporate Training Solutions a partner in improving business results.

The **Workforce Development Center (WDC)** is designed to provide a wide range of training and educational opportunities for individuals getting started in the workplace, furthering their current careers, or working to meet licensure and certification requirements.

The WDC is made up of three major program areas, including:

*Health Professions Institute (HPI)* - provides entry-level training opportunities for individuals beginning their career in healthcare. HPI also provides continuing education opportunities for current healthcare professionals needing this education as part of their recertification, re-licensure, and professional development.

*High Technology Institute (HTI)* - provides technology training through practical hands-on instruction for both new and experienced users. HTI courses range from computer fundamentals to web authoring, from software programming to AutoCAD training. The Technical Certification Programs include: Apple, ASQ, Cisco, Comp TIA, Fiber Optics, Google Android, Linux, Localization, Microsoft, PC Technician, Project Management, Video Game Development and more.

*Business & Industry Institute (BII)* - provides training for those starting or transitioning to a new career, meeting professional continuing education requirements, or simply expanding upon their existing skills in a variety of industry specific program areas. BII program areas include job entry training, business development, professional development, and professional continuing education.

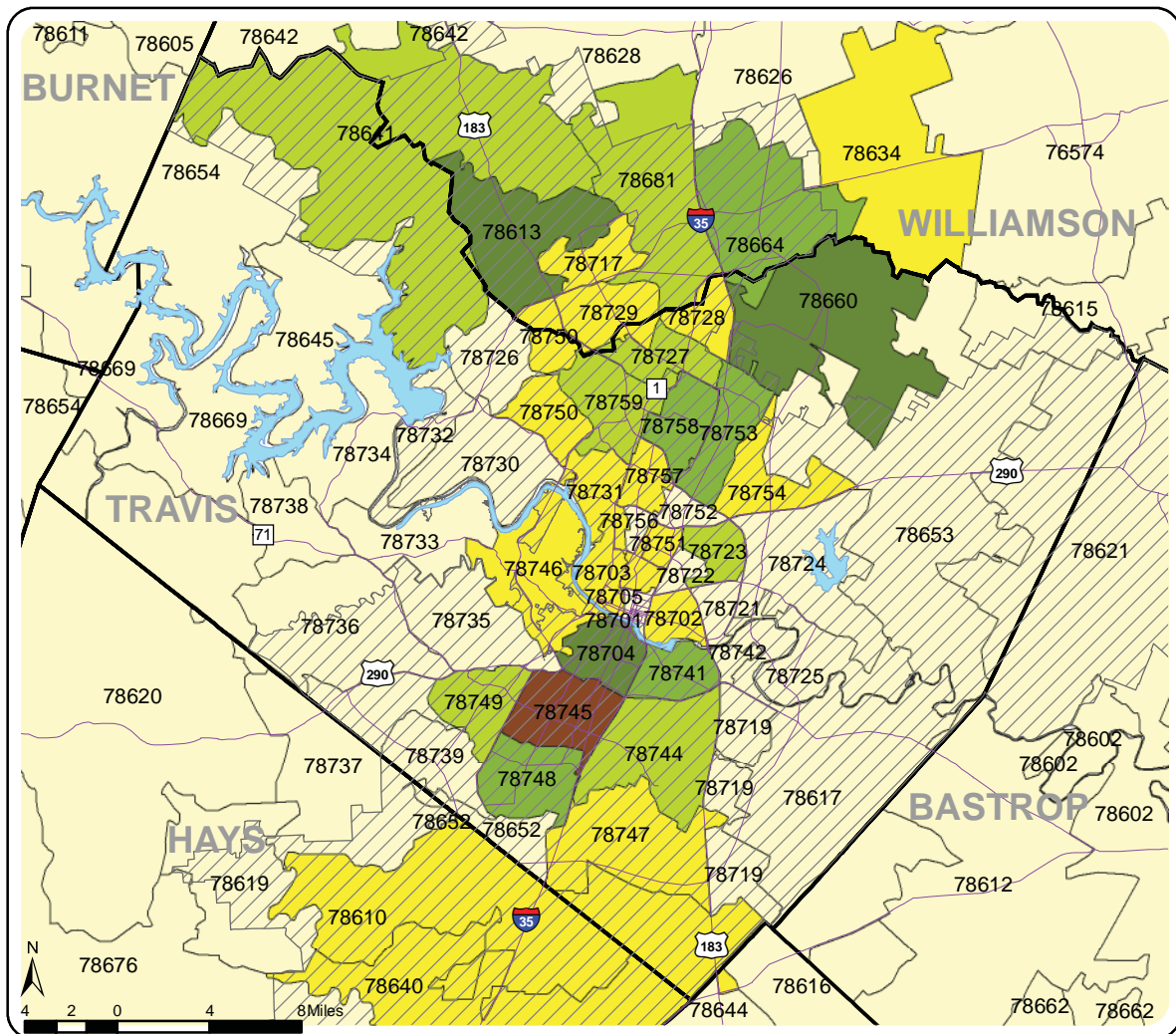
