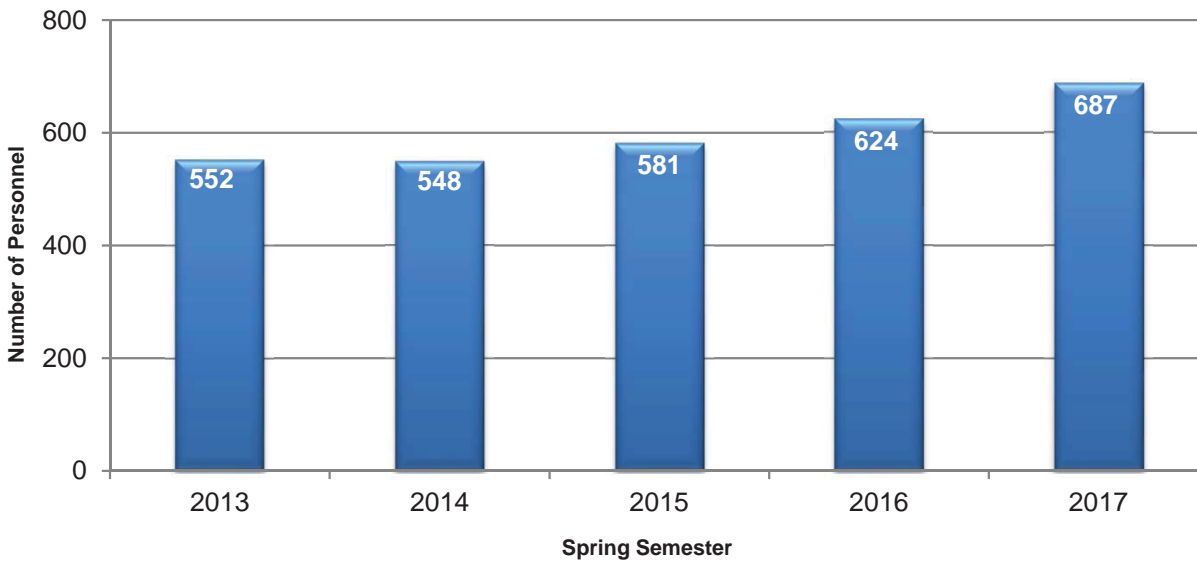

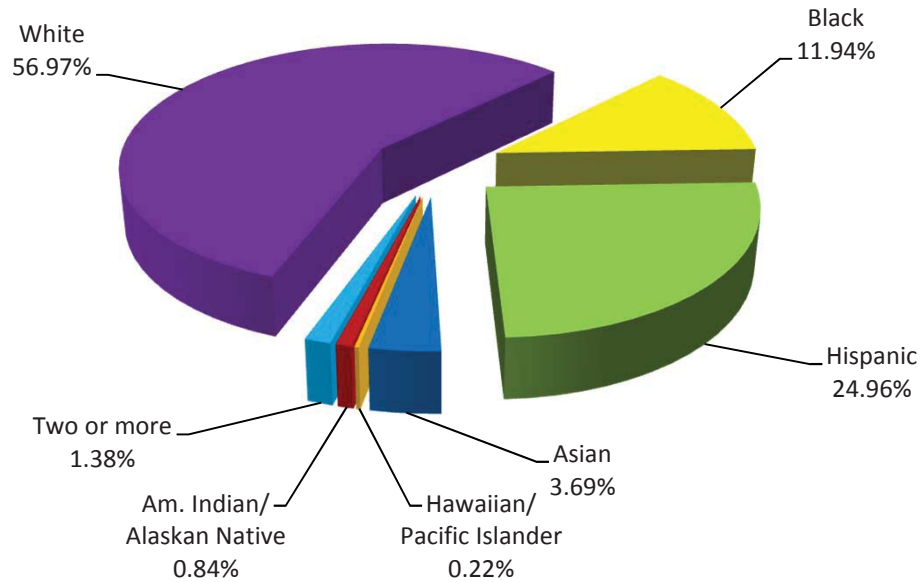


Administrative and Professional/Technical Personnel

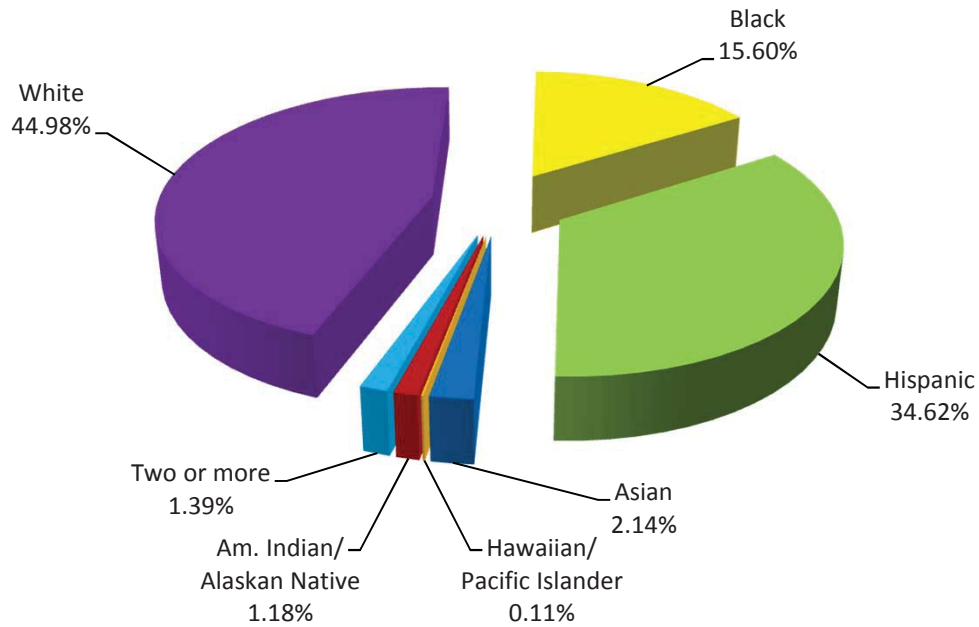

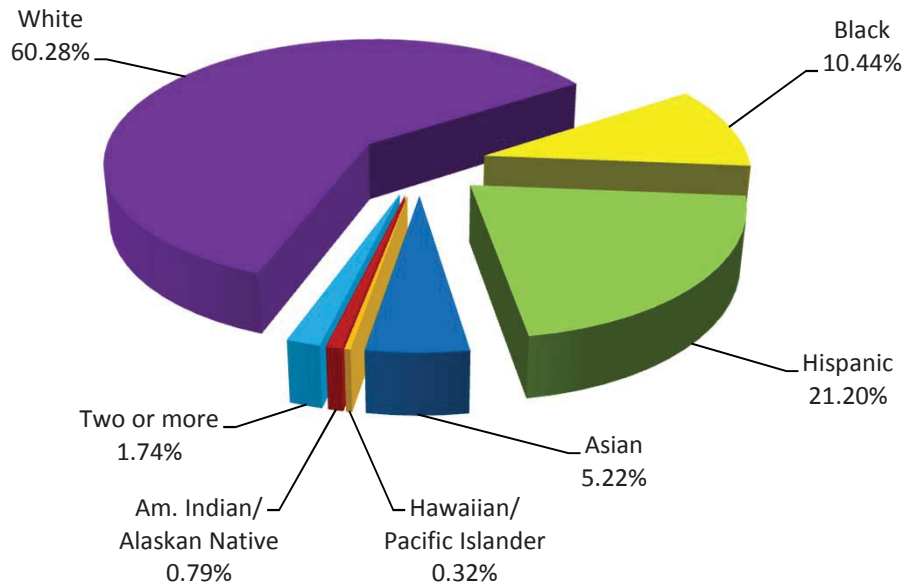

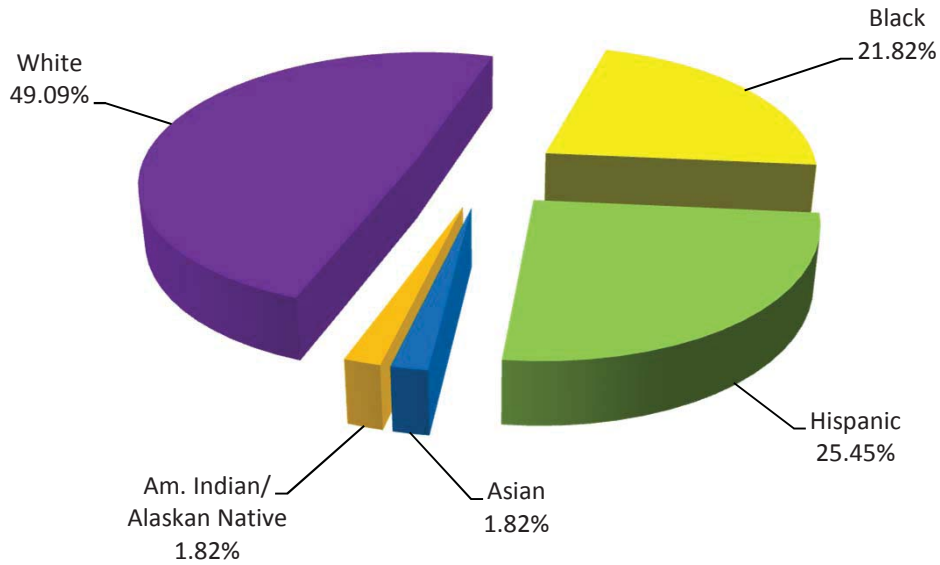

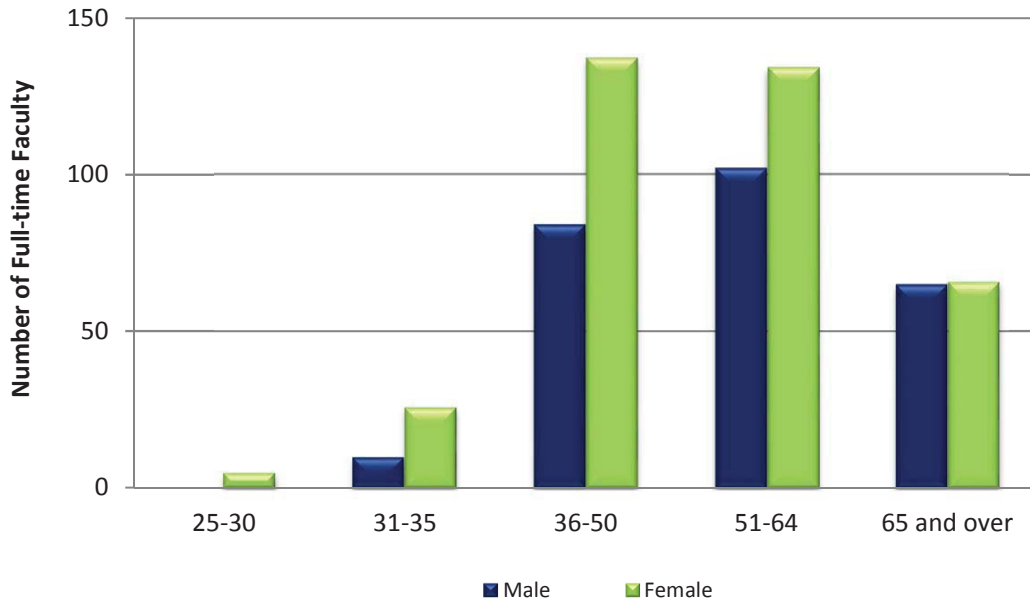

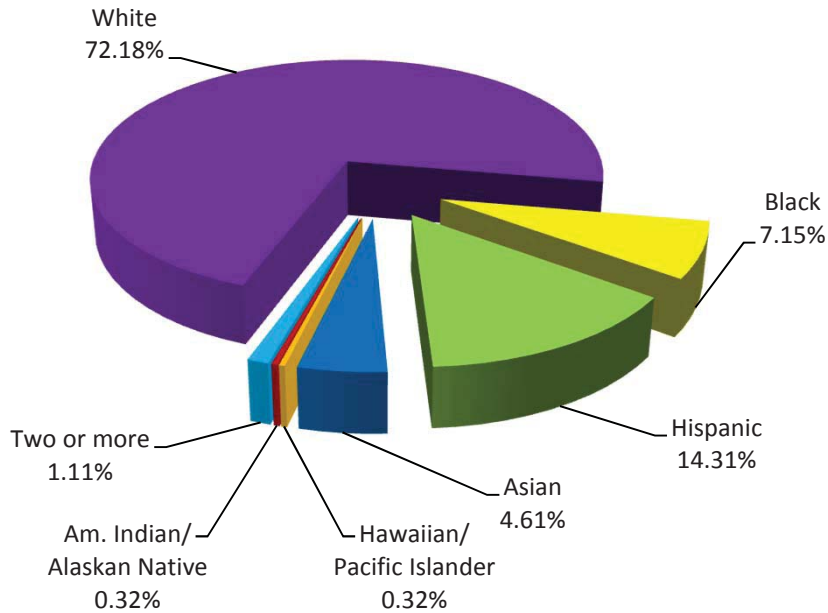

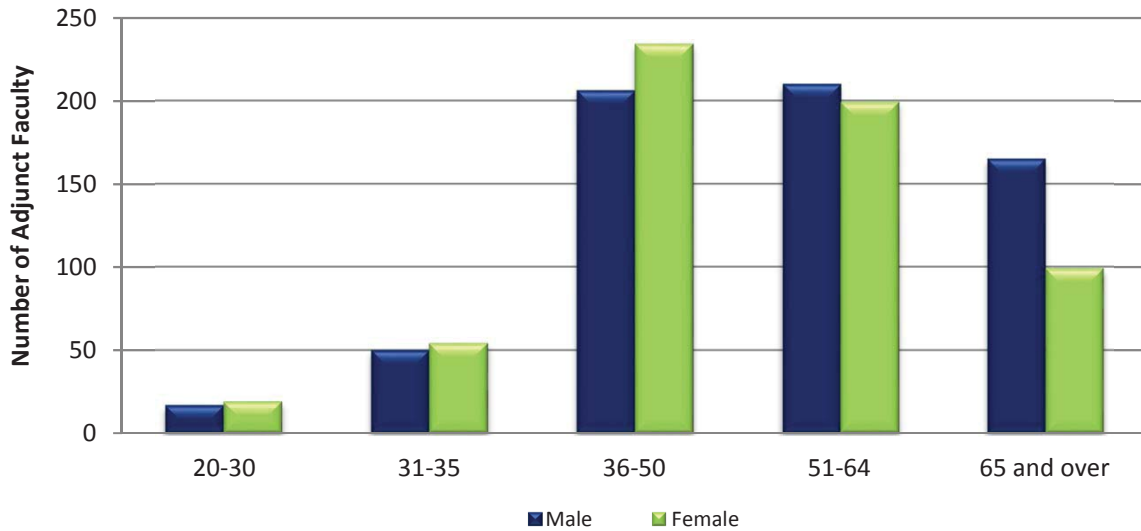

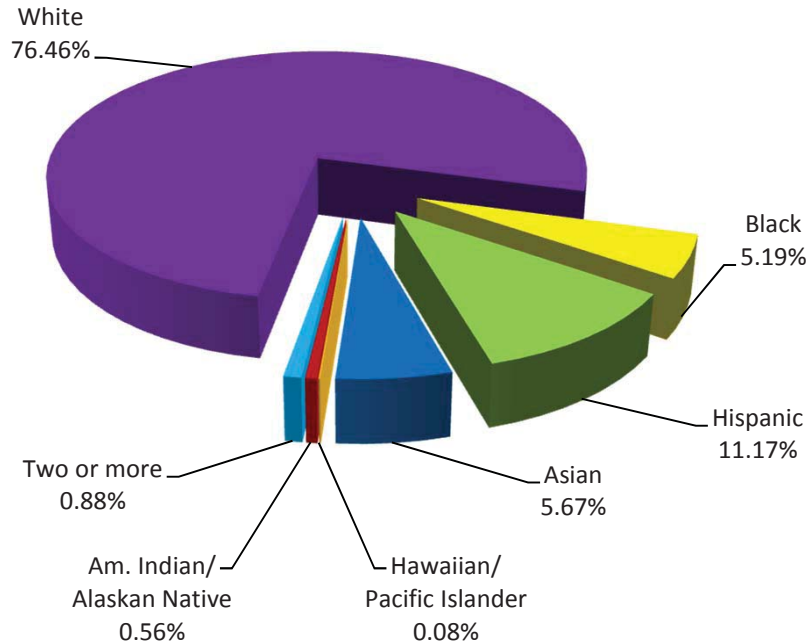

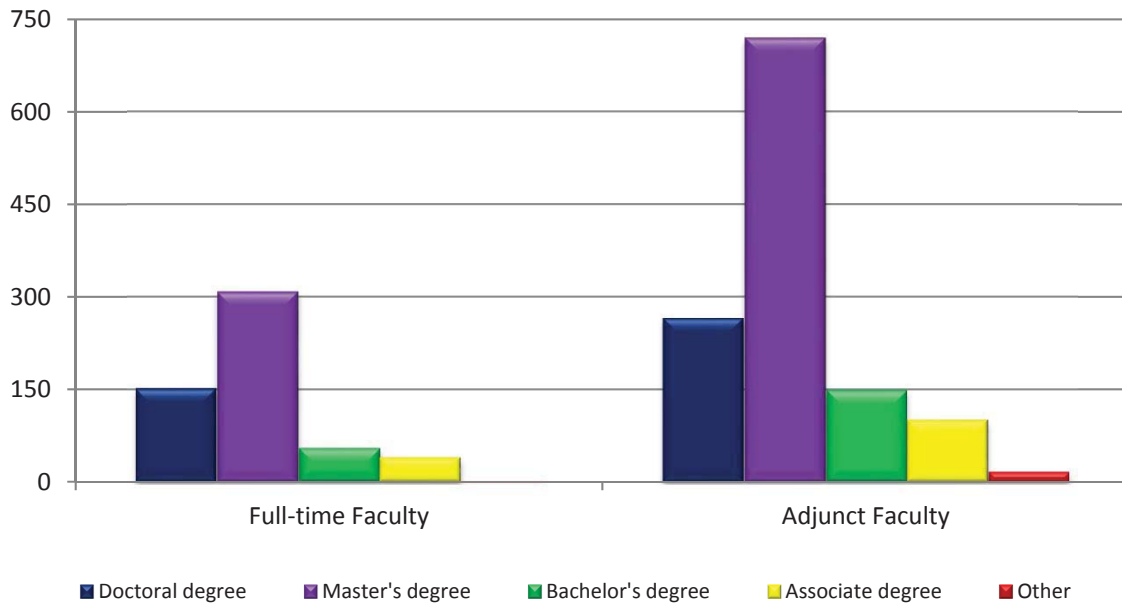

Highest Degree Earned by Credit Teaching Faculty Type Spring 2017



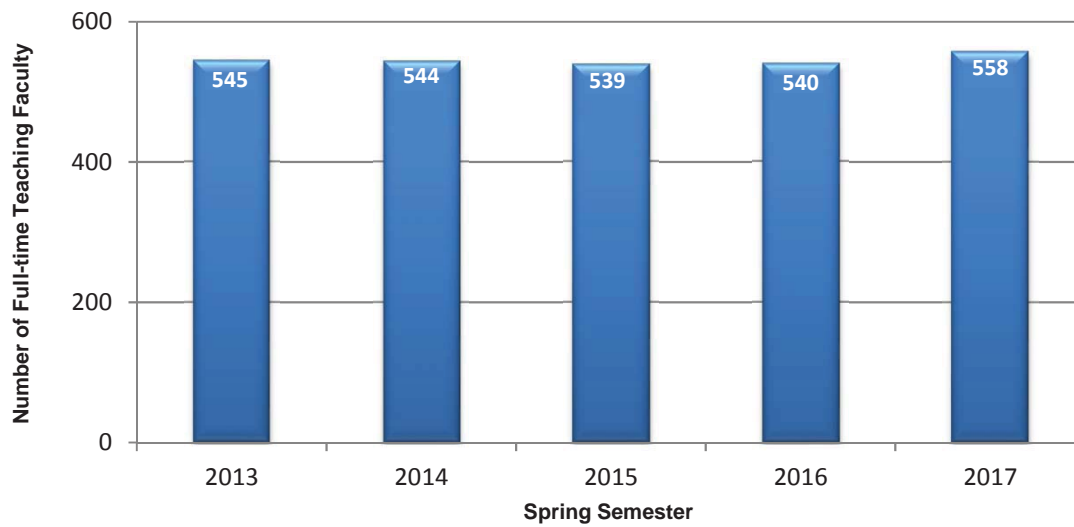

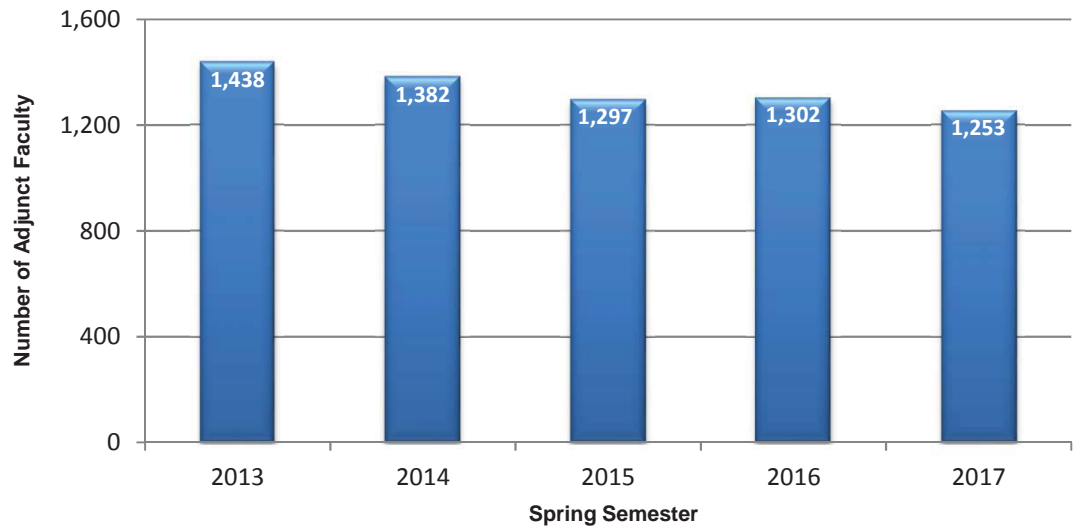
